STAFF PROCEDURE RELATIVE TO WAR CRIMES AND WAR CRIMINALS

1. Hereafter the Theater Judge Advocate, MTOUSA, is charged with the functions of coordination within Allied Force Headquarters all staff work dealing with War Crimes and War Criminals. All matters dealing with War Crimes and War Criminals will be referred to the Theater Judge Advocate MTOUSA for appropriate disposition.

2. Among the functions to be performed under this directive, the Theater Judge Advocate will:

2. Prepare all communications to higher authorities or other Theaters on matters relating to War Crimes and War Criminals other than of a routine nature, for signature and dispatch by the Adjutant General, AFHQ, after consultation with other interested Staff Branches and Headquarters.

May, at the discretion of employing unit, be re-engaged on their previous basic rate of pay plus the appropriate cost of living bonus at the time of re-engagement (except that employees previously in receipt of a personal cost of living bonus under the terms of paragraphs (ii) (b) and (iii) (b) above may, at the discretion of the employing unit receive that bonus if more advantageous than the cost of living bonus at the time of re-engagement).

(v) Employees discharged through some fault of their own:-

Will not normally be re-engaged. If however they are re-engaged it will be on the same terms as in paragraph (i) above.

(vi) In all cases where discharged employees are re-engaged on any other rate than the minimum laid down in Appendices "A" and "B" this will be subject to the production of a certificate from the previous employing unit stating the reasons for discharge and the latest rate of pay in issue.

In addition to the above grades a special grade of "Chief Executive" is established at a maximum rate not to exceed 20,000 lire per month. This amount will include Cost of Living Bonus. Appointments to this grade which will be made only in very special circumstances, are reserved to the Allied Force Labour and Wages Committee, and are, in all cases, subject to the approval of the C.A.O., A.F.H.Q. The pro-forma at Appendix "B" to this memorandum will be used for this purpose.

2. Teachers

Professors, teachers and Educational Course Instructors in all subjects at Army Colleges will be classed as Category 1 personnel, subject to the posts in question being identified by, or under the authority of, the Chief Education Officer, GHQ. Such personnel must be filling vacancies not below the rank of Warrant Officer on approved War Establishments.

3. Marine grades will be paid at the daily rates shown above, with the following additions:-

(i) Diver - plus 35 lire an hour underwater.

(ii) Lineman (Navy) - plus 5 lire an hour while tending Diver.

4. The daily rates shown in the above schedule have been computed on the basis of a 26 day month and will, therefore, apply only when computing deductions from the pay and cost of living bonus of all grades (other than marine, hotel, mess and club grades) who have worked less than the stipulated minimum of 26 days in any month. Deductions from pay and cost of living bonus in respect of hotel, mess and club grades who work less than 30 days in any month will be computed by dividing monthly figures by thirty (30).

5. Juveniles between 14 and 16 years of age in the apprentice and unskilled grades will receive the minimum basic rate applicable to juveniles 16-18 years of age.

6. Rations

When full rations, i.e., all meals provided to the employee by the employing service, the following deductions will be made:-

(a) 30 lire per day from the basic rate of pay.

(b) 4 lire per day from the cost of living bonus.

Sub-para (b) is not applicable to hotel, mess and club grades.

SHEET 3 OF REVISED APPENDIX "B" TO AFHQ ADMIN MEMO No. 14

7. The standard working day for Hotel, Mess and Club employees is 12 hours, and no overtime will normally be paid unless a legal collective contract, existing before 1 September, 1942, can be produced and verified by the local Provincial Italian Labour Office or AMG. This only applies to the hotels which are taken over and where the management is responsible for the entire administration and supply of labour, and not the hotels, messes and clubs which are requisitioned and direct labour employed by the Armed Forces.

8. Overtime is not payable to the following grades:-

Professional Workers (Electrical Engineers, doctors, lawyers,

CHRISTMAS BONUS, DISCRETIONARY BONUS, AND ANNUAL BONUS
AND PAYMENTS MADE TO ITALIAN CIVILIANS EMPLOYED
BY THE ALLIED FORCES IN ITALY, GERMANY AND AUSTRIA.

