1. If the personnel engaged are directly employed in a permanent State office, or an office dependent on a provincial State office - they must be regarded as temporary employees of the Italian State, and paid accordingly to the scales laid down for this class of employee - i.e. irrespective of the mode of payment, etc.

The considerations mentioned in minute 1st are taken into account in framing these scales, and any attempt to establish special rates of pay for particular sections of non-the-scale personnel must be resisted, as such an action would upset the whole structure of the scales of salaries, wages and pensions of public employees.

The pay of temporary civil servants in Great Britain is not fixed according to the rates paid for similar type of work by private employees.

2. It is agreed that if the personnel engaged were the direct employees of ASAC and were paid out of ASAC funds, they would be paid wages according to the ASAC scales of pay for private employees.

The question does not arise however for the personnel concerned are paid out of Italian State funds and must be classified as public employees and paid accordingly.

The reimbursement of expenses for members and staff of Municipal Commissions formed under DLI 159 is authorized by the Council of Ministers in Circular 6548/10124/3/11-1-7 dated 28 January 1945.

The "General Administrative Instructions Pursuant to General Order No. 35" prescribe the compensation of members of a Commission and staff. The principle of paying on an equal basis with a public employee performing comparable work is supportable.

Many members of these commissions and their staffs will be composed of public employees and the setting up of a different scale for those recruited from outside sources will only cause dissatisfaction by reason of the fact that these public employees will receive no extra compensation for their work.

It is requested therefore that 72-A be withdrawn.

Subsequent to Minute 10 above, Italian Decrees No. 123 and 328 have been implemented in Northern Italy with retroactive effect as from 1st May 1945. These decrees provide for increases in remuneration of State and para-State employees.

It is suggested that Evacuation Commission staffs who are said to be eligible for payment at rates appropriate to "public employees doing similar work" should indirectly benefit by the implementation of the above mentioned decrees and that the increases now provided should form a satisfactory basis of payments.

It is proposed to implement Decree No. 116 in Northern Italy with effect from 1st August 1945; when this has been done State employees in the North will enjoy the same rates of remuneration and pensions as those in the South.

SUBJECT: Revision of Expiration Proceedings.

TO: 1 20th Lombardina, Piemonte, Liguria, Venetia Regions.

1 IL 702 is being implemented in North Italy. 20 35 Conclusions will be supplied with copies and be informed that except as mentioned below they will in future only suspend persons whose past record is such that they believe that they will eventually be dismissed under IL 702.

2 It has been agreed with the Italian Government that persons suspended by IL 702 will not be re-instituted without going through expiration proceedings. All therefore must re-examine all suspensions of officials of lower grade than the 7th with a view to cancelling suspensions of all persons who will not be dismissable under the new terms of IL 702. It should not be overlooked that in addition to being expirable under Art 2 of IL 702 officials of the lower grades may also be expirable under para 2 of Art 1 if they have shown serious conduct bias.

3 It may be desirable to form a revision board to re-examine suspensions by the light of IL 702. This will still have a discretion to keep persons suspended if their return to duty is likely to cause trouble even if they are not expirable under IL 702, but that cases should be regarded as quite exceptional. It should be recognized that such action is but a postponement of the difficulty if the man is not expirable under IL 702 the expiration examination will in due course have to be held. Further it is unfair to the man to keep him suspended if he is not expirable. It is hoped that no such suspensions will be left for the Italian Government to deal with after the transfer.

4 Suspensions of the "deferred" category will be dealt with first. No further examination of the schools of the "deferred" category will be undertaken even to see if any persons whose schools have not yet been examined may be expirable under IL 702 until all proceedings against the higher category are completed. 277

5 The "reinstated" category will be dealt with next. Persons suspended will be divided into three classes - a) will also include the examination of which is not complete -

- a) Grades 5 - 7
- b) Grades 8 and 9 (except school teachers)

