1. With reference to your letter DF/6.21/CA dated 23 Nov 45 addressed to Public Works and Utilities Dept.
2. We have visited the Expiration Office of the Ministry of Public Works and discussed the points raised by you.
3. With regard to para 1 of your letter. The Ministry assured us that all cases are actually completed within the prescribed time limit of three months. They consider that the present difference between judgments commenced Col (d) and those completed Col (e), amounting to 59 is quite a reasonable one. They point out that Col (d) continues to increase and will continue to do so until all Italian territory is turned over to the Italian Government, until then, Col (e) cannot be expected to become equal to Col (d). In anticipation of the enactment of the new law, the last two grades have been allowed to drop behind.
4. With regard to para 2 of your letter. The Ministry states that once an appeal is lodged against a judgment passed by them, the matter is dealt with by the Central Expiration Committee, on which they have no jurisdiction whatever. Consequently, they are not in a position to explain why appeals have been dealt with at an unsatisfactory rate. They also informed us that, according to the provisions of the new law, the Central Committee has now been disbanded, and the responsibility for the hearing of appeals transferred to a Sezione Speciale del Consiglio di Stato (Special Section of the State Council).
5. In general we were informed that under the new law only one punishment will be adopted in regard to personnel found guilty, viz. "rimozione" (removal from employment or dismissal). No lesser punishment will be adopted, but the Ministry still holds the

faculty of "metters a riposo" (retiring) the personnel in the higher grades who they judge unsuitable for further service owing to combined reasons of age and political conduct. This is not considered by them as expulsion provision, but these retirements will continue to be shown in Col (i) as previously.

3. The addition of 56 in Col. b of the Expiration return for the end of August is correct so far as this return is concerned for the reason that only Florence, Pisa, Lucca, Fies and Imphora have been included.
4. The Ministry was unable to take any action with regard to personnel in the remaining Provinces of both Regions as they had not received the necessary information from their offices in those Provinces.
5. It is expected that the next return will cover the Provinces not omitted.
6. With regard to para. 2 of your letter the Ministry state that besides the two cases shown on the return they have dealt with a number of other cases of personnel either not belonging to the permanent staff or of a grade lower than IX. Another reason they have given us is that the Commissions are unable to commence a case when the accused fails to acknowledge receipt of the "Notification of charges" and does not forward his defence. In addition they have a difficulty in communicating with the Provinces recently handed back to the Italian Government.
7. We are assured that every effort will be made to complete all the proceedings within the time limit.

- 1 Please point out that the Commission's explanations (para 2) for the lack of progress of defascism of the first IX grades does not affect the criticism. It is still considered that the rate of progress is too slow. Why are the cases of petty officials like storemen taken before those of more important officials. It would not be a matter of great moment if they were never operated at all; but it is important that senior officers should be dealt with promptly so that they can either settle down to their work or so that their successors can. Please impress upon your commissions that they must deal senior grades first and that time spent on junior grades is no excuse for failure to do so. Under the armistice terms we have the duty of seeing that fascists are removed from positions of authority and we do not include petty officials in that definition.
- 2 With regard to dismissals what is required are the total dismissals, the fact that there is an appeal against the order is quite irrelevant. If a decision is reversed on appeal then the figure will be amended. The decision will NOT be omitted from the return because the appeal has not yet been heard. On 15 April you showed 27 dismissals; out of 124 cases concluded since then in SIX weeks only nine cases have been heard! and the dismissals are now 26.
The corrected figures for dismissals as at 30 April and 15 May are still awaited. The statistics for the whole commission are being held up for want of these figures.

2. The remarks therein have been considered, and you are assured that the next return will be drawn up to include only persons at present located in territory in which the L.I. Decree No. 159 of 27 July 44 is in force. In future, we will also adhere to the principle of giving priority to the scrutiny of higher grades.
3. Taking the above for granted, we reply to the various objections raised by the Civil Affairs Section in respect of the return on expiration of 15 March, as per your previous letter.

A) OFFICIALS FROM GRADE I TO IV -

Out of the five officials who appear from the comparison of Col. b) and c) to have not yet been examined, four are now in Northern Italy and the fifth in territory not yet handed back to Italian Administration.

B) RETURN - GENERAL

1) Most of the 430 cases which, according to the comparison of col. b) and c), have not yet been examined, concern officials at present in Northern Italy or in areas not yet handed back to the Italian Government. The total of 887 cases shown in col. b) includes also, as already stated in our 3634 dated 21 March 45, personnel in Northern Italy appearing from our records to hold qualifications as per L.I. Decree No. 159 of 27 July 44. For these cases the terms of deferment as per the regulation now in force, are not observed.

11) The 64 undecided cases are now nearly completed. The delay is due to the time needed for hearing the persons concerned and for gathering all the other evidence for the judgement. We will expedite the procedure.

You should always bear in mind that the work of the Committee concerns also employees in Grade X and XI, temporary personnel, and officials belonging to Bodies controlled by this Ministry.

With reference to the remarks made by you (your letter dated 20/3/45) on the epuration of the personnel of this Ministry belonging to the first four grades, we point out what follows:

Since 11 cases out of 16 have been examined, the figure of 65% noticed by you in our return of February 28 is correct in respect to the number of the officials holding permanent rank in the first four grades. However this 65% represents the 100% of the work that this Epuration Committee could actually carry out.

In fact, you must consider that, out of 5 officials of grade IV still to be examined, 4 are now in Northern Italy, and the fifth one in the territory not yet handed ~~to~~ over to the Italian Government.

So far as these officials are concerned the terms for the commencement of the epuration proceeding will become effective from the coming into force of the Legislative Decree of the Lieutenant General No 159 of 27 July 44 and of the L.D. of 11 Oct. 44, No 157.

The scrutiny of the position of Officials actually living in territories not yet handed over to the Italian Government has been started, but can not be completed until information on the activity of the officials in the said territories has been gathered.

Moreover, we inform that we have completed the scrutiny of the officials included in the other five grades who are on duty in Rome with the central Administration, and the scrutiny of the officials belonging to the local agencies in the territory under the Italian Government jurisdiction.