1. GENERAL

a. Following the established policy of keeping conditions of employment and compensation for Allied Forces employees in step with those prevailing in the home industry, a Christmas Bonus, Discretionary Bonus and Paid Annual Leave will be granted to Italian civilian employees of the Allied Forces for each month of completed service or fraction thereof. (See paragraph 3b below). Furthermore, they will be granted six (6) paid holidays a year.

b. Previous instructions or publications in conflict with this Memorandum are hereby rescinded.

c. This Memorandum will be effective from the date of publication. Bonuses and annual leave with pay provided by this directive will be computed retroactively to 1st January 1945, or the date of employment, whichever is later, but will not apply to personnel who have been discharged from employment before the publication of this Memorandum.

d. Only those Italian civilians employed by the Allied Forces on a permanent or semi-permanent basis are entitled to the benefits under this directive:

- (1) Permanent employees are those persons regularly employed on a permanent basis or for a lengthy indefinite period of time.
- (2) Semi-permanent employees are those persons employed for limited periods of time not less than 1 week, for seasonal work, or for work of brief but indefinite duration.

2. a. CHRISTMAS BONUS: A Christmas Bonus will be paid to Italian civilians employed on a permanent or semi-permanent basis, such bonus to accrue at the rate of two days' pay per month, to be paid on the next day pay day before Christmas or at Christmas, whichever shall occur first.

b. DISCRETIONARY BONUS: Italian civilians employed on a permanent or semi-permanent basis (except for personnel other than messengers) will be paid discretionary bonus at the following rates:

- (1) Clerical and Administrative grades (includes Hotel and mess clerical staff): 2 days' pay per month.
- (2) Hotel and mess (other than clerical staff): 1 day's pay per month. other grades (including marine) :- 1 day's pay per six months.

c. ANNUAL LEAVE WITH PAY will be granted to Italian civilians employed on a permanent or semi-permanent basis at the following rates:

Office Workers: 2 days per month.

Other Workers: 1 day per month.

Payment for accrued leave not taken up to time of dismissal will be paid to the individual on the date of dismissal.

d. PUBLIC HOLIDAYS WITH PAY: Six (6) public holidays with pay will be granted Italian civilians employed on a permanent or semi-permanent basis as follows:

(1) United States Forces:

New Year's Day	1 January
Washington's Birthday	22 February
Independence Day	4 July
Armistice Day	11 November (or other appointed day)
Christmas Day	25 December
Thanksgiving Day	due date

(2) British Forces:

New Year's Day	1 January
August Bank Holiday	1st Monday in August
Armistice Day	11 November (or other appointed day)
Christmas Day	25 December
Good Friday	due date
Easter Monday	due date

When Italian civilian employees are required to work on these days no extra pay will be given, but such employees will be granted a holiday with pay as soon thereafter as possible. If Italian civilian employees will be required to work, without additional pay or compensation, on any days, other than those specified above, which may be declared holidays by the Italian Authorities.

3. For purposes of computation the term "pay" in sub-paragraphs above shall include current basic pay and cost-of-living bonus at time payment is made.

b. For payment of a fraction of a month, ($\frac{1}{2}$) of the indicated rates will be paid for each completed week of service provided that, in the case of grades other than Clerical and Administrative and hotel and mess, no disallowance bonus will be paid for any period of service less than six (6) months.

SUPPLY OF CIVIL FOR REQUIREMENTS FOR VENEZUELA, GUAYANA

1. Supply of civil needs for the territories of VENEZUELA CIVIL and GUAYANA continued under T-1 990 to be a military responsibility of Allied Force Headquarters on a combined basis. Civil supply requirements are, therefore, forwarded by Allied Force Headquarters (G-5) to CCS who approve and allocate procurement responsibility as between United Kingdom and United States.

2. On the other hand-

a. Allied-occupied VENEZUELA CIVIL is a disputed territory and supply to it of FOR on civil account is normally carried out from British military depots through the Inter-Territorial Petrol (ITP). Of the industrial requirements some are LSC items, others are RSC items, others are NOT British military grades at all.

b. The services of GUAYANA is an integral part of ITPE (retained under military Government for military reasons) and the supply to it of FOR is from United States sources through the Composite Industrial Petrol (CIP). (See paragraph 10 ITCSA Supply Directive B).

3. To facilitate the slating of FOR products for these two territories pending allocation of procurement responsibility of CCS, the following procedure is suggested:-

a. Slating will be carried out as follows:-

(1) For VENEZUELA CIVIL to ST G-5.