1. The Assistant High Commissioner for Operations now wishes, with the approval of this Headquarters, to commence in North Italy, operation under DE 159 and the decrees do enact therefrom which, as you are aware, have already been implemented.
2. Owing to the particular wording of Article 25 of DE 159, you will notice that the time limits within which proceedings must be concluded does not begin to run until after the restoration of the territory to Italian administration but this does not prevent the commencement of proceedings under the decrees.
3. The High Commissioner has laid down, with the approval of this HQ, that the cases of persons who have been suspended shall be dealt with in priority of all other cases. Will you please see that this priority is observed and in this connection the Provincial Delegates are as much answerable to you and under your control as are other Italian officials in AMG territory.
4. The coming into operation of DE 159 is not in itself any reason for suspension of activity under GO 35 or GO 46. The activities under these orders correspond to the investigatory phase under DE 159 and it will naturally be some weeks after the Provincial Delegate commences his own investigatory proceedings before he is in a position to complete his own investigations. GO 35 Commissions will, therefore, continue to investigate the cases before them and to suspend persons where they think that course desirable.
5. When DE 159 Commissions have completely dealt with the cases of persons suspended under GO 35 (that is, when DE 159 has 'caught up' with GO 35) there will be no further reason for the continuation of the GO 35 Commissions and they will then be abolished.

- 6 A new operation decree No. 702 has been passed and appeared in Gazette No. 136 of 13 Nov 45 but its implementation in ASO territory is under consideration. By this decree officials of grades lower than the 7th are not separable unless they fall within certain classes and all suspensions of such officials are revoked. GO 35 Commissions are only the vanguard of DL 159; and the reasons for suspension in GO 35 are the same as those for dismissal in DL 159. As officials of grades lower than the 7th are no longer normally dismissable and their suspensions are revoked by the new decree there is no reason for continuing, in ASO territory, the suspensions already ordered of these classes of officials. You will, therefore, take such action as may be necessary to terminate, subject to your own discretion as mentioned in 18/3.32/DA of 10 Nov 45, the suspensions of all persons in the "deferred" category of GO 35.
- 7 You will suspend action with regard to officials within the "routine" category of GO 35 (including all school teachers) until you receive a copy of the text of the decree. The cases of all Grade 8 - 9 officials and school teachers will be examined by the GO 35 Commissions to see if any of these should be dealt with under any of the special clauses under Art 2 of the new decree. If so, their suspensions will not be revoked but that of officers not within these classes will be revoked subject to your discretion.
- 8 You will please arrange for GO 35 Commissions to hand over to the Provincial Delegates the School Personnel and other documents relative to all officials of Grades 1 - 7 who have been suspended and also officials of lower grades who in your opinion should be proceeded against under Art 2 of the new decree.
- 9 Future statistical returns will include only officials in the grades 1 - 7 (including analogous civilian ranks) plus the relatively few officials of lesser grades who are being especially proceeded against.
- 10 Have appropriate instructions as to GO 35 apply also to GO 46.

- 1 Under the Italian Government's new proposals for defascinating which are expected to come into force at a fairly early date, officials of grades lower than 7 will no longer be liable to dismissal. You will accordingly instruct GO 35 Commissions that they will hereafter take no further steps whatever with regard to investigating the cases of or suspending officials of the deferred class.
- 2 Your attention is strongly called to clause 16 of the Administrative Instructions issued with GO 35 and especially to the second paragraph thereof which appears to be being completely ignored by GO 35 Commissions.
- 3 Returns under GO 35 for the month ending 31 Oct 45 and the subsequent returns will show only two categories - immediate and routine.
- 4 Persons of the deferred class who have been suspended will normally be re-instated but if serious friction is likely to ensue, you have a discretion to continue the suspension. You will bear in mind however that it is not intended to exercise any such discrimination outside AMG territory as the decree proposes to abolish all suspensions of officials lower than Grade 7 and even to permit the re-employment of suspended persons of Grade 7 or higher where the Department or Management thinks fit.
- 5 On the hereover, schedule of persons in the deferred class will not be handed over.
- 6 Instructions as to Grades 8 and 9 officials will be communicated to you later when the decree is actually passed, but no case of a grade 8 or 9 official will be dealt with unless and until all cases of senior officials have been completed (vide clause 16 of the Instructions).

