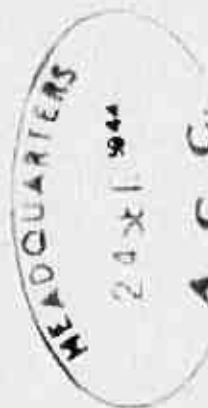

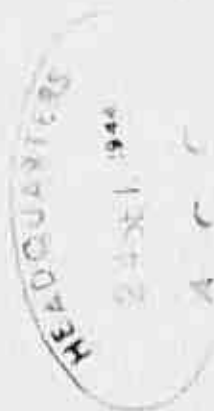

1. I am informed that after seven fascist employees of the PERUGIA REAR CO had been dismissed orders for their re-instatement were given by a Lt JOHNSON.
2. It is the policy of this HQ that defascism is a matter domestic to the Italian people and that our only function is to see that it is in fact carried out.
3. It is quite contrary to AOC policy to intervene on behalf of fascists, the only exception to this rule is that of an irreplaceable technical expert whose dismissal might affect the operational efficiency of the Army. Fascists who have been dismissed under domestic arrangements will not be retained or re-instated by CA officers as a mere matter of convenience.
4. Will you please enquire whether this report relates to Lt JOHNSON of your Agricultural Division who is now it is believed at Perugia and if so take such steps as may be necessary to ensure that AOC policy is followed and that the dismissal referred to become effective.