(2) For GUAYANA to CIP/USRA.

b. Bids for VENEZUELA CIVIL will be submitted by AG WHI Corps to Headquarters Allied Commission. Nomenclature will be according to the War Office List of Potentially Products of 401 1524/14.

c. Bids for GUAYANA will be submitted by AG WHI Province to Headquarters Allied Commission. Official U.S. Army nomenclature will be used. 1270

d. Headquarters Allied Commission will screen these bids and submit them (broken down as between VENEZUELA CIVIL and GUAYANA) to G-5 (G-5), who will submit them to ST G-5 and CIP/USRA for final screening. After screening G-5 Allied Force Headquarters will submit the details to CCS for approval and allocation of procurement responsibility.

e. Once screens have been so screened and so submitted, provisional procurement action will be taken as follows:-

Paragraph 3, ITG Administrative Memorandum Number 13, 1945, is rescinded and the following is substituted therefor:

" 3. SUMMARY

(a) Authority is granted to provide food, as set forth herein, during each working period of night (8) hours or more for Italian civilians, who are:

1. workers other than office workers.
2. office workers.

for the Allied Forces. This authority is extended to civilians employed directly by the Allied Army, Navy or Air Forces, by contractors on their behalf, or to employees of industry or service for the Allied Forces.

(b) Where employing units have an approved their working schedule that forty eight (48) hour week is completed in five and a half (5 1/2) days, the 48 hour, or office workers will not be limited on the half (1/2) day, with the following unit commander authority, to all those workers who have completed their forty eight (48) hours.

DISCONTINUATION OF PETROLEUM SECTION

1. With effect from 1 December 1945, Petroleum Section this Headquarters is dissolved, and all Allied Force Headquarters Administrative Memoranda relating to its establishment, functions, and policy are hereby rescinded.

2. Until such time as complete reversion to individual petroleum responsibilities has been attained, certain functions provisionally undertaken by Petroleum Section cannot be made an immediate responsibility of the Services or Civilian organizations.

3. Accordingly the following bodies have been formed to ensure the smooth hand-over of Petroleum Section's responsibilities:

FUNCTIONS:

a. Coordinate handover of slating responsibilities and stock control from Petroleum Section to individual agencies.

b. Allocate and release petroleum products from Allied stocks to the various national agencies in accordance with quantities slated for by those bodies. Until such time as national slates are fully implemented, the Italian, Greek and Yugoslav civil economies and military forces will continue to be supplied through the recognized petroleum distributing organizations. Allocations will be made, and releases reported to Combined Petroleum Committee, Allied Force Headquarters. Products released will be in accordance with quantities slated for by individual national agencies, and all stock-holding agencies responsible will make no releases other than those authorized by CPC.

c. Termination of accounting responsibilities consequent upon the dissolution of the Mediterranean Common Pool.

d. Continuation of interim accounting.

Central Mediterranean Coordinating Committee (CMCC)

FUNCTIONS:

To carry on Allied tanker duties previously entrusted to Petroleum Section, AFHQ and maintain continuity until such time as functions and responsibilities can be handed over to normal commercial channels or to Comitato Italiano Petroli.

The CMCC will:

a. Be advised of supply programs set up to meet the needs of all procuring (slating) authorities.

b. Receive advice of all tanker notifications for Italian port discharge.

c. Cable acceptances, nominating ports of discharge whenever possible (necessary due to bulk shipments being undertaken by Civil Oil Companies to main port installations on CIP basis).

d. Be advised of all tanker sailings with BIA nominated ports, and details of cargo and consignee.

e. Arrange to issue, when necessary, release sailing instructions.

f. Receive stock and usage reports on ocean terminal storage from all holding agencies (S & T, PMS, Navy & CIP, etc.) and in turn advise details of tanker cargo arrivals.

g. Recommend allocations of tonnage between grade and user.

h. Coordinate movement of coastal tankers for Italian Coast and from Italian Coast to Yugoslavia and Greece.

i. Maintain liaison with the proper authority in respect to dry-docking and repairs of coastal vessels.

j. To ensure that ocean tankers arriving from extra-Mediterranean sources are not used for intra-Mediterranean shuttle moves, involving consignees in demurrage charges, without approval of consignor.