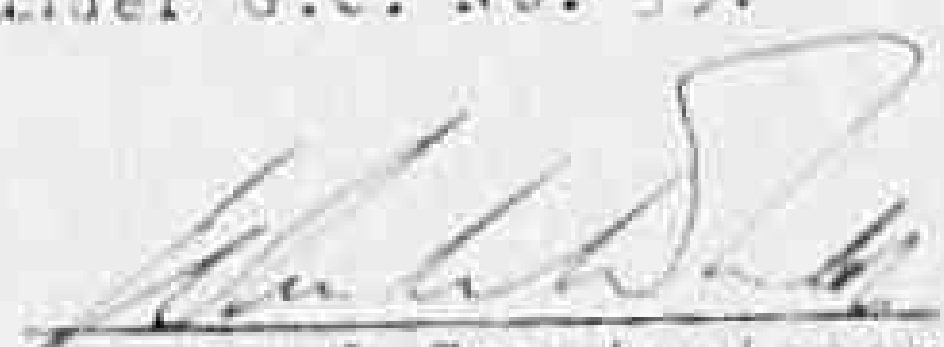

- 1 I enclose a copy of a letter addressed by the Detention Commission of the Commandation Ministry sitting in Milan to the CMA of Genoa, No 346/30/0/0 of 12 Jul. The letter is quite desirable except for the fifth paragraph.
- 2 00 35 was not drawn to allow persons of one Region being operated by the Commission of another. It is not administratively sound that notices and orders signed by an officer of one region should apply inside another. 00 35 also allows a personal hearing. A central hearing in Milan is neither reasonable nor practical; such a ruling would in practice deny the right specifically granted by the Order.
00 35 also lays down who shall be responsible for the collection and extradition of whole personnel. The Commission has no power to vary the Order by directing that they shall be dealt with in some other way (e.g. be submitted by CMA) nor to require that evidence and documents shall be submitted to CMA.
- 3 The Commission of the Commandation Ministry will be instructed to withdraw the paragraph referred to. Arrangements must be made for local considerations. When 10 100 comes into force, Detentionists under that decree to determine Dismissals can and should sit centrally; the regulations provide for it - but that is another matter.

1. In the Region of Liguria, and particularly affecting the city of Genoa, it is estimated that approximately 1500 Railway employees were summarily dismissed from employment by the C.I.N.

2. The "Il Tribuno del Popolo" a Genovese newspaper of 20 July 1945, page 2 column 2 & 3, contained two separate letters of comment. One deplored the fact that the Provincial Epuration Commission at Palazzo Ducale (Genoa) had not received a single Scheda Personale stating this was contrary to the provisions of GO 35. That letter went on to point out the hardships that had resulted.

3. The second letter was quite rebellious as a result of the situation and asked the pertinent question of the Editor as to what was his conception of "Epuration" and went on to ask if it is possible to epurate non criminal personnel who are non-collaborationists, then would it not be possible for the CLN to carry out the wishes of the workers committee and re-instate these epurated without waiting the actions and decisions of the GO 35 Epuration Committees.

4. A few days ago an employee of the Railway called at the Legal Division of this HQ. and stated that when he had gone to the President of the Epuration Committee under GO 35 he was informed that his committee had no jurisdiction to undertake such epuration. On receipt of this advice the R.L.O. called in the chairman of the Legal Committee of the CLN who could give no explanation. Later on discussing the matter this chairman stated he had had a conversation with the President of the Epuration Committee and was shown a letter from the secretary for the commission of the Communication Ministry of Milan. An English translation of this letter is enclosed for your information.

5. As result of this letter it now appears that no action has been taken by the local commission under GO 35 in respect to Railway Employees by way of Epuration or reviews for re-instatement.

Commission at Palazzo Ducale (Genoa) had not received a single Scheda Personale stating this was contrary to the provisions of GO 35. That letter went on to point out the hardships that had resulted.

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4. 5. As result of this letter it now appears that no action has been taken by the local commission under GO 35 in respect to Railway Employees by way of Epuration or reviews for re-instatement.

6. This HQ. had no knowledge of the such inactivity on the part of the Epuration Committee or of the existence of any such letter para 4 until 3 or 4 days ago. It would therefore be appreciated if this HQ. could be fully advised.

7. The immediate protest in Genoa was that they objected to submission to such an Epuration Commission stating they couldn't get witnesses to Milan, that such Commission could not know the former political and social factors under which they lived and in any event objected to central direction and rule from Milan.

We wish to inform you that the AMG on the 14 June of the running year has appointed Mr. Mario Pliets as Commissioner for the Transport and Railway Ministry, to supervise and look after, (among the other matters) the enforcement of the orders issued by the AMG concerning epuration of personnel depending from the Railway Administration.

