SUBJECT : Illegal profits of Fascists.

TO : HEADQUARTERS

Brescia, 16 July 1945

In August 1943 the Badoglio Government passed a law N° 720 of 9/8/43, setting up commissions to deal with illegal Fascist profits.

Curiously the Fascist Republican Government confirmed this law and up to August 1944 a commission sat in Brescia and worked on enquiries.

This law is now cancelled and replaced by Part.3 of DLL 159 of July 27 1944.

There are now in the archives of the Court of Appeal at Brescia between 2000 and 3000 files dealing with prominent fascists all over Italy.

The Primo Presidente suggests that the High Commissioner for actions against fascism be informed and be requested to send transport to Brescia and to collect these files and take them to Rome for distribution at Rome among the Provincial Commission set up by Art. 30 of DLL No. 159

Do you think these files relating to AMG territory should be treated separately and distributed through AMG channels to the Presidente of the various Tribunali for immediate action under art. 35 of DLL 159 or would it better to get the whole lot distributed at Rome ?

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The Commission here has put in a great deal of work and there is undoubtedly most valuable information in these files, on which a speedy action could be taken.

- 1 Two general methods of removal of undesirable personnel by IAG have been authorized - Ex. Memo 67 and GO 35. It is considered undesirable that any other general method should be used.
- 2 Where persons have been suspended by some other machinery, it is desirable that the earliest opportunity should be taken of having these cases dealt with under GO 35.
- 3 Care should be taken that excessive suspensions do not destroy the efficiency of the service.

SUBJECT: Epuration of Guardia Forestale

TO : Vice-President, Civil Affairs Section
Att: Lt. Colonel White

1. Reference your DF/3.43/CA of 7 July 1945 and previous correspondence.

2. Regarding action taken by Major Bump in Lombardia Region in connection with suspensions. In accordance with our AGR/171 of 30 June, the matter was fully discussed at the Milano Conference of the Regional Agricultural Officers on 5 July. The following is quoted from the minutes of that meeting:

"Suspension of Guardia Forestale personnel has been carried out to insure the operating efficiency of the organization by action through the Legion Commanders to suspend with pay all categories of personnel considered undesirable. The same procedure is followed in any instance where the agricultural official in office cannot carry on the functions of that office and must be removed by the supervisory officer, for reasons of technical inefficiencies or is 'persona non grata'."

3. The matter was further discussed with Colonel Poletti Regional Commissioner, who indicated his concurrence in the desirability of suspending categories of personnel considered undesirable. The matter has assumed more than ordinary importance, insofar as Guardia Forestale has been concerned, for they were quite prominent in political activities which made them so unpopular with the residents that their suspension had to be effected without delay, for their presence in the offices was causing severe and justifiable criticism of the technical efficiency of the remaining personnel.

4. It seems to be clear that Major Bump took more than ordinary drastic measures in order to insure the suspension of undesirable personnel, but also that his action did not in any way affect such action as may be required under the terms of G.O. 35 and directives thereunder.

In accordance with arrangements made early in May, he is authorized to travel in the various regions of the North, in order to make available a Forestry Officer in areas where none is permanently assigned. To such extent as he operates in regions other than Emilia Region, it has been established that he will operate under the jurisdiction of the Regional Commissioner of the region concerned.
3. No information is at hand in regard to notices of suspension indicated. I will see Major Bump in Milan on Monday and obtain full information, which will be forwarded to you upon my return later in the week.
