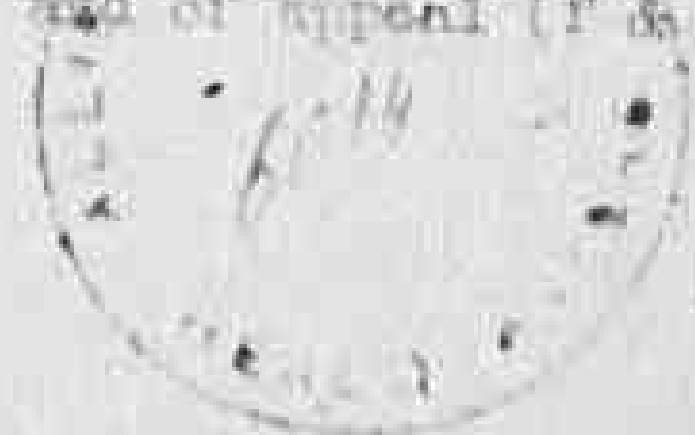

1. The report on defascism that is periodically sent to your S/C comprises only one part of the personnel of the Ministry, that from grade IV to grade IX. Data contained therein represent but one part of the work performed.
2. Taking into account the above specification, we inform you that in the period of time between 1 and 15 June there have been examined 75 cases in total.
3. In the first fortnight of June the Commission of Epuration has concluded six epuration proceedings, only one of which appears in the report, against the officials of grade V. In fact the proceedings concluded within 31 May, as to officials of grade V, were 3, whereas in the return of 15 June are 4. The remaining 5 cases concluded by the Commission, are not shown in the report because they regard employees of a grade lower than the IX.
4. The time limit of 15 July has been extended to 15 August 1945 as per art. 10 of L.L.D. No.179 of 22 April 1945. This time-limit concerns the provinces which were transferred to the Italian Government up to 16 October 1944. As to the provinces transferred afterwards the nearest time-limit will expire on 9 November 1945. Within the mentioned time-limits of 15 Aug. and 9 Nov. all obligations will be fulfilled.
5. This Ministry assures you that it does not reckon on any further extension of the present time-limits.
6. Therefore it agrees with your Sub-Commission that the work must be brought to completion within the fixed time-limits.

1. This Sub-Commission wishes to invite your attention to the unsatisfactory progress being made with regard to the general action of defascism within your Ministry.
2. As a matter of fact, on the basis of the data supplied by you, on 15 June 1945, there were 154 cases for which preliminary investigations had still to be carried out. A comparison with the report for the period ending 30 May indicates that only 14 cases have been investigated in the whole fortnight.
3. In the same period not one expuration proceeding had been concluded.
4. As you know, the time limit for completion of hearings for part of the personnel is 15 July and for the remainder 15 August. On the basis of the figures in the fortnightly returns it is felt that, if progress of defascitization continues at the present rate, it will not be possible for your Ministry to complete the proceedings in due time.
5. It is understood that, in the past, there has been a tendency to regard time limits as provisional; this Sub-Commission wishes to point out to you that the new time limits set forth in the Decree No. 179 of 22 April 1945 are definite, and therefore they should in no way be exceeded.
6. We feel sure that you are fully aware of this necessity, and we assume that you have already taken appropriate measures in order to assure the timely completion of your work.
7. We would appreciate being informed at an early date of the action taken.

1. Reference your DF/EB/CA dated 13 April ult. and DF/6.17/CA dated 30 April ult.

2. The Ministry of Agriculture has informed us that, in view of the impossibility to complete preliminary investigations in due time, an adequate extension of time limit has been requested of the Assistant High Commissioner for Epuration with letter No. 22587 dated 18 April 1945, copy of which is attached.

3. The Ministry has been unofficially informed that its request on this matter has been received and that appropriate legislation will be issued within the next few days.

4. Reasons given by the Ministry for its inability to complete investigations of its own personnel by the deadline of May 15 are based essentially on the impossibility to carry out the work with the limited personnel available and qualified for it. It is pointed out that officials dealing with these matters must be thoroughly trustworthy, scrupulous, objective, precise. They have to check each statement of the "schena personale" against records on file and must often look through the records to make sure that declarations are not incomplete. Therefore notwithstanding hard work, investigations could not be carried out quicker than has been done.

5. In the case of Senior Technicians of the Bodies of National Importance, it has been pointed out that under this category come only the employees of the communal offices of the Economic Bodies of Agriculture. Since they

are very numerous (at least one, but often more than one in each communal office) an agreement was made with the High Commissariat to expedite the investigations relating to this group. On the basis of this agreement the "schede personali" of these employees, instead of being sent to the central office in Rome, are all delivered, for preliminary investigation, to the various Provincial Delegates of the High Commissariat, who in turn submit their conclusions to the High Commissariat, in Rome.

This procedure not only hastens the completion of the investigations, but also gives the possibility of comparing declarations made in "schede personali" with records on file, which would not be available in Rome.

6. In consideration of the above and of the fact that the Economic Bodies have directed their provincial offices to provide for the delivery of the "schede" to Provincial Delegates before 31 March 1945, it ensues that it is the responsibility of the Provincial Delegates of High Commissariat that preliminary investigations concerning the category of employees in question be completed within due time.

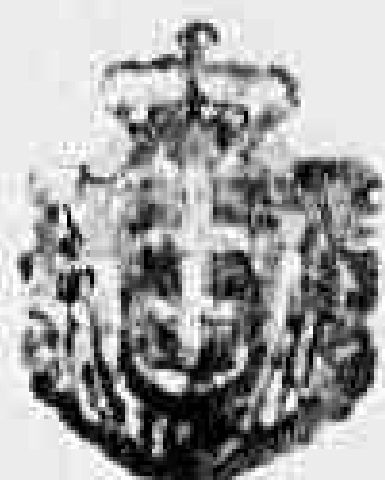
7. It is to be kept in mind, however, that the new decree, which is going to extend time limit for investigations, will apply not only to the Ministry, but also to all bodies within its jurisdiction.

8. It is believed that the above explanations will clarify the position of this Sub-Commission in this matter. It is hoped that the Civil Affairs Section will therefore follow through with the High Commissariat the question of legislation extending time limit of 15 May.

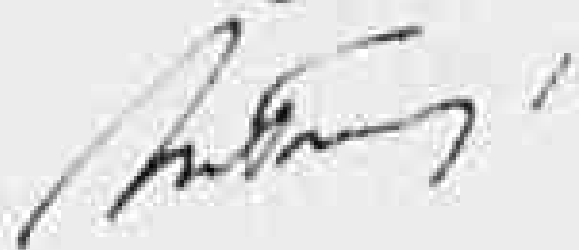