As it appears that some District C.I.N. carry out arbitrarily functions exceeding those of a simply advisory character which have been admitted by the AMG we ask them to comply with the above written provisions.

Consequently no measure of an exceptional character and which however does not come under the existing laws may be enforced without the previous exam and approval from this Commissioner in accordance with the Allied Authority.

The only schede which are legal for the epuration of the depending personnel are the ones which have been distributed sometimes ago by the AMG. Therefore no striking out adding or change of any kind is allowed in connection with the queries included in the original schede.

As it appears that some District C.I.N. carry out arbitrarily functions exceeding those of a simply advisory character which have been admitted by the A.G. we ask them to comply with the above written provisions.

Consequently no measure of an exceptional character and which however does not come under the existing laws may be enforced without the previous exam and approval from this Commissioner in accordance with the Allied Authority.

The only schede which are legal for the epuration of the depending personnel are the ones which have been distributed sometimes ago by the AMG. Therefore no striking out adding or change of any kind is allowed in connection with the queries included in the original schede.

The said schede, after having been properly filled up by the interested persons shall be forwarded through the district CLN as already stated in the note number 5126/CC/PL/S. of the 5/7/45 to the Provincial Epuration Commission of Milan together with all possible probatory documents and with the closely examined statements, if any, which may better enlighten judgement.

Several important questions concerning the interpretation and application of various provisions of order 35 have been presented by provincial officers and provincial operation commissions. Some of these have been covered by previous directives and instructions. In the interest of uniformity, supplemental administrative instructions will be issued from time to time, as needed for the attention of provincial commissions and through them for the operation commissions in each province.

1. Treatment of "pre-8 September" regular civil-service employees who were forced to pledge allegiance to the Fascist Republican Government.

Article II (a) of General Order 35 provides that any person who has pledged allegiance to the Republican Fascist Government shall be suspended from service.

Several provincial operation commissions feel that injustices are likely to occur if this provision is applied universally to all "pre 8 Sept. 1943" employees who were forced as a condition of retaining employment to swear allegiance to the Fascist Republican Government.

Provision for taking into account extenuating circumstances in cases of this type is contained in Circular No. 1 in the booklet of instructions for operation commissions entitled "Gestione del Funzionari e degli Impiegati Fascisti" issued by the Allied Commission February 1945.

It is recommended that operation commissions in each province, in accordance with the general rules set forth in Circular No. 1 exempt from suspension persons who:

- a. were full time civil service officials or employees, employed in the same type of position in North Italy prior to 8 September, 1943;
- b. belong to a category of officials or employees which, as an entirety, was forced to take the oath as a condition of retaining employment;
- c. does not fall within any of the other categories of Fascist activity set forth in Article II, and
- d. is otherwise unobjectionable to the operation commission.

2. AUXILIARY AGENTS OF QUESTORS

It is reported from some provinces that "auxiliary" agents of questors

were forced to pledge allegiance to the Fascist Italian Government.

Article II (c) of General Order 35 provides that any person who has pledged allegiance to the Republican Fascist Government shall be suspended from service.

Several provincial epuration commissions feel that injustices are likely to occur if this provision is applied universally to all "pre 8 Sept. 1943" employees who were forced as a condition of retaining employment to swear allegiance to the Fascist Italian Government.

Provision for taking into account extenuating circumstances in cases of this type is contained in Circular No. 1 in the booklet of instructions for epuration commissions entitled "Sospensioni del Funzionari e degli impiegati Fascisti" issued by the Allied Commission February 1945.

It is recommended that epuration commissions in each province, in accordance with the general rules set forth in Circular No. 1 exempt from suspension persons who:

- a. were full time civil service officials or employees, employed in the same type of position in North Italy prior to 8 September, 1943;
- b. belong to a category of officials or employees which as an entirety was forced to take the oath as a condition of retaining employment;
- c. does not fall within any of the other categories of Fascist activity set forth in Article II, and
- d. is otherwise unobjectionable to the epuration commission.

