General Order No. 1

Suspension of fascist officials and employees

WHEREAS it is the policy of the Allied Military Government that persons who were in positions of responsibility during the fascist régime or have since 8th September 1943 collaborated with the enemy shall be removed from office;

AND WHEREAS the Italian Government has undertaken such removal and has enacted laws further implementing decrees for that purpose;

AND WHEREAS it is the intention of the Allied Military Government that without delay the suspension from office of all persons affected shall become effective forthwith.

NOW THEREFORE I, ELLERY W. STONE, COMMODORE USNR for and on behalf of the Allied Military Government, hereby order as follows:
