REPLYING OF INFORMATION

All the provincial Delegations (including those in the Regions not yet restored to Italian Administration) have been ordered to nominate the members representing this

High Commissioner to the respective Commissions, and transmit the nominations to the Delegations of the Ministries of Grace and Justice and of the Interior. (General procurators for the Courts of Appeal to deal with the Military, objects to deal with the Chemists, Doctors, Veterinaries and chemists and first presidents of the Courts of Appeal to deal with other professions).

For the present we have received no orders for the appointment of the above Commission save the following, which were appointed by the First President of the Court of Appeal of Rome: Lawyers and Procurators (One Commission and two Sub-commissions), doctors, accountants, Bankers, Engineers, Chemists and Notaries.

PUBLIC EDUCATION

Each provincial Delegate has been requested to give two nominations for the constitution of a provincial Commission for the operation of elementary school teachers and other two nominations for a Commission for the operation of intermediate school teachers.

As of today the following Delegations have replied: AVELLO - CHIETI - VITERBO - L'AQUILA - ALESSANDRIA - VERDIANO - ROMA - CANTALIMBERTA - FIRENZE - NAROLI - AVELLO - SANZANO - SALERNO - REGGIO CALABRIA.

The nominations given by the above delegations have been transmitted to the Ministry of Public Education for the issue of the decree of appointment.

TRANSPORT

Three sub-commissions have been constituted for the operation of the personnel of FF.SS. (State Railroads) and of the Civil Motor Transport for the relevant Department. One sub-commission has been formed for the department of Reggio Calabria; 5 of the Department of Florence.

Nominations have been requested for Sub-Commissions at Naples, Bari and Cagliari.

Summarizing therefore, in 42 provinces are already operating the provincial Commissions contemplated by art 18 - 3rd para - of DL 155 of 27 Jul 1944; in three provinces are already operating the departmental Commissions for Transport; and in the city of Rome already several Commissions are operating, as said before, for the operation of those registered in the register of professions.

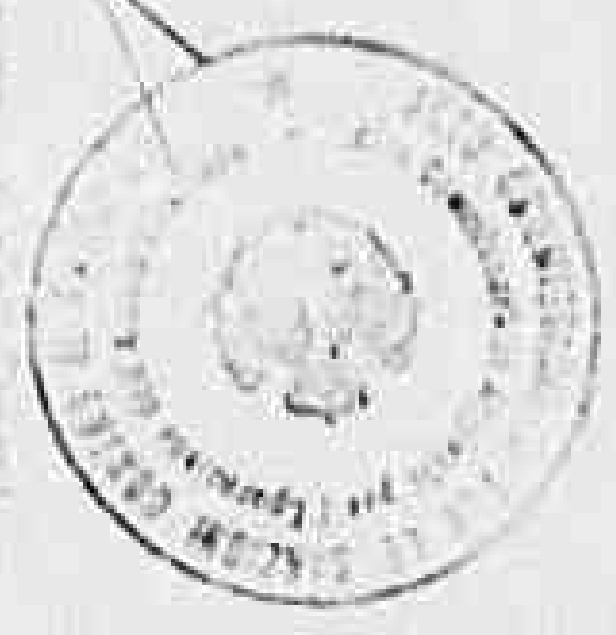

In reference with the conference I had with you on 22nd March last I wish to inform you, as I explained already to Brigadier General J.S. Upjohn, that besides the Commissions set up in every provincial capital as contemplated in the Para of art. 15 of the 159 of 27 July 1944, the High Commissioner feels the need for creating sub-commissions of first instance holding office in the province, for the purpose of directing and expediting the work of operations. These sub-commissions would have the task of operating the personnel of State administrations and independent bodies when such personnel was large and belonged to different registers even in the same administration.

For the present this need is felt for the employees of communications and public education.

As regards communications, the matter has been taken up with the respective Ministry, and although a decision has not been reached in connection with the Post office personnel, the question of the Transport personnel has been settled. Hence the respective sub-commissions have either been or are now being formed and require only the decree of appointment to be issued by the respective Minister, or are waiting for the nomination of their members by the Provincial Delegates for operations, by the Provincial Committees of National Liberation and by the Department office of the Administration concerned.

In reference with the conference I had with you on 23rd March last, I wish to inform you, as I explained already to Dr. Beller, General G.M. Ugochi, that besides the Commissions set up in every province, called a *comitato provinciale*, in view of art 18 of D.L. 159 of 27 July 1944, the High Commissioner feels the need for creating sub-commissions of first instance holding office in the province, for the purpose of assisting and expediting the work of separation. These sub-commissions would have the task of examining the personnel of State administrations and independent bodies when such personnel was large and belonged to different registers even in the same administrative unit.

For the present this need is felt for the employees of communications and public education.

As regards communications, the matter has been taken up with the respective Ministry, and although a decision has not been reached in connection with the most office personnel, the question of the Transport personnel has been settled. Hence the respective sub-commissions have either been or are now being formed and require only the decree of appointment to be issued by the respective Minister, or are waiting for the nomination of their members by the Provincial Delegates for evaluation, by the Provincial Committees of National Liberation and by the Government office of the Administration concerned.

The Commissions are composed of: a President (regular and substitute) and one member (regular and substitute - administrative official) and another member (regular and substitute) representing the Deputy High Commissioner, and appointed by myself.

Besides three sub-commissions already operating at Palermo and one at Reggio Calabria, five sub-commissions have been appointed to the provinces controlled by the ASD for the Railway Department at Florence, while nominations have been requested for proposal to the Minister in charge of the Naples and Ancona Departments. As the personnel employed in the latter is very large it is believed that four sub-commissions will be required, including one for civil motor transport.

A sub-commission is also being appointed at Florence for the employees of the T.E.T.I. (Telephone service).

As regards Public Education, two sub-commissions are being created for each province, including those under the ASD. One will deal with the intermediated schools and the other with the elementary schools. For the present, only those for Naples and Florence have been requested, while as regards all the others still controlled by ASD, we are waiting for the members to be nominated in the manner explained above.

I wish to inform also that steps are already being taken to set up special provincial commissions of first instance (not sub-commissions), for the separation of persons registered in the register for professions. The members are appointed by the local judicial authorities, delegated for the purpose by the Ministry of Grace and Justice, according to the usual system of nomination by or to my delegate.

In Florence a Commission is being appointed by the Minister of the Treasury for the Istituto di Credito Agrario per la Toscana.

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5 The principal cause of the delay in appointing provincial commissions is the requirement that a judge sit on all commissions, nearly 150 commissions (mostly central) have already been appointed and so many magistrates have been withdrawn from normal work that the administration of justice is being interfered with, to a halt has had to be called. Nearly 100 more commissions are required to meet central and provincial requirements. It is hoped that the appointment of commissions will soon be resumed.

This power is intended to exercise especially for the transportation, communication and education services. Where such divisions sit in AMG territory AMG is responsible for seeing that they do their jobs.

7 The HG is represented at the Provincial level by a Delegate who in addition to other duties is a liaison of local to keep the HG informed on local conditions. Circular No 4 of 7 Jan 45 from the Assistant High CommissionerPROVINCIAL OPERATION

- 1 The SO will be represented in all provinces by a Delegate responsible for conducting preliminary investigations and preparing cases for submission to execution commissions. The Delegate should, where possible, have his office in the prefecture and work in close collaboration with the Prefect.
He will compile registers and lists of employees and the information available as to such employees with which the responsible heads of all services are responsible for supplying him.
- 2 The evidence collected will
 - a) if it concerns persons comparable centrally, be submitted to the SO (unless there is a division of an appropriate central execution commission sitting provincially, when it will be sent to that commission).
 - b) If the evidence refers to persons more or less provincially it will be forwarded to the appropriate provincial commission; but if a provincial commission has not been established, it will be retained for transmission when the commission has been set up.
- 3 The Delegate may recommend suspension; if the Prefect does not agree he will inform the SO and the SO will then refer the matter to the SO (in any territory to the appropriate SO officer).
- 4 The Delegate shall be responsible for such degree of supervision over the work of commissioning as may be necessary to prevent interference, pressure or favour. If any such is attempted it will be reported to the SO (in any territory to the appropriate SO officer).
- 5 The Delegate will supervise decisions of commissions setting provincially and forward them to the SO with his comments. The period within which an appeal must be lodged will commence on the date on which the SO receives the decision, considered; but the Delegate will nevertheless give notice of appeal in all cases where he is of opinion that an appeal should be lodged, leaving the SO to withdraw the appeal if, in his opinion, it is not justified.
- 6 With the appointment of Delegates in the capitals of all provinces local execution may be said to have begun. If execution is to be effective it is necessary that the Delegate should be able to act on the collaboration of the Prefect and himself and on the assistance of the democratic parties and of the public. The Prefect will be responsible for replacing himself where cooperation in execution cannot be relied upon. If his territory it will be a good ground for asking him to change a delegate.
- 7 It is intended that party and public cooperation shall be channelled through the local SOs. The public must become accustomed to the idea of public responsibility. It may be channelled by means of meetings, articles in the press and public notices. All information received from the public must be signed. No attention will be paid to anonymous denunciations or intrigue.

When the registration has been completed, the registration shall be retained for transmission.

1 The Delegate may propose a resolution if the President does not agree he will inform the Delegate that the resolution is not in the interest of the Party or the Party's officers.

2 The Delegate shall be responsible for such degree of support as may be necessary to prevent interference, pressure or favor. If any such is attempted it will be reported to the President and the Delegate will be removed from the Party.

3 The Delegate will constitute the one of Candidates sitting previously and forward them to the President. The period within which an appeal must be lodged will commence on the date on which the Delegate receives the decision concerned; but the Delegate will nevertheless give notice of appeal at all times where he is of opinion that an appeal should be lodged, leaving the President to withdraw the appeal if, in his opinion, it is not justified.

