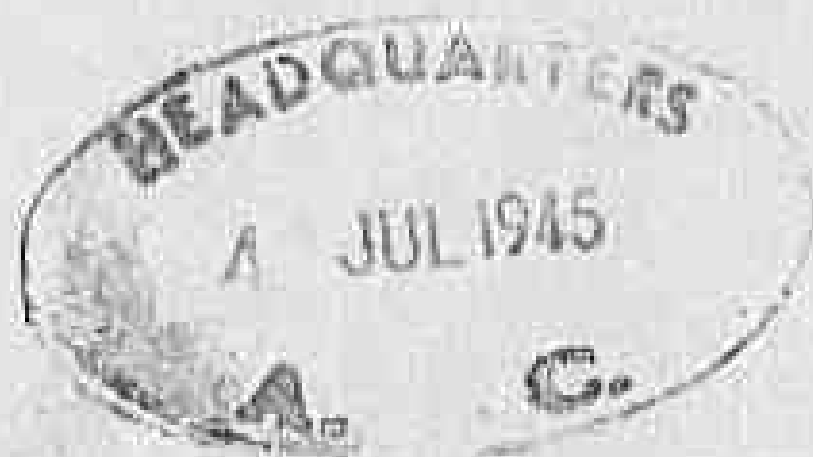

SUBJECT: Transport - Courier Service.

TO : Vice President, Civil Affairs Section.

1. With reference to the attached correspondence, the position at present is as follows.

2. By making use of special vehicles, Dispatch Office have to date cleared all proclamations, but until air courier service starts, it will be difficult for proclamations to be dispatched beyond the 5th and 8th Army Headquarters.

3. It is expected that when the air courier service commences, Dispatch Office will be in a position to deliver proclamations to Venetia and Lombardia Regions only. Arrangements will no doubt be made to run an air courier service to Piemonte and Liguria Regions, and pending this, it will be necessary to transport proclamations for those two Regions in a special vehicle.

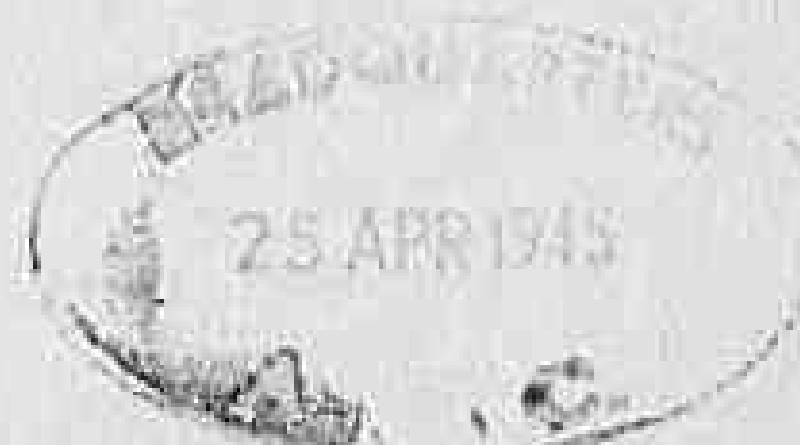

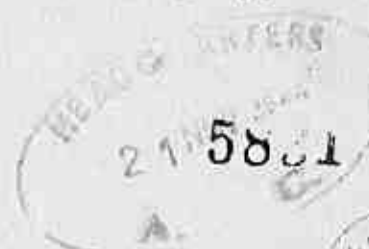
