Dear Colonel,

With reference to letters D.F./6.34/C.A. and D.F./6.A/C.A. dated 27 May and 5 June, I am sending you the two returns relative to the period prior to 31 May, pointing out that the figures contained in the return of the central Administrations refer to the officials of all grades and not only to those belonging to a grade higher than the ninth, since this office has organized its work of statistics in such a way that it cannot distinguish with sufficient precision the personnel by grade. However, I assure you that I have already given orders to the central administrations to furnish the necessary data to this office in order that they may be forwarded to the Commission in the shortest time possible.

At the same time I wish to inform you that the return on operations in the provinces is not complete since not all the provinces have sent the figures requested from them; I shall do my best to send you the figures relative to the other provinces as soon as they arrive in this office. In regard to the return of provincial Bodies (Enti) it is not possible for me to send you any figures in spite of the many urgent requests to the provincial delegations.

In the meeting which I shall have with the provincial delegates whom I have invited, I shall give the necessary instructions in order to remove ^{all the} difficulties.

Dear Colonel,

With reference to letter DF/6.A/CA of 20 April I wish to inform you that I have taken account of the proposed changes in the statistical form, which I approve fully.

I take this opportunity to inform you that I have already instructed the competent offices to collect the data requested by the A.C. However, in so far as the provincial commissions are concerned, we cannot be too sure that the request will be complied with with rapidity, due to difficulties of communications. This may be due also to the fact that many Commissions formed recently are still in the organizational stage.

I should like to know if, contrary to what has been done hitherto by the A.C. in connection with the various Departments, the data requested must refer only to officials with a grade higher than the 9th or to all those subject to epuration. I ask this with the end in view of avoiding misunderstandings in complying with the request.

I hope, at any rate, that in spite of the requested correction, I shall be able to furnish the statistical data concerning the central administrations up to 15 April by the end of the month - as agreed.

I shall await your reply.

Your Excellency,

Now that AUC Officers are withdrawn from Italian Govt Territory this Commission having no means of watching the Progress of Provincial commissions has to ask you to supply it periodically with information.

There are two classes of Commissions and therefore two different classes of returns are required, one for persons accountable by Ministerial Commissions including sub-Commissions sitting provincially and one for persons accountable by the Provincial Commissions.

As regards the former the information desired is that indicated by the headings on the accompanying proforma.

With regard to Provincial Commissions, the same form will suffice but instead of showing Ministries in Col (a) it is suggested that the totals should be shown by compartment. Another type of information is however also necessary in order to enable progress in the provinces to be judged and that is the number of each of the various types and the number of each of those types in which operation has been finished. A suggestion as to what is in mind is enclosed.

As the time limits are so short it will I am afraid be necessary to ask for these returns fortnightly otherwise progress cannot be effectively watched. The returns would be for the totals on 1st and 15th of each month and it is desired that they should reach this office not more than a fortnight later.

I shall be glad to discuss these proposals with your statistical Officer both with a view to explaining any point which may not be clear to him and of discussing any modification of these proposals which may be desired either to meet any difficulty or to make the return more useful.

As a result of the former in which the internal administrative details of the German State-Administration has developed the original instruction that Information Security should be provided by the German State-Administration themselves in no longer of administrative, or military. 2. They will explain to Ministry that col c and d of the form relate only to action within the Ministry. The Minister does not usually refer 50 to 100 names to the Ministry with persons concerned to him. In his records, this will be. Minister has investigated the record of every one of the employees the Ministry should include a list that goes with that in col b.

3. The next consideration is not to refer only to the proceedings of the Ministry of Education, which they report to the personnel branch of the Ministry after every session. The Ministry should understand that there have no difficulty in saying for instance that the total number of names heard by 30 and that Minister can provide in 20 cases.

4. Similarly in the case of Police other than Ministry, but the returns will in each case be provided by the appropriate personnel branch and the above instruction will be provided as if referred to Ministry and Ministry related to the Ministry should not the appropriate responsible officer.

That, for instance, he has retained the records of 200 employees and has referred 20 of them to the Department of Education (for High Schoolmaster). 1. It has been decided to ask all Ministerial Sub-Commissions to make a return on Defamation on a fortnightly basis. The form submitted to the Joint High Commissioner and approved by him.
2. The form at least should be completed by each Ministerial Sub-Commission. It deals with both civil servants and outside England but this will not prevent a separate return being required for any large organization or group of organizations such as banks which have a provision or separate department which it may be desirable to submit separately.

3. These returns will be for the information of Sub-Commissions.

4. Sub-Commissions will keep Administrative Section informed of the returns by aggregation the returns received by them and submitting to Administrative Section two returns one for Civil Servants the other for other persons.

5. Attention will be drawn to the fact that we require the information in this form and that we ask them with the approval of the Joint High Commissioner.

6. Sub-Commissions can obtain from Chief Clerk, Administrative Section copies of the form in Italian at the rate of 10 (ten) pence for each Ministerial Sub-Commission with which they deal of either or both forms as may be necessary and also forms in English for their aggregated returns to Administrative Section.

7. The first return will be sent immediately after the 1. Sep and will consist of two sets of forms. An original form showing the position as at the 30 Aug and a second form showing the position as at 15 Sep.

- 1 Attached are drafts of forms which are suggested for the 15 day returns on Defascism. One form with regard to Ministries and the other for other bodies defascized under them.
- 2 This Section only requires one of each form from each Sub-Commission every 15 days, but Sub-Commissions themselves will require one (of each possibly) from each of its Ministerial Sub-Commissions or even one for certain specified groups of accounts e.g. Banks.
- 3 To facilitate the compilation of the final return to this Section it is suggested that Ministries should supply the information required on similar forms so that all that requires to be done by Sub-Commissions is to aggregate the various returns submitted to them by the Ministries.
