Subject: Reports on Epuration.

With reference to your letter AFSC/INT/899 dated 27th November 1945.

1. As I have previously mentioned in various letters concerning the same argument, the reason why the figure in column (e) of the return is less than that of column (d) is due to the fact that the latter includes, for whom the epuration proceedings which were initiated have been deferred. Article 25D.L.L.No.285, 23rd October 1945, states that the only cases which can be considered as having been technically begun are those for which the notification of the charges has been made to the parties affected; and the "three months term" runs as from the date on which this notification is made. In practice it happens that before any such notification is made that the charges are withdrawn by the High Commissioner; and so the proceedings are finished and yet do not account among those concluded (Column e).

2. I have informed the Central Epuration Commission to ascertain when the outstanding appeals are to be heard.

3. I have given instructions for the Fortnightly report to be compiled in the mode required by you.

SUBJECT: Evacuation Returns - 30 Oct 45.

TO: Air Forces S/C

- 1 The attention of the Evacuation Commissions concerned should be drawn to the comparison between the present col (e) as compared with col (d) as at 31 Jul. The time limit for proceedings is three months; it follows therefore that every case in col (d) three months ago should be completed now, and as all cases do not take so long as three months, the total of col (e) should be still larger by the number of cases which have taken less than three months. You will ask for an explanation of why col (e) is so far short of its proper figure.
- 2 Appeals lodged on or about 15 Feb are still in process of being heard. If col (g) is markedly less than col (f) of 15 Feb please ask the Ministry to ascertain when the appeals may be expected to be heard.
- 3 You will please instruct all concerned that in view of EL 702 having come into operation, returns from 30 Nov inclusive will contain only figures relating to grades I to VII and the comparable grades of civilians evacuable under that Decree and that the column lesser punishments will no longer be used.
Below the form and not included in the total will be a line "other grades" as to which only cols d, e, f, g, h, i, will be completed.
- 4 You will realise that the explanations for which you are asking may lie in the fact that grades 8 and 9 are no longer liable normally to Evacuation and that in anticipation of this becoming law these grades have deliberately been allowed to drop behind. Your enquiries cannot be phrased forcefully. The return for 30 Nov on the new lines will show the facts as to this.

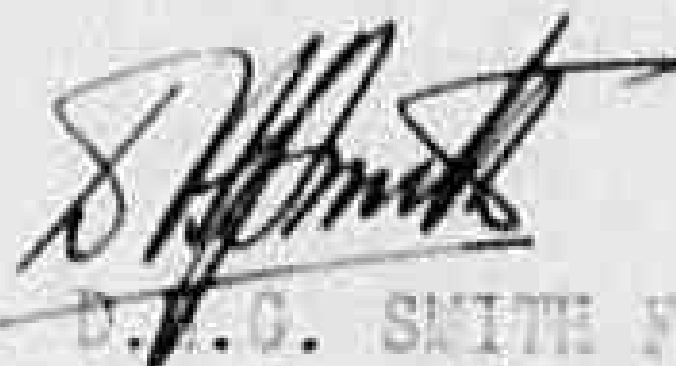

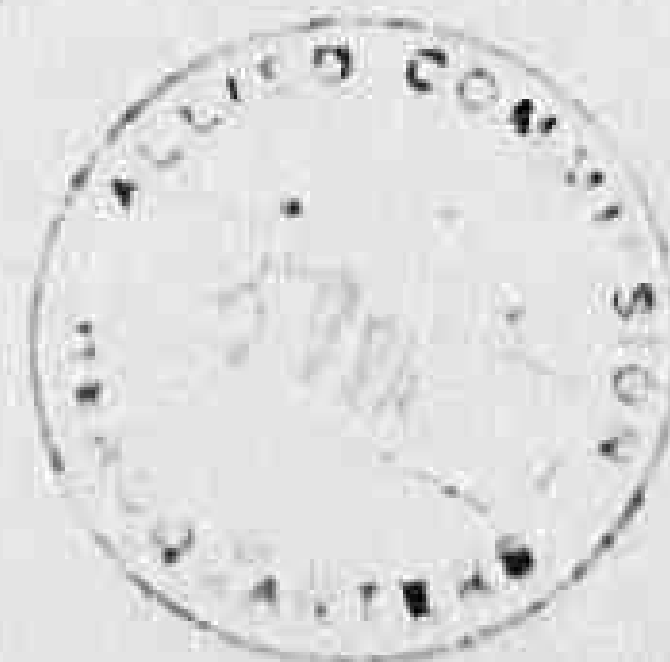

Expatriation Returns.