2. "AUXILIARY" AGENTS OF QUESTURA

It is reported from some provinces that "auxiliary" agents of questura appointed after 8 September are still being kept in office. This result may be partly due to the fact that until very recently epuration commissions could not act with respect to the "Category Postponed" in which these auxiliary agents fall. Now that the "Category Postponed" has been made subject to all the requirements of order No. 35, epuration commissions should proceed to deal immediately with questura agents as the nature of their work makes epuration imperative.

All auxiliaries hired after 8 September 1943, should either be suspended forthwith, or if in the category of temporary employees (arventizi) be dismissed immediately under Order No. 35 A. The permanent agents will be epurated as are all other categories of public employees.

3. Reports from Epuration Commissions

Epuration Commissions in each province are henceforth required to submit in duplicate to the provincial Commissioner a monthly report showing:

- a. Total number of suspension and dismissals made during the month.

b. The names of all persons suspended or dismissed showing title of position, cause for dismissal or suspension and date of the Commission's order with respect to each.

One such copy will be retained by the provincial Commissioner and the other will be forwarded to the Regional Expropriation Officer.

4. Provincial Expropriation Commissions appointed under General Order No. 35 have no authority to deal with cases of undue enrichment under the Fascist Regime. This subject is covered by part III of D.L.L. 159 and subsequent Decrees, the operation of which is the responsibility of the special branch of the department of the High Commissioner for Sanctions under the Italian Government, and not of A.M.C. or A.C. If in the course of their investigations into matters which are within their competence, the Provincial Expropriation Commissions come across facts which indicate that action under part III of D.L.L. 159 may be desirable, they should report such facts to the Intendente di Finanze as a basis for further action by the Italian Government at a later date.

- 1 The points raised by your RIX/LB/78011/38 of 10 June are dealt with in para 5 of Circular No 1 at p. 33 of the Handbook for Expiration Commissions and in para 5 of Circular No 2 on p. 37. An English Summary of the contents of these circulars was distributed to all Regions under DP/3.32/CA of 1 Feb.
- 2 It is true that there is more than one form of oath. The oath of fidelity and loyalty referred to in the circulars is the oath administered to Senior Government Officials and does not refer to that taken on a large scale by quite minor officials (who alternatively would probably be covered by para 5 of circular No 2) which is the oath to the Republic (not the Government) and is not within the intention or wording of the order.
- 3 As mentioned in the preface to the handbook and implied by the letter referred to above, expiration is to be carried out in the spirit of the High Commissioners circulars. GO 35 is based on IL 159.
- 4 It is thought that these circulars sufficiently answer your enquiries.

1. Section (e) of Art. II of the above General Order states in substance that persons who have pledged allegiance to the Republican Fascist Government shall be suspended from service.

2. Many persons in this Province employed by various organizations took an oath to the "Repubblica Sociale Italiana". As an example, I append copy of such an oath taken by employees of the Ferrovie dello Stato, who have several thousand employees. I have seen a directive of this company to its personnel, which states that they must sign such an oath or be dismissed.

3. There are, in my judgment, many thousands of employees who have taken such an oath and who will, either under General Order No. 35 or D.L.L. 150, be subject to suspension or dismissal. The extent of this may be such that some agencies or concerns may have to suspend operations for lack of employees.

4. I have discussed with a number of Italian officials the difference, if any, between "Republican Fascist Government" and "Repubblica Sociale Italiana". It appears that members of the P.N.R. took an oath directly to the Republican Fascist Government. Other persons took an oath to the Repubblica Sociale Italiana as shown in the attached paper. If any distinction can be made, it would appear that one oath is to the Government and the other to the Republic.

5. Under the circumstances please advise me if taking the oath attached hereto is cause for mandatory suspension under Section (e) of Art. II.

