SUBJECT: Italian State & Agents in US Territory

TO: All Consular Offices in US Territory and SACs

1. From time to time, questions arise as to the correct status and rights of individual members of the Italian civil service at present employed in Military Government Territory, U.S. questions as to an individual official's contract with or grade or correct status of pay or allowances. In general, such questions have or necessity to be referred to the appropriate Italian Ministry for advice, as the Ministry is the only body in possession of the knowledge requisite for a decision. It has been decided that in future all such questions may be dealt with or direct correspondence between the appropriate Ministry and the dependent Provincial State Office.

2. This decision is subject to the following limitations:-

- a) It is limited to matters having application to an individual only: it does not include direct correspondence with the appropriate Ministry upon questions having a general application to a class or group of officials; it is limited to the ascertainment of the true facts and of the Italian administrative law of practice applicable thereto in an individual case: it does not authorize Italian officials in any way to alter the existing position of the individual (e.g. to promote, demote or transfer him) without the consent of the Ministry.

3. All such communications from the President to the Ministry must, however, be sent through the channels. The necessity for strictly observing these channels must be firmly impressed on the Prefect and reassured taken to see that he adheres to them.

4. SACs/SAOs and IIs will place on all such communications a stamp or other indication containing the words "forwarded" or "sent" to indicate that the proper channels have been observed. SACs/SAOs and IIs are not required to examine in detail the President's proposals or to express any opinion on them, unless they have special reasons for doing so.

5. In all matters no instructions or directions of general application affecting the position or category of officials may be issued without prior consent of the Allied Command. Hence the issue of any general increase in pay or allowances, or of any bonus or indemnity to a group or section of employees must be approved by the Allied Commission.

not allowed to transmit correspondence with the appropriate authority upon questions relating to a request for extradition to a class or group of officials; it is also to be the responsibility of the two States and of the Italian Government to ensure that the extradition of a person to a third State is not effected in a manner which would be contrary to the existing situation of the individual concerned, or to the interests of the State of which he is a citizen.

3 All such communications from the President to the Ministry must, however, be sent through the Ministry. The necessity for strictly observing these channels must be firmly emphasized on the President and Ministers taken to see that he with-
to them.

4 The Ministry will place on all such communications a stamp or other mark indicating the words "forwarded" or "sent" to indicate that the communication has been received by the Ministry. The Ministry will also place a stamp or other mark on all such communications indicating the date and time of receipt.

SUBJECT: Italian State Employees in AMG Territory

TO : All Regional Finance Officers and
Senior Finance Officers.

1. It has been decided that all establishment questions affecting individual members of the Italian civil service at present employed in AMG territory shall in future be dealt with by direct correspondence between the parent ministry and the dependent provincial State office. This arrangement is limited to matters having individual application only, for example, seniority in grade, promotion, increments of salary, rates of travelling and subsistence allowances, retirement and pension, marriage and birth premiums, etc.

2. In AMG territory no instructions or directions of general application affecting a section or category of officials may be issued without prior consent of the Allied Commission. Hence the grant of any general increase in pay or allowances, or of any bonus or indemnity to a group or section of employees must be approved by the Allied Commission. ✓

3. Where salary, wage or pension changes of general application have been authorized in Italian Government territory, other than by decree and it is considered desirable that like treatment shall be applied in AMG territory, the proper Italian Ministry will furnish copies of the relative circular or instruction to the Finance Sub-Commission. If extension to AMG territory is approved the circular instructions will be sent through Allied official channels to Regional Finance Officers for delivery to the respective provincial State offices. By this arrangement Finance Officers will know that the salary or pension changes are authorized in AMG territory, and the instructions will be delivered without postal delays. ✓

4. These arrangements do not confer on the Italian Government any authority to finance provincial State offices or to issue credit or direct payment orders in AMG territory; except as already provided for expenditures chargeable to the budgets of the ministries of War, Marine and Air, the State Railways, the State Monopoly and to capitolo 202 in the budget of the Ministry of the Treasury.
