SUBJECT : Reports on Road Conditions.

TO : Distribution as below.

1. Five time to time reports are required as to condition of roads, bridges etc., and as the winter approaches it will be even more necessary to have the latest information covering roads before setting out.
2. The best way of obtaining this information is from officers who have returned from tours. To enable information in the reports to be collated, a questionnaire has been prepared. Officers should complete these in their return and forward direct to Public Works Sub-Commission.
3. The form should also give information as to routes taken, state of roads, bridges and any repairs necessary. It need not go into details but should contain enough information to guide others who may be taking the same route.
4. A Road Reports Bureau will be set up by Public Works Sub-Commission where officers may get up-to-date information before proceeding on a journey.
5. A copy of this questionnaire is being forwarded to Regional Commissioners in the expectation that they have or will set up similar Regional arrangements for collection of road information and place one of their headquarters officers in charge. Visiting officers would find information of this nature at Regional Headquarters most helpful.
6. Attached are ten copies of the pro form for your use. Additional copies may be secured from Road Reports Bureau, Public Works Sub-Commission.

- 2. The best way of obtaining this information is from officers who have returned from tours. To handle this problem in the reports to be collected, a system has been proposed. Officers should complete these on their return and forward direct to Public Works Sub-Commission.
- 3. The new form should give information as to route taken, state of roads, bridges and any other details. It need not be too detailed but should contain enough information to guide others who may be taking the same route.
- 4. A Road Review Bureau will be set up by Public Works Sub-Commission where officers may get up-to-date information before proceeding on a journey.
- 5. A copy of this Memorandum is being forwarded to Regional Commissioners in the expectation that they have or will set up similar Regional arrangements for collection of road information and place one of their headquarters officers in charge. Visiting officers would find information of this nature at Regional headquarters most helpful.
- 6. Attached are ten copies of this new form for your use. Additional copies may be secured from Road Reports Bureau, Public Works Sub-Commission.

  - b The proposed proforma will not be convenient if there is more than one indifferent or bad patch. On some roads there are a number of interruptions it would be difficult to report on many on the suggested form. I was wondering whether a tabulated form such as that attached might be more convenient.
- 3 Presumably Regions are already responsible for notifying this Hq of the conditions of roads in their areas, particularly if any become impassible, and this road report is merely used as a check up.
