SUBJECT: Radio Telephone Service to UNITED STATES.

TO : Chief Commissioner.

PLEASE PASS QUICKLY

1. The State Department, WASHINGTON, has given its consent to the re-opening of the Radio Telephone Service to the United States and we have now to nominate individuals in AG who will have authority to use it.

2. The service has so many restrictions attached to it that in my opinion it is almost worthless. For instance, the subject of conversation must not have bearing on the war effort or shipping, whilst only individuals already nominated the other end can answer a call.

3. However, the service may be put into operation at short notice now and I suggest for your consideration that in addition to yourself, your Vice Presidents and Political Advisers be authorised to make calls.

4. Permission can also be extended to diplomatic and consular representatives and the Italian Government. Political Section will make recommendations on these.

5. The establishment of this commercial undertaking appears to me to set a dangerous precedent.