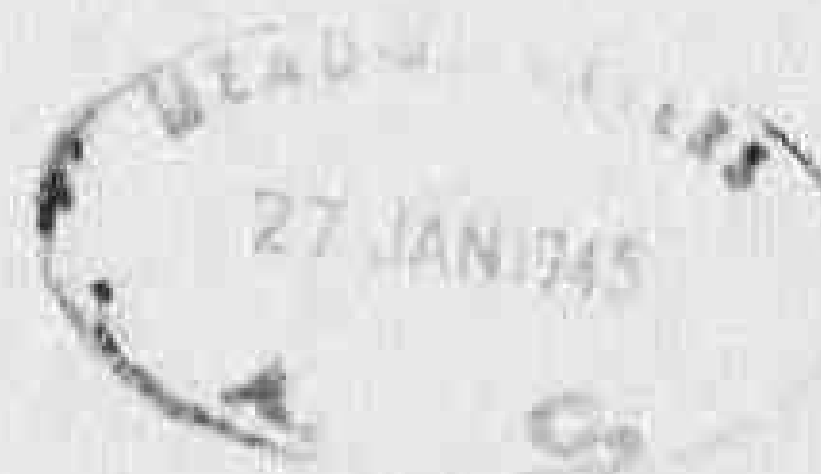

- 1 Reference your RS/507/3 of 18 Jan. As DL 159 has been implemented in Pesaro it is considered that confusion would be likely to be occasioned if GO 35 were put into operation at the same time. The High Commissioner has been asked to expedite the setting up of the Italian Separation Commission.
- 2 The Provincial Commissions are responsible only for defascising employees of the smaller and purely local concerns, they cannot defascise employees of Government departments or of concerns of national importance. The latter are defascisable centrally; the non-appointment of provincial commissions in no way stops their operation. What has delayed matters is not the non-appointment of provincial commissions but lack of transport which has delayed the sending of central representatives down to conduct investigation locally.
- 3 The High Commissioner is hoping to get over some of this difficulty by appointing divisions of the "central" commission to sit locally especially for the transportation, communication and education services.

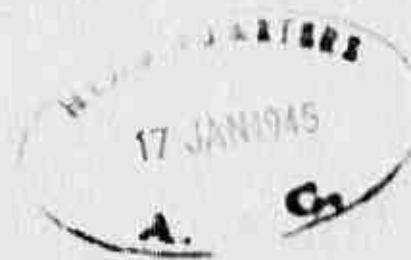

1. The Commission is extremely reluctant to authorise the posting of General Order 35 where the Italian Government Decree D.M. 159 is already working, unless there is evidence of a complete breakdown of their system.

2. I am therefore proposing to bring pressure to bear on the Italian Government to expedite the functioning of the Commission in Pesara Province and will endeavour to find out why they have failed to take action so far; it is, I suspect, because of the change of Government and the change of the High Commissioner and Assistant High Commissioner for Emigration. 1. I do not think that you need be unduly alarmed at the delay involved in putting G.O. 35 into effect. Having obtained authority from this Headquarters to put G.O. 35 into effect it is only necessary for you to instruct any given Provincial Commissioner to publish a Provincial Order putting it into operation.

Copies of the Order and Administrative Instructions have been sent to you and therefore there does not seem to be any ground for anticipating a delay.

2. As I pointed out at the last Siena meeting (see Minutes, para 6) the real object of G.O. 35 was to provide for an epurational procedure in the north where it is to be expected that there will be substantial delays before the Italian Government can appoint Commissions.

In Tuscany Commissions have already been appointed under D.L. 159 and are working, and it would be very unfortunate if we introduced yet another system in the absence of a complete breakdown of this system in your Region, and I think that G.O. 35 should only be instituted in existing liberated areas until after a solemn warning to the Government that they are failing lamentably to carry out their duties, citing specific instances of such failure.

3. Accordingly I would prefer to leave the matter where it is until you have evidence of a complete breakdown of the Government's procedure.

1. It was my understand^{ed} from the discussion at the last Regional Commissioners' conference in Siena that General Order No. 35 was to be made operative only when Provincial Commissioners or AMG were being criticized for failure to remove fascists promptly.
2. I have explained the situation to Provincial Commissioners. There are no specific instances in this Region of criticism for failure to act against fascists in territory under Regional control.
3. I now understand from my Legal Officer that there are two steps in putting General Order No. 35 into effect. First, the Region must apply for authority to put it into effect and publish a Regional Order authorizing Provincial Commissioners to invoke General Order No. 35. Second, Provincial Commissioners, if and when situations arise thereafter which make the use of General Order No. 35 advisable, should post General Order No. 35 and publish a Provincial Order announcing that it will be put into operation as of a certain date.
4. Since the object of General Order No. 35 is to facilitate prompt action if and when the Italian channels of epuration fail, I hereby apply for authority from the Allied Commission to put General Order No. 35 into effect in Toscana Region with the understanding that it will be put into effect in any particular Province only when the necessity for its use in that Province arises.
