However, Mr. H. Coit MacLean has proceeded to Milan where he will eventually open the American consular office there and where he will have the rank of Consul General. Mr. Lester L. Schnare, Consul General, and Mr. Herman Moss, Vice Consul, have proceeded to Genoa where the American Consulate General will in due course be re-opened. I shall undertake to inform your office when any additional consular personnel may proceed to Army areas to re-open American consular offices there.

1. Reference is made to your letter, subject as above, of 2 April 1945, enclosing Memorandum of 31 March. The Commission is of the opinion that the attachment of political advisors with the occupational forces, both in the northwest and in the northeast of Italy, is highly desirable, provided suitable personnel can be made available. The British ambassador has agreed to make available one or two officers and the American Ambassador has also offered to supply one or two officers either from the POLAD office, AFHQ and/or American Embassy.

2. In order to provide for their billeting, rationing and transport, the political advisors designated to accompany the Allied occupational troops into Milan should be attached administratively to the Allied Commission and on call and moved forward by the Commission to the headquarters of the occupying troops in accordance with the operational pattern as it may develop. The Allied Commission is presently dealing direct, for planning purposes, with the task force designate with this mission.

3. Similar arrangements might be carried out with respect to political advisors who may be designated to accompany the occupational troops into northeast Italy. Any special arrangements could be made by the Commission with 15th Army Group or any task force which may be specially designated.

The Consul General will perform the usual consular functions on behalf of British Nationals and Regional Commissioners should submit any communications or enquiries from British Nationals to him.
2. The area for which the Consulate General will be responsible is that covered by Regions II (excluding BARI) III and VII. The Province of Bari and the Island of Sicily may be added to the Consulate General's responsibilities but no decision has yet been taken on this.
3. Mr. Consul-General Swan is in charge assisted by Mr. B.J. Garnett, Mr. J.M. Fisher and Mr. W. Parkin of His Majesty's Foreign Service.
