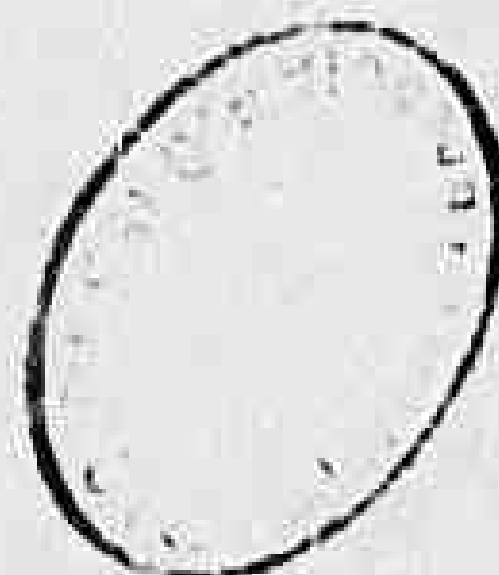

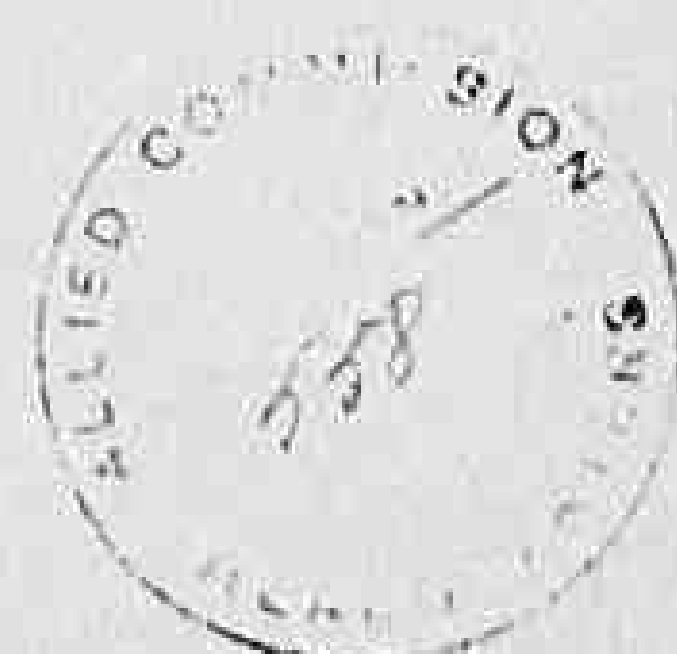
1. Letter circular 475/346/EC dated 21 December 1945 and 4755/EC dated 11 January 1946 on the above subject are rescinded.

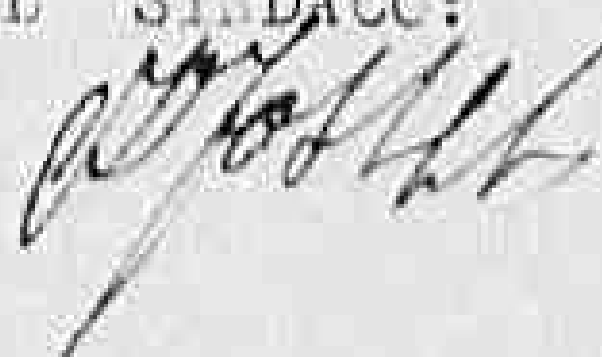

My dear Mr Prime Minister,

As you are aware, your Government took into custody in September the former German Embassy in Rome, the Villa Volkonsky. Your Government is therefore the trustee of this property on behalf of the four powers occupying Germany and holds it as such.

If Allied Force Headquarters move to Rome, it is desired to obtain the use of this villa for the Supreme Allied Commander. It is understood that no formal transfer of the property back to the Allied Commission for the temporary use of Rome Area Allied Command is necessary, but that as long as the trusteeship of property remains with your Government, the Allied authorities can obtain use of the premises for the desired length of time.

I would be most grateful, my dear Mr Prime Minister, if you would consider at your early convenience, permitting the Allied authorities the use of this villa for General Morgan in the event of the move.

SUBJECT: Deregquisitioning of Real Estate.

TO: Chairman
Accommodation Control Committee for Naples Area

1. The Accommodation Control Committee for Naples Area was made responsible for allocation of real estate in Naples Area by Staff Memorandum Number 16, this Headquarters, dated 25 September 1944.

2. The Committee will henceforth stress to all concerned the need for deregquisitioning real estate and its return to civilian control. All requests for additional requisitioning or the acquisition by another of real estate submitted for deregquisitioning will be carefully screened and approved only after thorough investigation convinces the Committee that the requirement is based on essential long range needs. Requests that only represent more desirable accommodations for temporary use, will not be honored.

