1. Action taken by ARS in the past and that was to be taken by the Station Defection/Defection Commission (DDC) was independent and unconnected.

SUBJECT:- Pellegrino

1. I have to inform you that the very serious charges against Pellegrino for collaborating with the Germans against the Allies in September '43 pending the fall of the military tribunal at Naples, have been disposed of by the instructional judge, and he has been acquitted of all charges.

2. These charges were as you will recall brought under certain sections of the military penal code of war and have no connection with the expiration decree of the 27th July, '44.

3. While these charges were pending against him, expiration procedures under Part II of the expiration decree which deals merely with dismissal were quite properly suspended, but I have this day agreed with the Italian Government that these expiration proceedings shall now continue; they will be given a high priority and the deputy High Commissioner for Expiration has undertaken that they will be brought to a conclusion one way or another as soon as possible.

SUBJECT : Defascism.TO : Regional Commissioner, Region I. (Attn: RLO).

Reference your RLS 013.21 of 26 Jun to CLO.

- 1 Admin Sec is now responsible for policy and supervising defascism and is therefore replying to your letter.
- 2 Action taken by AMG in the past and the decision of an Italian Defascising Commission (IDC) are independant and unrelated. The AMG order should not be revoked and is in no way affected by any finding of the IDC.
- 3 The IDC is competent to consider the case of Italian officials whether or not they have been removed from office by an AMG order and should most certainly consider the cases of those who have been so removed, as in Italian law they are only suspended from duty and if "guilty" their employment must for the protection of the Italian Government itself, be terminated.
- 4 Where an official has been removed from office by us as a fascist and the IDC finds that he is not a fascist, the IDC should be prepared to consider any new evidence and if satisfied that the AMG order on the basis of the new evidence was not justified, revoke the same where upon the official will become available for re-employment (we are very short of competent officials especially in the forward areas) but he will not be appointed to replace an AMG appointed official.
- 5 A list of officials barred by AMG should certainly be handed over as should any other information which will assist the Italians to get on with defascising, which can without breach of security be communicated.
- 6 The IDC's advice that Dr. GALIBO's case should be considered by the IDC is approved. In the event that they should find Dr GALIBO "innocent", he can then consider the evidence available and decide whether or not to revoke the previous order.
- 7 A directive on defascism is in course of preparation.

MEMO to Admin. Sec.

The attached correspondence from Region 1, while involving an isolated case raises the policy question of what attitude the AGC should take with regard to defascistization of persons who were removed from public office by AGC officials during the period of occupancy.

Many people were removed from office on the basis of being fascists, hostility to the Allies, inefficiency etc. Frequently the officers who removed them are no longer available in this theatre and irrespective of that frequently there is nothing of record to show the reasons for their removal.

Having been removed, the Italian Government cannot reemploy them without AGC's consent. However, removal from office by AGC probably from a legal standpoint is in effect only a suspension, so that the civil servant retains his civil service status but is inactive. If that is so he would seem to be subject to defascistization under the Italian RDE as amended.

There would seem to be three possible courses of action to be taken in this type of case looking at it as representative of many others, i.e. a general class.

(a) Each individual case may be studied in the Region in which it arose and if as the result of such examination there is some doubt as to propriety of the removal on fascist grounds to withdraw the removal order in advance or at least to do so provisionally upon the Commission clearing this individual.

(b) Permit the Commissions to consider cases with the understanding that if on review by AGC locally the decision is approved the removal order will be revoked. This involves retention of a veto power.

(c) To come to an understanding immediately on a general basis that if removed persons are cleared of fascist taint as the result of a Commission's action, the prior removal will be considered automatically revoked without further action by AGC.

It would have to be clearly understood that whichever method or combination of methods is pursued, it shall not apply to internees nor shall any clearing serve to reinstate the individual in any position held by an appointee of AGC without express approval of AGC.

Method (a) requires a great deal of effort on the part of limited personnel who would be in a position in Italian Government territory to deal with such matters and as above stated, records or knowledge as to

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Dismissals are frequently non-existent so that for intelligent action a separate inquiry would have to be made concerning the individual.

Method (b) aside from other possible defects involves a detailed examination of records of Commissions and through lack of qualified personnel alone is not feasible.

Assuming that Commissions act fairly, method (c) would seem to be the most workable, particularly if all civil servants had been removed only because of fascist connections. However, some civil servants were removed for reasons of inefficiency, hostility etc. They might easily prove before a Commission that they should not be defascistized. Yet should they be allowed to return to active service? Probably this class is not numerous and in Italian Government territory their return to active service would not likely do any harm to the Allied war effort.

The entire matter should be considered as a matter of policy to be pursued, entailing quite possibly some discussion with the Italian officials in charge of Defascistization in order that a workable formula may be produced and a directive sent out.

SUBJECT : Persons barred from Public Office

TO : Chief Legal Officer - A.C.C. Headquarters (REAR)

1. Sometime in December 1943, Major Robert N. Gorman the then Senior Civil Affairs Officer of the Province of Palermo issued a directive to the effect that any civilian who had held certain posts in the Fascist Party were to be barred from public office.

2. A certain Dr. Michelangelo Galioto was included in a list of those who were subsequently put out of office by an order of the Senior Civil Affairs Officer in accordance with the above mentioned directive.

3. The leaders of the Partito D'Azione called upon Colonel A.N. Hancock, Regional Commissioner, and pointed out that there had been some mistake in that Dr. Galioto did not fall within the categories stated in the directive issued by the Senior Civil Affairs Officer of Palermo. The Regional Commissioner then advised that the matter should be decided by the Defascistization Commission.

4. The High Commissioner S.E. Musotto now makes the request that before this matter is submitted to the Commission that the order issued in December by the Senior Civil Affairs Officer should be first revoked, otherwise the action of the Commission might result in nullifying a previous order of the Allied Government.

5. The Regional Commissioner has asked this office for a ruling on the following points:-

(a) Whether or not the order of the Senior Civil Affairs Officer be revoked?

(b) If revoked whether or not the list of persons who were barred from office should be turned over to the Defascistization Commission for any action they deem necessary?

(c) Whether or not the Defascistization Commission is authorized to pass and take any appropriate action on the list of persons barred from Public Office by the Allied Government even though the previous order has not been revoked.

6. This office has expressed no opinion in this matter because it is one of general policy and therefore is submitted to you for consideration.

- d) Ispettori Federali.  
(Federal Inspectors).

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- e) Segretari Politici e Vice Segretari Politici.  
(Political Secretaries and Vice Political Secretaries).
- f) Gli ufficiali della Milizia Volontaria Sicurezza Nazionale ordinaria.  
(Officers of the ordinary National Safety Voluntary Militia).
- g) Gli squadristi, "mercia su Roma", e "Scolerpe littorie".
- h) I fascisti comunque riconosciuti colpevoli di attentati alla libertà individuale.  
(All fascists found guilty of having repressed individual liberty).

3. Will you please investigate as to whether any officials of the communes under your control have held posts as above.
