SUBJECT: Channels of Communications

TO : Headquarters Allied Commission
APO 394

1. Since no enlisted men can remain in Sicily, as ordered by Acting Executive Commissioner, it is necessary to close the A.C. message center here.
2. Arrangements have been made with U.S. Naval Operating Base Palermo who have agreed to serve the A.C. officers remaining in Palermo Area. To facilitate handling, record and that all mail from your Headquarters for A.C. offices in Palermo Area should be placed in large covering envelope addressed to Allied Commission Liaison Officer, Palermo and despatched in the usual manner.
3. Naval Base here has also extended to us their signal facilities. Their call station is 11111. Please route your signal messages through them for the remaining A.C. offices in Palermo.
4. In view of para 3 above, there is no longer need here for the three Italian cipher P.C.O.'s. Any instructions be issued regarding them.
5. A considerable volume of signals and call is being received addressed to Allied Commission Offices which are no longer in existence, having closed on 26 MAR. Any action be taken to stop this. The offices that closed prior to 27 MAR 1945 are:

3. Naval Base here has also extended to us their signal facilities. Their call station is 1100K. Please route your signal messages through them for the remaining A.C. offices in Palermo.

4. In view of para 3 above, there is no longer need here for the three Italian cipher T.C.O.'s. My instructions be issued regarding them.
