POC Supplying for non vehicle, other purposes

17 SEP 1944

1. All POC Supplies are distributed on a Provincial basis and are made available as a result of bids sent by Regions to HQ AEC before the 10th of the month prior to that in which they are required. They are relayed to Petroleum Section APO and their allocation is made known to Regions and Provinces about the 25th of the month.

2. Bids must be based on actual requirements substantiated by facts and must be carefully screened by Regions before submission. Bids are further considered by Petroleum Section APO and it is in connection necessary to cut them down when allocation is made.

3. When Sub-Committees of this HQ are interested in new propositions, or are sponsoring State-controlled or semi State-controlled concerns which involve the use of POC for non-vehicular purposes they will not make application to the Commerce Sub-Committee for supplies of POC but will request the Regional Supply Officer (in duplicate copy to Commerce Sub-Committee) to include the requirements and justification in the monthly bid of the Province concerned. A letter of backing to the Regional Supply Officer will assist him in deciding on the merits of an application, which may well have nation-wide implications.

4. Small propositions in rare cases arise at such short notice that they cannot be included in the monthly bid, application must still be made to the Regional Supply Officer who will have to make his decision on the availability of his current stocks.

5. Commerce Sub-Committee, who perform liaison duties between Petroleum Section APO and AEC, have neither the staff nor facilities to handle demands by Sub-Committees of their HQ, which often amount to retail quantities and involve questions of urgent delivery. Only monthly and supplementary Provincial and Regional bids will be dealt with by Commerce Sub-Committee.

When Sub-Commission of this BC are interested in new proposals, or are operating State-controlled or semi-State-controlled enterprises which involve the use of PGL for non-substantive purposes they will not send application to the Commerce Sub-Commission for approval of PGL but will request the Regional Supply Officers (in duplicate copy to Commerce Sub-Commission) to include the requirements and justification in the monthly bid of the Province concerned. A letter of backing to the Regional Supply Officer will assist him in deciding on the merits of an application, which may well have nation-wide implications.

4. Should proposals in more cases arise at such short notice that they cannot be included in the monthly bid, application must still be made to the Regional Supply Officer who will have to make the bid, which he can available out of his cushion stock.

5. Commerce Sub-Commission, who perform liaison duties between Petroleum Section AFHQ and ABC, have selected the staff for facilities to handle demands by Sub-Commissions of this BC, which often amount to retail quantities and involve questions of urgent delivery. Only monthly and supplementary Provincial and Regional bids will be dealt with by Commerce Sub-Commission.

SUBJECT: PGL Supplies for Ministerial, Vatican and Diplomatic Corps

TO : ALL SUBCOMMISSIONS
FROM: Economic Section

1. With the Italian Government concentrated in Rome, it is necessary to put the supply of PGL for the above and kindred purposes on a firm basis.
2. By arrangement with Commerce Subcommission and the approval of Petroleum Section, AMHQ, the Italian Government have appointed an Inter-Ministerial Committee for Petroleum under the Ministry of Industry, Commerce and Labour, who present bids for all Petroleum products for civilian use on behalf of the various Ministries with a separate bid for the requirements of Ministerial Vehicles operated by them.
3. Each Ministry, including those for Air, War and Marine, should therefore now submit their requirements for Ministerial Vehicles to the Petroleum Committee (Avv. ROSSIGNI) of the Ministry of Industry, Commerce and Labour Inter-Ministerial Committee. Supplies for purely Air Force, Military or Naval purposes should be bid for as before by M.A.I.A.
4. It is requested that subcommissions who have dealings with the Italian Government Ministries will make known to them these arrangements and impress on them that no requests by individual Ministries or by individuals can be entertained.

1. Your Excellency's letter No. 718 of 5 July 44 on the subject of Petroleum Allocations has been passed over to this Sub-Commission which deals with these matters.

2. In order to take care of requirements of vehicles operated by Italian Government Ministries, an Inter-Ministerial Committee for Petroleum has been set up and is supervised by the Ministry of Industry, Commerce and Labour.

3. The individual Ministries submit their monthly requirements to the Inter-Ministerial Committee who submit a consolidated request to us. The resulting allocation is handled and controlled by the Inter-Ministerial Committee who are then able to meet the requirements of all Ministerial vehicles.

4. It is requested, therefore, that you will arrange for your requirements through them.
