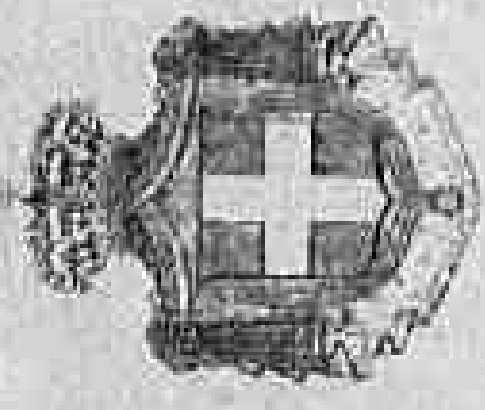

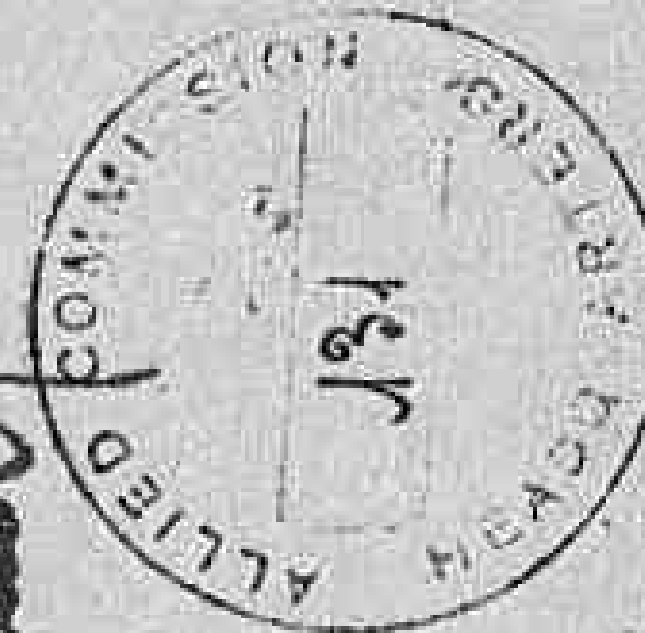

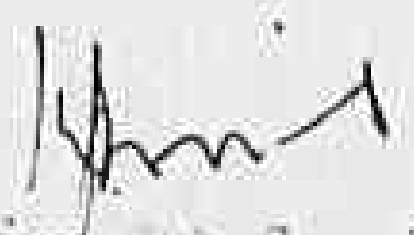

1. I have considered the proposed proclamation which is returned herewith. The proclamation itself follows exactly the form of RDL No. 25 of the 20th January 1944 except that in certain articles the functions which were imposed on Italian Government officials by the decree are by the proclamation imposed upon AMG authorities. This procedure is correct, and inevitable if the proclamation is to be issued in this form.

2. I do in fact agree with you that if any order of this kind is to be issued in this form ~~that~~ there is no reason why it should not be issued by the SCAC XIII Corps. *Here*

3. I have, however, grave doubt whether an order in this form is good in law.

In the first place, an occupying power has only the right to suspend, and not to abrogate, the laws of the occupied territory; I have grave doubt as to what would be the true legal effect of a "suspension" of the anti-racial laws.

In the second place, an occupying power, since it is not the sovereign of the occupied territory "has no right to make changes in the laws or in the administration other than those which are temporarily necessary ^{by the} ~~in the~~ interest ^{of the} ~~and~~ maintenance and safety of his armies and the realization of the purpose of war. On the contrary, he has the duty of administering the country according to the existing laws and existing rules of administration." (Oppenheim's International Law, Vol. II, pg. 342.)

4. In construing the above quotation it should be borne in mind that the reference to the "purpose of war" means the destruction of the enemy forces; it does not refer to any ultimate purpose on the part of a belligerent. 57.1

5. I am of opinion that the proper way to give effect to this decree is to issue a Regional Order along the lines of General Order No. 18.

It will be recalled that when General Order No. 18 was originally issued the present policy of implementation had not been developed and the order was issued in its existing form for precisely the reasons given above.

6. I appreciate of course the objection to any action which appears to deviate from our policy of non-implementation of Italian legislation. I think however that from a legal point of view it is necessary to deviate in this case and I think that the existing preamble to the General Order can be enlarged so as to place the Yugoslav Government in a difficulty if they seek to object to the issue of the order. I suggest that some such clauses as the following might be inserted:-

WHEREAS prior to 8 September 1943 the Italian Government had passed certain laws providing for discrimination against persons of Jewish faith, and

WHEREAS all such laws are contrary to the principles of all the United Nations for which all the United Nations have engaged in war against the Germans and against the Italian Fascist Government, and

WHEREAS since the 8 September 1943 the Italian Government has enacted a decree ~~restoring~~ ^{restoring} to Jews their full civil and political rights, and

WHEREAS such decree is in conformity with the spirit and principles of all the United Nations;

NOW, THEREFORE, I..."

7. I feel in this case that the Yugoslavs will not be slow to take advantage of the quandary in which we appear to be placed. I think it is better that they should be forced in the position of complaining against the enactment of a law of which they must manifestly approve rather than they should be in a position to criticize the legality of an order which we have actually issued.

Transitory and executory provisions.

All penal proceedings now pending for violation of the racial laws are quashed.

Sentences already passed on a conviction after trial in respect of the aforesaid violations shall be of no further

juridical effect.

Record cards concerning the said sentences shall ^{not} be compiled; those already compiled shall be struck out of the interested party's judicial record within one month from the effective date of this Proclamation.

