With further reference to this office letter DF/3.32/1/CA of 25 Aug and your AC/BOL/LQ/E/1 of 29 Aug.

- 1 Col THOMAS was asked for the names of three officers who had served in Bologna to obtain the statistics required but the names sent are of two officers who have already left the theatre and the third cannot be spared from his present functions.
- 2 There is no alternative but to ask for the temporary services of one of your officers. The work will not be whole time but it will involve his visiting the GO 35 Separation Commission at each Provincial Capital pointing out what is wrong with their returns and what is required and arranging for the new returns to be submitted and sent on to this HQ.
- 3 The time occupied will not be long in each town and there is no reason why on his tour he should not undertake other work for you. His tour can be arranged to suit your convenience so long as all cities are visited within a reasonable time.
- 4 It would however be necessary to spend one afternoon in this office to receive his instructions.
- 5 Will you please detail an officer for this duty. He will proceed to Rome by air and can if desired return the next morning.

- 1 The Suspension returns attached to your monthly report are returned here- with with comments for re-submission after correction.
- 2 It was not intended that separate returns should be submitted for each province and far less that this HQ should receive a return from each Commission.
- 3 It is the Regional Commissioner's function to criticize provincial returns and the Provincial Commissioner's function to deal with individual Commissions. All that is required from a Region is one aggregate return showing the progress of the Region as a whole. It is possibly fortunate that the provincial returns have been submitted as guidance appears to be needed.
- 4 Detailed criticism is shown on each form. The following is general com- ment.
 - a) A fairly general fault seems to have been that Commissions have ignored the priorities Immediate Routine and Deferred. According to many of the returns even Deferred cases have been heard before "immediate" cases have been cleared off.
 - b) In hardly any of the returns is it clear how many tribunals are engaged in hearing cases.
 - c) The total objections plus "suspensions - no objection having been lodged" should generally agree with or be slightly less than "suspensions proposed". It cannot be greater. In not one return do these agree and in only one case is there any approximation.
 - d) Suspensions ordered under the heading of objections should agree with "by order" under the heading of suspensions. In only two of the 9 returns does it do so.
 - e) The distribution of work varies very greatly. Schedules per tribunal vary from 2600 to only just over 300, and yet the tribunal with only 300 has only heard one case. Some commissions have heard over 50 cases. The number of commissions should have been regulated so that they had approx- imately the same task.

Dear Colonel Bowman,

Col SPICER has passed to me your enquiry as to the introduction of defascism in certain parts of Emilia as this is a matter with which this Section deals.

First of all there is Exec Memo 67. This is in the process of being re-written and the schedules are being slightly widened which will enable a little more to be done under it than was possible in the past.

Then there is IL 159. this and its amending decrees can be implemented in Army Areas by SCAOs whenever they wish; but this has the drawback that the machinery works through officials of the Italian Government who, to carry out their function, will need to correspond fairly freely with the High Commissioner in Rome and this for security reasons may not be desirable in Army areas.

Lastly there is GO 35. It has been laid down that this shall not be brought into use without first obtaining approval of this HQ. The object of GO 35 is to provide machinery to enable defascising to proceed where conditions are not suitable for epuration under IL 159. It acts by way of suspending individuals until such time as IL 159 can be implemented and their cases be considered under that decree.

If you are of opinion that it is now desirable to commence on epuration and that it is not desirable to implement IL 159 perhaps you will submit your recommendations together with the reasons which lead to your conclusions.
