The following cables received from the AC political
advisors in N. ITALY are forwarded for your information:No. 142 of 9 June 1945.According to press discussion on premiership seems to have
reached a deadlock with DI GIULIO and MOTTI each refusing to accept the other.

I think I should warn you that if failure to find a personality acceptable to all parties should lead to break up of coalition and assumption of power by right wing parties with exclusion of Communists and Socialists a very serious situation would arise in the North.

I doubt whether left-wing parties here would be willing to accept such a solution and it might even lead to formation of separate government in the North. As a purely left wing government would be equally dangerous at this stage when arrangements for elections will be going ahead it seems essential that the coalition should be preserved.

I have before me your telegrams 141 and 143.

With regard to electoral lists, the position is that the Allied Commission has informed the Italian Government that their present system of preparation of electoral lists is so cumbersome and impracticable that the Allied Commission does not intend to instruct its Regional Commissioners in AMG territory to take any action. I am asking the Chief Commissioner to have a meeting on this matter at the earliest possible moment because I am convinced that we must get on with the question of elections.

With regard to consultation by the Allied command on the movement of Italian troops, I wrote a letter to the Admiral on May 31st suggesting that he must press for consultation on movements and locations of all troops and he spoke to AMG who said that the movement of troops was a matter for 5th Army and that Rome would be consulted and it was up to 5th Army AMG to put up any protests. This is merely passing the buck and is most unsatisfactory. I will have a further talk with the Admiral tomorrow.

The following is copy of cable received by hand from Mr. IDKEDEN
15. 7. 1947 dated 8 June 47:

"At concluding meeting of Regional Committees of National Liberation
of Northern Italy yesterday strong criticism was expressed by speakers
of various parties of delay in formation of new government.
The party speaker to lay blame on politicians of the South and Republicans
and the C.M.N.'s in the North should consider the possibility of setting
up a provisional government of Northern Italy. He also suggested
that delay might be due to foreign intervention.

Motion passed by the congress after calling attention to
the grave dangers created by delay in forming government announced
intention to hold direct election of representatives of regional
committees headed by President of C.N.I.L. to be sent from Central Committee
of Liberation Immediate formation of new government representing the
CLN and on the basis of the March 1st program of 23rd May the radical
revival of the political direction of the country and the improvement
of the international status of Italy. In this government complete
party would have to be guaranteed among the portion in the allocation
of principal ministries.

Motion also approved the political and planning activities of
CLN during the insurrectionary period and its governmental acts
after liberation. It went on to refer to the historic role played
by the CLN in the liberation of the country and demanded that the
constitution as consultative organ of the democratic state should
until elections to the Constituent were held, be the only organization
which represented the will of the people for the radical revival of
Italian politics and life and the source of all initial acts in the recon-
struction of the country.

A motion by the Christian Democratic representative of VENEZIA GIULIA,
that the CLN of VENEZIA GIULIA should be represented in the delegation
going to Rome caused much acrimonious discussion. The President, ARANDI,

all contrary to lay blame on politicians of the South and Republican Party. They went so far as to say that if Rome could not make up its mind the UNR's in the North should consider the possibility of setting up a provisional government of Northern Italy. It also suggested that delay might be due to foreign intervention.

Formal motion passed by the Congress after calling attention to the above factors urged by Selvi in formal government announced intention to send soon delegation of ten representatives of regional committees headed by President of UNR to demand from Central Committee of Liberation immediate formation of new government representing the UNR and on the basis of the UNR programme of 23rd May the radical revival of the political direction of the country and the improvement of the international status of Italy. In this government complete parity would have to be guaranteed among the parties in the allocation of ministerial portfolios.

Motion also approved the political and planning activities of UNR during the transitionary period and its governmental acts by the CILN in the liberation of the country and demanded that the committee be consultative organs of the democratic state should the until elections to the Constituent Assembly were held, be the only organization which represented the will of the people for the radical renewal of Italian Political life and the source of all initiative in the reconstruction of the country.

