It has been decided to inform the Yugoslav Government that in view of the extent to which the Italian Government has now re-assumed control of Italian Territory, the Allied authorities are no longer competent to authorise the continued functioning of Yugoslav or Greek consular offices in Italy. These governments are therefore being informed through diplomatic channels that if they desire the continuance of these offices they must make the necessary arrangements with the Italian Government. The Italian Government is also being appropriately notified through diplomatic channels.