3. It is again stressed that now the principal function of the Committee is to assure the return to the Italians of requisitioned real estate as promptly as possible.

BRITISH ADMINISTRATIVE INSTRUCTION NO.23

ACCOMMODATION IN ITALY

1. AFHQ Administrative Memorandum No.29 dated 8 Jul 44, announced the policy that the needs of all Italian agencies, whether commercial, governmental or private, are subordinate to those of the United Nations. There can be no change in this general policy which would prejudice the redeployment programme or affect the operational efficiency of the forces remaining in the theatre, or involve construction of alternative accommodation.

2. In order to assist in the rehabilitation of the governmental and economic life of ITALY, it is necessary that every consideration be given to well founded requirements of the Italian authorities. Civilian necessity for the rehabilitation of ITALY is paramount to Military convenience.

3. All commanders in ITALY having requisitioned property under their control, will, upon receipt of this instruction, take the following action:-

- (a) Investigate immediately the use which is being made of all requisitioned accommodation within their Command to determine the necessity for such use.
- (b) Review, from time to time, all accommodation held, in order to ensure the utmost economy of use and to release any accommodation the continued use of which cannot be justified as a Military necessity.
- (c) Derequisition all unoccupied real estate if no requirement is foreseen for it and derequisition all other accommodation, the occupancy or use of which is not warranted as a Military necessity. Every effort will be made to expedite the release of government administrative buildings, prisons, educational facilities, hospitals, hotels and warehouses.
- (d) Where practicable, consolidate two or more user organisations

well defined requirements of the Italian authorities. Civilian necessity for the rehabilitation of ITALY is paramount to Military convenience.

3. All commanders in ITALY having requisitioned property under their control, will, upon receipt of this Instruction, take the following action:-

(a) Investigate immediately the use which is being made of all requisitioned accommodation within their Command to determine the necessity for such use.

(b) Review, from time to time, all accommodation held, in order to ensure the utmost economy of use and to release any accommodation the continued use of which cannot be justified as a Military necessity.

(c) Deroqu Coast all unoccupied real estate if no requirement is foreseen for it and deroqu Coast all other accommodation, the occupancy or use of which is not warranted as a Military necessity. Every effort will be made to expedite the release of government Administrative buildings, prisons, educational facilities, hospitals, hotels and warehouses.

(d) Where practicable, consolidate two or more user organisations occupying individual sets of accommodation, in order to economise in accommodation and permit releasing the excess.

4. All requests for additional accommodation will be strictly scrutinized by authorities competent to requisition and no request for accommodation will be considered unless it contains complete justification. Normally, requests for additional accommodation will not be approved unless such accommodation is clearly a Military necessity.

5. All Authorities in ITALY competent to requisition, will, at all times, be able to justify the continued use of requisitioned accommodation if so required by this Headquarters.

6. This Instruction in no way affects the instructions contained in AFHQ Administrative Memorandum No. 14 of 7 Mar 45, subject "Use of Commercial Facilities for Civil Requirements" and in AFHQ Letter AG 004/171 C40-0 dated 14 Aug 45, subject "Release of Hotel Accommodations".

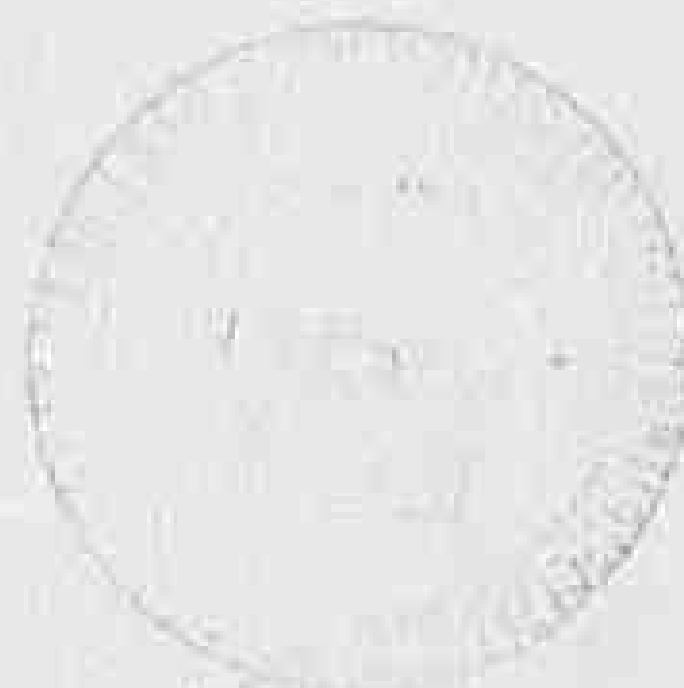
