TO : Comroe S/O

- 1 Please draw the attention of those concerned to the fact that it is now 6 weeks since there has been any or any substantial change in col (c).
- 2 Appeals lodged on or about 15 Feb are still in process of being heard. If col (g) is markedly less than col (f) of 15 Feb please ask the Ministry to ascertain when the appeals may be expected to be heard.
- 3 You will please instruct all concerned that in view of DL 702 having come into operation, returns from 30 Nov inclusive will contain only figures relating to grades I to VII and the comparable grades of civilians expirable under that Decree and that the column lesser punishments will no longer be used. Below the form and not included in the total will be a line "other grades" as to which only cols d, e, f, g, h, i, will be completed.
- 4 You will realize that the explanations for which you are asking may lie in the fact that grades 8 and 9 are no longer liable normally to expiration and that in anticipation of this becoming law these grades have deliberately been allowed to drop behind. Your enquiries cannot be phrased forcefully. The return for 30 Nov on the new lines will show this.

- 1 It is noted that Column B has increased by 11,000. Although this addition has been newly made it must, of course, relate back to the handover of Tuscany and Emilia Regions. It should not be overlooked that the time limit for conclusion of the examination of the Schede Personale is the 15 Nov 45 except for such portion of territory which was handed back to Italian administration after 15 May 45. As to the remainder, the examination of the Schede has to be completed by 19 and 31 Jan 46.
- 2 You will appreciate therefore, that there may be quite a proportion of Schede whose examination must be concluded by the 15th of this month.

- 1 Col. c has increased by only two during the last four weeks. This does not appear reasonable. Will you please take steps to have this improved.
- 2 Col. e. The rate of progress is still considered to be low. It is appreciated that a large number of cases have to be decided provincially but even allowing for these and the extra time which they are allowed, the rate of progress is too low; not a single case was finished in the last fortnight.
- 3 Please compare col. e of 30 Sep with col. d of 30 Jun. All cases have to be completed within 3 months of their initiation. All cases shown as initiated on the 30 Jun should by now be completed. As this is an outer limit and many cases are no doubt completed in less than the maximum time, it follows that col. e now should be substantially greater than col. d at 30 Jun. Where it is less, an explanation should be asked for. If the difference is large and the explanation is not considered satisfactory, but not otherwise, the facts will be reported to this Section.

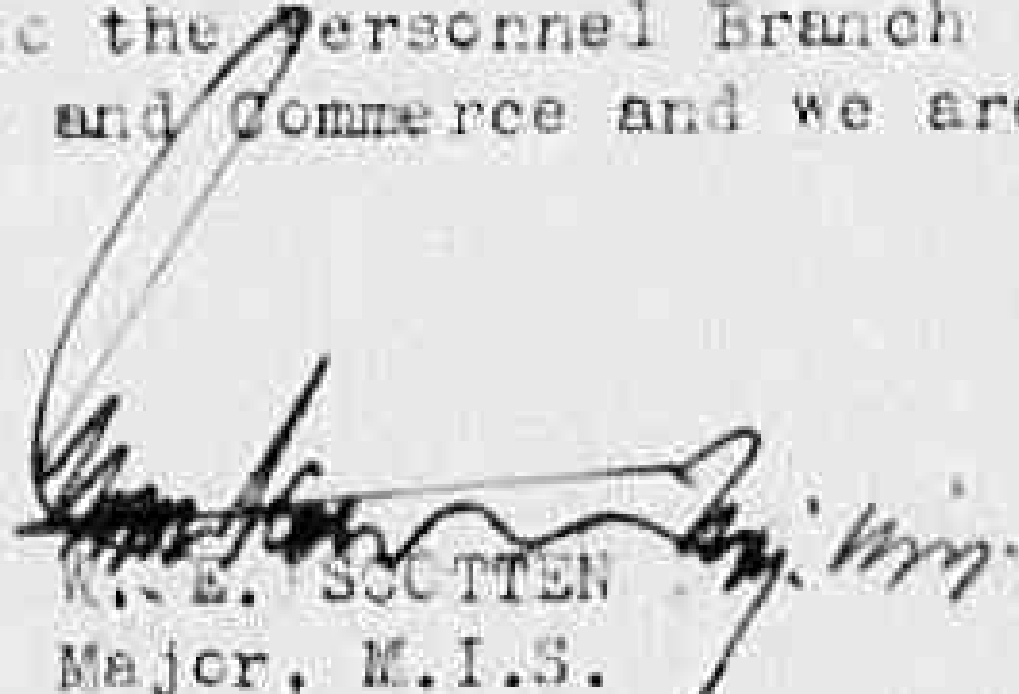
