Extract from my Monthly Report for February 1944.

d. Fascist Internees.

A recent instruction received from District 3 H.Q., states that approved internees are being released from 371 P.W. (Internment) Camp and they will be handed to the Provincial Officer, Salerno. The instructions go on to say that it is understood that Relief Camps exist for accommodating destitute persons.

I consider that these instructions should have come through Region 2 H.Q. I would also point out that there are no Relief Camps in this Province.

Up to date only a very few internees have been released and with one exception there has been no difficulty in disposing of them.

This, however, might become a problem if it is proposed to release large numbers of these internees.
