CONSEQUENT ON THE DEMONSTRATIONS IN ROME ON SATURDAY SIXTH JULY PROTESTING AGAINST THE DECISIONS OF THE COUNCIL OF FOUR IN PARIS MINOR INCIDENTS OCCURRED OF ANTI-ALLIED NATURE IN THE PIAZZA VENEZIA. THE PRESS ALSO REPORTS SIMILAR EXPRESSIONS OF ANTI-ALLIED SENTIMENT IN PADUA. IN VIEW OF THE GENERAL SENSE OF DISILLUSIONMENT WHICH IS THE RESULT OF THE REPORTED DECISIONS IN PARIS WE MUST EXPECT THESE SPORADIC ACTS. I HAVE ALREADY SENT WORD TO THE PRIME MINISTER EXPRESSING THE HOPE THAT THE GOVERNMENT WILL DO THEIR UTMOST TO STOP THEM A COURSE WHICH I AM SURE DE GASPERI WILL WILLINGLY FOLLOW. I DO NOT YET REGARD THEM AS SERIOUS