4 With the appointment of Delegates in the interests of all previous local operations may be said to have begun. If operation is to be effective it is necessary that the Delegate should be able to act on the consolidation of the President and should on the assistance of the Democratic Party and of the public. The President will be responsible for replacing himself whose operation in operation cannot be relied upon. (In the territory it will be a good ground for acting and to change a situation).

5 It is intended that party and public cooperation shall be demanded through the Local Party. The public and party cooperation to the idea of public responsibility, it may be demanded by means of meetings, articles in the press and public relations. All information received from the public must be signed. It is intended that it should be used to carry out demonstrations or intrigues.

6 Judging Candidates will be provided over by a magistrate and composed of persons who have lived or no connection with the locality but local citizens who are extremely locally because of their identity and who can be relied upon for justice and impartiality and who are not corruptible by favour or bribes may be admitted. Delegates and Presidents of the territory will forward the names of any such persons they are appointed to the President.

7 The object of having Provincial Delegates is to ensure that the President of the Council of Ministers is to ensure their practices and authority. All previously appointed Provincial Delegates are dissolved but will already have been and utilized if it complies with the law and the co-ordinating regulations.

8 The Delegate, through personally the representative of the President, will also supervise and for the other three branches of the Party against

1. MIL 139 "Sanctions against Fascism" was published on July 29. A translation has already been circulated for distribution down to Provincial Commissioners.
2. The decree has already been extended to Military Government Territory which is under Regional Control and all Regional Orders or other instructions on this subject will no longer be enforced.
3. The decree which is in six parts, deals with three main classes of cases:
 - a. Part I declares certain political acts committed in the past to be crimes against the state, sets up courts to try such cases and lays down the punishments.
 - b. Part II provides the machinery for investigating the political background of officials and of employees of national command of local bodies and directs the removal from office or employment of those with fascist sympathies.
 - c. Part III provides for the investigation of cases of "enrichment" and for forfeiture of property where no satisfactory explanation of "enrichment" is forthcoming.
 - d. The other three parts are of an administrative nature.
4. So far as ACC is concerned 3a and 3c are for the time being regarded as matters domestic to the Italian people though ACC may have to take supervisory steps later; but, ACC is pledged (as is the Italian Government) to remove fascists and to clear Italian administration and industry of fascism. 3b therefore is very much the concern of ACC.
5. The decree provides for the setting up in every Ministry of a commission which is responsible for investigating the political history and in appropriate cases attending with not only the officials of that Ministry

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 - a. Part I declares certain political acts omitted in the past to be crimes against the state, sets up courts to try such cases and lays down the punishments.
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 - d. The other three parts are of an administrative nature.
4. So far as ACC is concerned 3a and 3c are for the time being regarded as matters domestic to the Italian people though ACC may have to take supervisory steps later; but, ACC is pledged (as is the Italian Government) to remove fascists and to clear Italian administration and industry of fascism. 3b therefore in very much the concern of ACC.
5. The decree provides for the setting up in every Ministry of a commission which is responsible for investigating the political history and in appropriate cases dismissing or otherwise dealing with not only the officials of that Ministry down to junior officials in rural areas but of all employees of national concerns for which under Italian law the Ministries are responsible, again right down to the branch offices.
6. At HQ ACC the appropriate Sub-Commission is responsible for ensuring that defascism is effectively carried out by these Commissions (vol 2 of A/CC 250 of 15 Jul). Though these Sub Comms will be notified by the Ministerial Commissions of persons dismissed that will give them no picture of the persons remaining in Regions who ought to be but have not been dealt with, nor with the rate at which defascism is proceeding; for this information they must rely upon reports from Regions. At Regional level Regional Commissioner will be responsible for supervising the progress of defascism; he will ensure that his divisional officials keep him and Sub-Comm fully informed of the progress of defascism and in particular report persons who should be but have not been dealt with and and that any dismissals ordered are effectively carried out.

7. The decree also provides for the setting up in every province of a Provincial Commission which is responsible for dealing with the officers and employees of local bodies, welfare institutions and the like which are under the control of provinces or enterprises and do not come directly under any Ministry.

8. The responsibility for supervising the progress of defascistizing by the Provincial Commissions devolves upon the Regional Commissioner. Instructions as to the returns required to enable progress to be watched will be the subject of a separate communication.

9. The usual distinction between military and Italian Government territory will apply; namely that in the former the responsible officer can direct the prefect to set up a commission and ensure that it functions; in the latter he can only advise and press. In the latter case if no satisfactory response is obtained, the matter will be reported so that IN AQ (which has received the Italian Government's undertaking that defascistizing will be dealt with expeditiously) can through that Government bring pressure to bear on the defaulting party.

10. It is important that as much progress as possible should be made in areas seen to be restored to the Italian Government. If it is possible to get provincial commissions formed and functioning before the Italian Government takes over, much time will be saved.

11. Nothing in this decree affects the right of a GA officer in Military Government territory to remove any Italian officials from their employment whether for fascism, incompetence, corruption or for any other reason.

In Army areas in particular, it is important that the directions contained in Decree 67 should continue to be effectively applied.
