- 1 Please draw the attention of those concerned to the fact that it is now 6 weeks since there has been any or any substantial change in col (c).
- 2 The attention of the Expiration Commissions concerned should be drawn to the comparison between the present col (e) as compared with col (d) as at 31 Jul. The time limit for proceedings is three months; it follows therefore that every case in col (d) three months ago should be completed now, and as all cases do not take so long as three months, the total of col (e) should be still larger by the number of cases which have taken less than three months. You will ask for an explanation of why col (e) is so far short of its proper figure.
- 3 Appeals lodged on or about 15 Feb are still in process of being heard. If col (g) is markedly less than col (f) of 15 Feb please ask the Ministry to ascertain when the appeals may be expected to be heard.
- 4 You will please instruct all concerned that in view of DL 702 having come into operation, returns from 30 Nov inclusive will contain only figures relating to grades I to VII and the comparable grades of civilian exposable under that Decree and that the column lesser punishments will no longer be used. Below the form and not included in the total will be a line "other grades" as to which only cols d, e, f, g, h, i will be completed.
- 5 You will realise that the explanations for which you are asking may lie in the fact that grades 8 and 9 are no longer liable normally to expiration and that in anticipation of this becoming law these grades have deliberately been allowed to drop behind. Your enquiries cannot be phrased forcefully. The return for 30 Nov on the new lines will show this.

- 1 Since 10 May 1945 of Pescara and the whole of Emilia has been added to the territory under Italian Administration. This should be reflected in col 6 of the returns. Only two sub-commissions show any appreciable increase one substantial the other moderate. All sub-commissions receiving returns in which col 6 has not appreciably increased will check with the reporting body that this is correct.
