1 Since 10 May last of Returns and the whole of Italia has been added to the territory under Italian Administration, this should be reflected in col. 4 of the return. Only two sub-commissions show any appreciable increase over the other returns. All Sub-Commissions receiving returns in which col. 4 has not appreciably increased will check with the reporting body that this is correct.

2 The rate at which proceedings are being heard is slightly improved but is still too slow. Sub-Commissions must bear in mind that all unheard cases now in col. 4 MUST be concluded before 15 May. Sub-Commissions by checking the rate at which cases have been heard over the last four weeks can see that (in most cases) the cases will not be concluded in time unless the rate is improved and in some cases very considerably improved.

3 All Sub-Commissions will complete col. 4 of the return of 15 May with col. 4 of the return of 15 Aug.
The law allows 3 months for hearing. In all cases the number of proceedings concluded is smaller than the number of cases initiated on 15 May. All Sub-Commissions will ask for an explanation of the difference and forward same to this Section.

4 Appeals have at last started to move substantially. The number of appeals heard has now reached the number of appeals lodged on 15 Jan. Sub-Commissions upon appeals 'heard' are fewer than the number lodged on that date. Appeals may be said to be in arrears. The time for a case to be reached is at present 7 months. The AGC has indicated that the number of courts is to be increased.

Sub-Commissions by checking the rate at which cases have been heard over the last four weeks can also find (in most cases) the cases will not be concluded in time unless the rate is improved and in some cases very considerably improved.
- 3 All Sub-Commissions will compare col 4 of the return of 15 May with col 4 of the return of 15 Aug.
- The law allows 3 months for hearing. In all cases the number of proceedings concluded is smaller than the number of cases initiated on 15 May. All Sub-Commissions will ask for an explanation of the difference and forward same to this Section.
- 4 Appeals have at last started to move substantially. The number of appeals heard has now reached the number of appeals lodged on 15 Jan. Sub-Commission whose appeals 'heard' are lower than the number lodged on that date hearings may be held to be in arrears. The time for a case to be reached is at present 7 months. The AGO has intimated that the number of courts is to be increased.

It is 3 months after the 15 May mentioned in that Art and also in certain other decrees as the last day for initiating proceedings against certain classes of employees. The time limit for the conclusion of proceedings against these employees is still 15 Aug (15 May plus 3 months). It is only for certain excluded persons i.e. not of the state central administration that proceedings may be initiated after 15 May. The fact remains that so far as the bulk of the state central administration is concerned the last day for completion of the proceedings is 15 Aug and that your Commissions should have completed their (except for certain employees) by 15 Aug.

2) according to the return relative to the subsequent period - from 16 to 30 June, 386 proceedings were completed out of 563 initiated - leaving 177 pending.

As regards proceedings which are still pending, the arguments for the defence are being awaited for some, since the denunciations are of a recent date; requests have been made for inquiry-documents from various judicial authorities of the Kingdom for others; and the rest are in the process of completion.

The time limit of 15 August 1945, specified by the Allied Commission in its above-mentioned note of 3 July in connection with art 10, para 2 of RIL 179 of 22 April 1945 is given to the High Commissioner for referring the persons concerned to epuration and does not apply to the completion of the proceedings.

- 1 In the last 15 days 17 cases only have been heard (col c) and 290 still remain to be heard. At the present rate the cases will take 9 months to hear. Only a relatively short time remains. Please see para 1 of DP/6.2/CA of 4 June. If any cases of higher grade officials are excluded through expiration of the time limits, the fact that time has been expended on minor officials will not be accepted as a reason. The cases of minor officials must be deferred. This is a matter in which the Allies under the Armistice Terms have a right to insist as the Government has undertaken to remove fascists from office and it is not considered that this obligation is being carried out if time is wasted on petty officials so that the cases against more senior officials fail because of expiration of the time limits.
- 2 The time available is now rapidly running out considerable better progress MUST be achieved.

- 1 Please point out that the Commissions' explanation for the lack of progress of defascism of the first nine grades does not affect the criticism. It is still considered that the rate of progress is too slow. Why are petty officials like Ushers taken before these important officers. It would not matter very much if Ushers were not separated at all; but it is important that senior officers should be promptly dealt with so that either they can be re-instated and get to work or so that their successor can. Please impress upon your commissions that they must deal with senior grades first and that dealing with junior grades is no excuse for failure to do so.
- 2 With regard to the last paragraph please impress upon those concerned that what is required is the total of persons ordered to be dismissed and the fact that there is an appeal outstanding is quite irrelevant (please see D7/62/CA of 30 May). The misunderstanding has arisen through a mistranslation into Italian; the note should have read "after allowing for results from appeals" and the translator said "after the results of appeals". However they read the note, what we want is (and that is what matters) the total dismissals ordered by the Commissions of first instance as they are made. If a decision is later reversed an adjustment of this figure will then be made. The decision will NOT be omitted until the appeal is heard.
- 3 Please obtain without further delay the correct figure for the period ending 30 Apr. which is now a month overdue and holding up the return and also the corrected figures for 15 May.

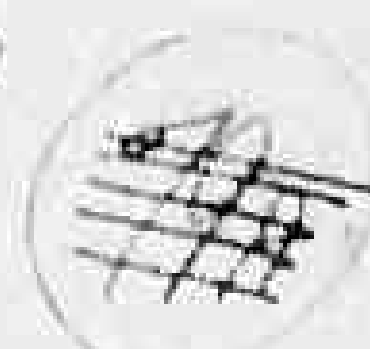

1. As to Officials of Grade 1 - A :-

- a) The statistical return applies only to those who are within the territory in which IL 159 is in force. Its object is to enable the progress of epuration to be watched. This object is defeated if figures relating to persons not now epurable are included. Col (b) therefore should be reduced by excluding all those to whom IL 159 is not at present applicable. If any such are also included in any other column those figures should also be adjusted.
- b) With regard to column (c). It is laid down (see the foot note) that all persons whose papers have been so far investigated as to enable it to be concluded that there is no case against them should be included in col (c). The object of this column is to show (by deducting it from col b) how much more work remains to be done, this is defeated if persons whom it has been decided not to prosecute are not included in col (c) their investigations are obviously complete.
- c) The cases referred to should not be included in the return.

2. As to the report in general :-

- a) If these cases have been so far investigated that it has been decided that the persons concerned are not epurable then they should be included in col (c).
- b) The case of persons not in the territory in which IL 159 is in force should be excluded from all columns.

- 3 Will you please have all these matters corrected so that the return for 30 Mar show the correct position.