Article VIII.

The Senior Civil Affairs Officer is authorized to issue General Orders for the better carrying out of this Proclamation which becomes operative in each area or part thereof within the occupied Territory on the date of its first publication therein.

Now therefore I, Harold R.L.G. Alexander, ^{G.C.B., C.S.I., DSO, M.C., B.D.C.} Field-Marshal, Supreme Allied Commander, Mediterranean Theatre of Operations, hereby proclaim as follows:

Section I.

A publication to be known as the Allied Military Government Gazette (herein after referred to as the Gazette) shall be issued from time to time under the authority of the Military Government and shall, subject to the proviso to section III, contain all Proclamations, Notices, Orders, Warnings and Directions and the like issued by or under the authority of the Allied Military Government of the Occupied Territory (herein after referred to as the Territory).

Article
Section II.

All acts, deeds, instruments, notices and other matters which by the laws of the Territory in force on the 8th September 1943 or by any law of the Allied Military Government are required to be published in an official organ, shall be published in the Gazette and publication in such Gazette shall constitute due publication as required by such laws.

Article
Section III.

All measures referred to in Sections I and II shall come into operation on the date of their publication in the Gazette unless otherwise stated; provided that nothing in this Proclamation contained shall be construed as affecting the validity or operation of any other measure, which the Allied Military Government may decide, shall be published in some other manner of any measure published before the commencement of this Proclamation.

Section IV.

In the event of any discrepancy between the English text of any measure and the text in any other language thereof, that text shall prevail which bears the original signature of the maker of such measure.

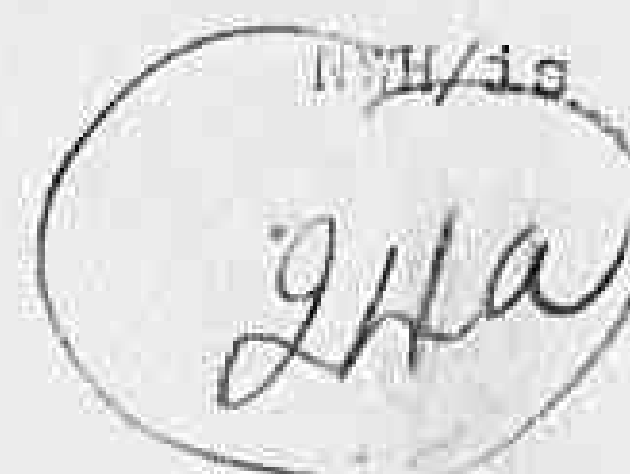

GENERAL ORDER NO. 39

CLOSURE OF FRONTIERS

I, CLYDE W. STONE, Rear Admiral, United States Naval Reserve,
Chief Civil Affairs Officer, for and on behalf of the Supreme Allied
Commander and Military Governor, hereby order as follows:

ARTICLE I

No person, unless authorized in writing by or on behalf of the
Supreme Allied Commander, may cross the frontier between Italy and
France or between Italy and Switzerland whether for the purpose of
entering or leaving Italy.

ARTICLE II

Any person violating this order shall, on conviction by an Allied
Military Court, be liable to imprisonment or fine or both with or with-
out such other lawful punishment as the Court may determine.

ARTICLE III

This order shall become operative in each province or part thereof,
within Military Government Territory on the date of its first publication
therein.

SUBJECT: General Order No. 40 and Denunzia Forms, Printing
TO : Civil Affairs Section, Attention: Major Reakes

1. With reference to the printing of General Order No. 40, and the denunzia forms, discussed with Major Reakes of the Civil Affairs Section and also with Lt. Bongarzone.
2. Lt. Bongarzone has indicated that AC can furnish the paper for printing the General Order, of which 35-40,000 copies will be required as there are 25,000 fractions (4,188 communes) in Northern Italy. Distribution will be made under the supervision of Civil Affairs Section, and a letter is going out to the Regional Commissioners asking that they indicate by signal to the Civil Affairs Section with copy to Agriculture Sub-Commission, the number of forms which will have to be supplied by this Headquarters.
3. Pending printing of the General Order, distribution is being made of mimeographed copies to regions concerned. Dr. Calzecchi has been asked to estimate the cost of printing 40,000 copies, and if he can quote an acceptable price he will be able to start printing immediately and complete the job in a reasonable length of time.
4. In connection with the denunzia forms, printing of which must be handled separately, Dr. Calzecchi is prepared to print 1,000 copies of each of the two forms, so that they can be distributed to the regions concerned for re-printing wherever possible, in order to make use of local stocks of paper and save unnecessary delays. Whatever quantity the Regional Commissioners will require from this Headquarters can be printed by Dr. Calzecchi if the paper can be furnished or located, under the supervision of Civil Affairs Section and Lt. Bongarzone.
5. Request approval of expenditure required to print 1,000 copies of each of the denunzia forms.

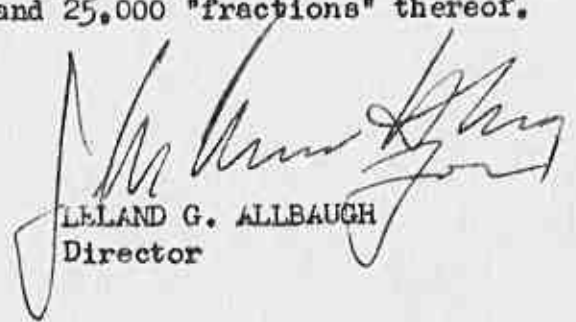