A motion by the Christian Democrat representatives of VENEZIA Giulia, that the CILN of VENEZIA Giulia should be represented in the delegation going to Rome caused such considerable discussion. The President, SELVI, placed on it raised doubts of International interests. It was out of question to receive approval. Eventually it was found impossible to postpone the matter any further and no motion was taken on the motion.

I will report date of arrival of delegation in Rome as soon as I know it together with any decisions on the meeting I may be able to obtain.

The following sitreps dated 7 June have been received from
Mr. Hopkinson:

"Congress of Regional Committees of National Liberation of Northern Italy covering LIGURIA, PIRENEE, LIGURIA, VENETIA, MARCHE and TOSCANA opened yesterday in MILAN. Agenda consists of (1) relations in internal political field (2) consultative functions of CLN (3) relations of CLN with public administration and in particular prefects (4) activities of industrial CLNs (5) urgent problems of supply, unemployment etc."

"President of CLNAI MARAZZI opening session outlined action taken by CLNAI in view and intent to secure formation of new government and after criticising liberals recent action in BOLOGNA he welcomed declaration of parties of the second June which he said placed beyond all doubt usefulness of CLN in participating in reconstruction and democratic revival of political life."

"Christian Democrat representative on CLNAI MARAZZI called yesterday and expressed grave anxiety in regard to (1) activities of CLNs in factories and (2) acts of violence in provinces. As regards (1) he said that activities against individuals in factories were still continuing. Massacre education was being carried out by factory CLNs against managers and employees. Managers were being sent away on purely personal grounds and with no political justification. Appointment of COMANDINI was not an adequate remedy. General MARAZZI among moderate elements including many workers was leading to risk of reaction. As regards (2) he said that in provinces and especially in smaller communes of MUSICA, BIELLA, VA D'ORSOLO and other mountain regions there existed what he described as virtual reign of terror. Locally appointed police were carrying out requisitioning and blackmail and conniving at robbery and killing. Carabinieri were intimidated and powerless. He said that similar conditions existed in country districts of BOLOGNA, MODENA and RAVENNA Provinces."

He admitted that elements were in fact a small minority of thugs only nominally forming part of communist party but deplored failure of communist and socialist leaders to take an open stand against these practices. Indeed by accepting very dangerous republicans into their parties they were making situation still worse. He thought that Christian Democrats might find it necessary themselves to take the lead in the matter.

As regards the factory committees, I told BARBARA that the ALLIED COMMISSION and US were working actively on the question in consultation with the Italian Government and that I hoped that very shortly, measures would be announced which would clarify the position. He said that he hoped it might be possible to establish separation commissions for factories which would not only have the duty of clearing out fascists but would have the power to reinstate owners, members of management, and workers who had been sent away improperly. Decisions of any commissions should be open to review by Allies.

As regards state of affairs in Province, Public Safety Officer of LOMBARDIA REGION confirms that violence of this sort is on the increase. He attributes it in part to activities of criminal elements released from jails by Germans. In existing circumstances this state of affairs is not surprising. It is of course mainly a police matter but from this and other reports I have received, it has attained such proportions that it requires special investigation by provincial commissioners and organised suppression involving if necessary, use of Allied troops. General GRITTENBERGER is already interesting himself in this situation and has given orders to divisional commanders to increase their patrols. SUBJECT: Political Advisers - situation from N. ITALY.

TO : Distribution below.

The following is copy of further cable received from the AC political advisers in N. ITALY.

"No. 4056 of 26 May 45.

I visited BOLZANO and TRENTO May 24-25. Despite continued presence of large numbers of German troops situation in both provinces appears satisfactory. I will submit detailed report on my return to ROME but briefly position is as follows. In BOLZANO Province there is roughly two-thirds German speaking majority and in BOLZANO city large Italian majority. Prefect a Socialist selected by CLNAI Milan is adopting sensible Liberal policy towards German speaking population e.g. there is a German newspaper, German schools and two representatives of South Tyrolean Party on the local CLN.

Active agitation in favour of separation or union with AUSTRIA is however banished. In TRENTO position is quite different. Except for ten communes which are administered as part of BOLZANO Province is overwhelmingly Italian and there is no racial problem. CLN consisting of usual five parties is functioning well."