1. With reference to your letter 26410/5178 Coll. dated 18th September 1945 and previous correspondence on the above subject, the following general observations have been submitted to this Sub Commission by the Civil Affairs Section of the Allied Commission:-

- (a) Since 10th May, most of Toscana and the whole of Emilia have been added to the territory under Italian Administration, and this should be reflected in column B of the return. As no substantial increase has appeared in the return submitted by your Ministry to this Sub Commission, confirmation is requested that the return of the territory in question has in fact made no appreciable difference to the numbers involved.
- (b) The rate at which proceedings are being heard, although slightly improved, is still too slow. Your Ministry is reminded that all unheard cases shown in column D must be concluded before 15th November 1945.
- (c) You are requested to compare column D of the return for 15th May with column E of the return for 15th August. The law allows three months for hearing, yet the number of proceedings concluded on 15th August is smaller than the number of cases initiated on 15th May. Your Ministry is asked to furnish this Sub Commission with an explanation

dated 13th September 1945 and previous correspondence on the above subject, the following general observations have been submitted to this Sub Commission by the Civil Affairs Section of the Allied Commission:-

- (a) Since 10th May, most of Toscana and the whole of Emilia have been added to the territory under Italian Administration, and this should be reflected in column B of the return. As no substantial increase has appeared in the return submitted by your Ministry to this Sub Commission, confirmation is requested that the return of the territory in question has in fact made no appreciable difference to the numbers involved.
- (b) The rate at which proceedings are being heard, although slightly improved, is still too slow. Your Ministry is reminded that all unheard cases shown in column D must be concluded before 15th November 1945.
- (c) You are requested to compare column D of the return for 15th May with column E of the return for 15th August. The law allows three months for hearing, yet the number of proceedings concluded on 15th August is smaller than the number of cases initiated on 15th May. Your Ministry is asked to furnish this Sub Commission with an explanation of the difference.

2. It is appreciated that appeals have at last begun to move substantially, although the time for a case to be reached still averages about seven months. However, this Sub Commission is informed that the number of courts is shortly to be increased which should materially help to lessen the difference between the figures shown in column F and those in column G.

Following our letter No. 29917, dated 19/10 and referring to letter AFSC/INT/17 of 27th September.

With regard to para B of the above letter you are informed that 15th November is fixed, not for the completion of the cases but for notification to the appropriate Euration Commission.

Concerning para C9 the column "Euration Proceedings initiated" includes those for whom judgment has been deferred. On the contrary, according to article 25 D.L.L. 23/10/44 No. 285 only those cases where the charges have been communicated to the party concerned are to be considered as technically initiated and the term of three months runs from the dated on which the party concerned is informed of the charges. Before such communication takes place, and in practice this happens in many cases, the High Commissioner withdraws the charge and in this case the proceedings are extinct without appearing among those concluded.

However, all proceedings started so far have been concluded within three months of the charges having been communicated to those concerned.

In particular I must point out that the Commission of the 1st Grade for Military Personnel had to suspend its work for about 40 days while waiting for the competent departments to nominate the High Commissioner's representative for sanctions against fascism, to substitute Dott. Alberto Guidi who resigned.

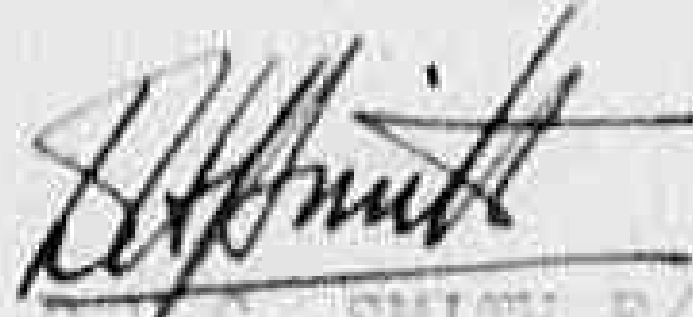

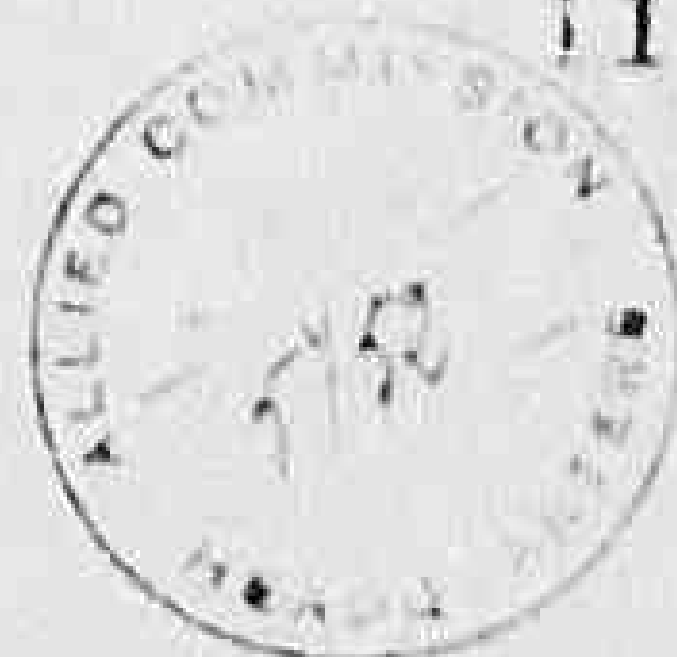

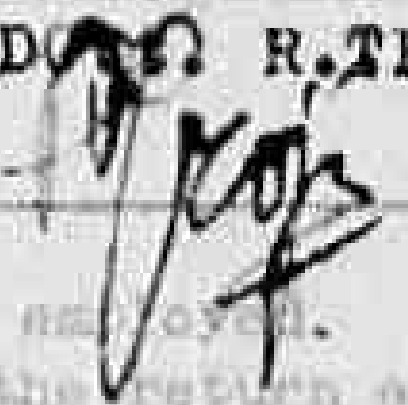
