Subject: Defascistization

1. Reference is to your letters of 27 July, 7 August and 11 August 44 under your file reference F13/IX/368.
2. It is noted that under each section, State Railways, Railways in Concession, and Motorisation, you have set up several separate commissions.
3. Please let me have a complete statement showing the commissions now set up, with personnel, under each heading; and the actual functions of each separate commission, with indication of the levels at which they are working.
4. It will be appreciated that the attention of the appropriate commission should be directed to the higher officials under your jurisdiction, both at Headquarters and in the Districts.
5. A full explanation of methods being employed by each commission, and a report as to progress, is desired. A progress report not later than the Friday of each week in respect of each commission is requested.
6. Kindly let me have your assurance when replying to the above questions that the Progress Report will be submitted.

SUBJECT: Sanctions Against Fascism,

TO: Communications Sub-Commission,

Reference your 08/57/1/70 of 9 Aug.

- 1 It may not at first be clear that a suspension made prior to the new decree was not made because the person was then "the subject of separation proceedings" but was made solely because the man was a fascist. He might in the future become the subject of proceedings but that is not the same thing. You will appreciate therefore that Art 22 applies only to suspensions made under the decree that is to those made after the decree came into force by the commissions set up thereunder.
- 2 The payment of persons suspended prior to the coming into force of the decree is governed by a directive issued by the Minister of Finance after consultation with and with the concurrence of the Finance Sub-Commission from whom you can obtain full particulars.
- 3 I do not quite see what your objection to Art 22 is, it seems to be quite equitable, a man suspended is not deprived of his basic pay until he has been found guilty. As has been explained, the section has nothing to do with those suspended prior to the decree whose pay is governed by another instruction.
- 4 I do not understand why you suggest that no more suspensions should be made now, what is the objection, persons suspended get pay.
- 5 The intention is to proceed with defascizing as quickly as possible and this will involve further suspensions. If therefore this letter has not cleared up your difficulty perhaps you would see me because frankly I do not entirely understand your point.

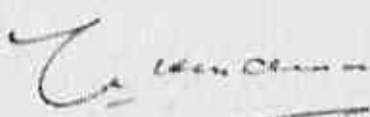

4. It is the opinion of this Sub-Commission that no further suspensions should be made until the above question is decided.

2. No executive action has been taken against individuals belonging to national ministries except that the Director-General of Posts and Telegraphs has been given 3 months sick leave, from 15th July.

1. The orders of the Regional Commissioner Rome Region do not apply to the employees of the Central Administration of the Department of Posts and Telegraphs.
2. In the case of the Head Office of National or para-statal institutions, action is being reserved until the recommendations are received from the Committee for Defascistization that is being set up by the Ministry of Communications.
3. Should you consider it desirable in the meantime to suspend from employment any individual or class of individuals pending the completion of the proceedings of the Committee, you are requested to make such recommendation to this office, when it will be immediately considered and instructions given as to your further action.

1. The routine for dealing with classes of employees in the Rome area is clearly defined in A/CC 250.
2. Presumably similar divisions of responsibility are being made for other areas, but this has not, as far as I am aware, been the subject of a specific instruction.
3. The case has arisen of the S.E.T. concessionary telephone company, which covers the whole of South Italy and Sicily, which has its Head Office in Naples. Similar cases will doubtless arise of other utility services.
4. Presumably the employees whose duties lie within the Naples commune will be dealt with by a local Committee, while the staff of the Head Office will be dealt with by a superior Committee.
5. I should be glad of a statement defining this, and, to avoid any difference of dealing with the matter by the Regional Commissioner Region III, I should be grateful if that Office (and other Regional Commissioners) could be notified of the correct routine.
