I HAVE ALREADY SENT WORD TO THE PRIME MINISTER EXPRESSING THE HOPE THAT THE GOVERNMENT WILL DO THEIR UTMOST TO STOP THEM A COURSE WHICH I AM SURE DE CASPERI WILL WILLINGLY FOLLOW.
