The persons presenting the letter, ten to fifteen in number, claimed to be reinforcement to guard at prison. All persons taken from the prison had already been sentenced by Court of Assize. Director of prison and two other persons suspended. No trace at present of prisoners, investigation continues. Lawlessness and murders are occurring in La Spezia daily. Report follows.

During a visit to Turin on 22nd June I learned that two or three days previously, two Russian officers called at the headquarters of Piemonte Region and saw Capt. Micklewright, a British Executive officer. They had come from the USSR (Russian) Transient camp at Modena and were representing CCP., USSR, for repatriation of the Soviet citizens. They were in possession of a leave pass signed by (believed) a British Major which did not indicate any place of destination. Capt. Gorcewvassily (the other officer was a Major but I do not know his name) asked for transport to assist them in their work, and when he was told that it was regretted that none was available he adopted a rather truculent attitude. Capt. Micklewright, realizing the need for tact and discretion, took the officers to Colonel Marshall and Col. Selby and all three officers remained in the room during the subsequent interview. (Capt. Micklewright made short hand notes). Colonel Marshall eventually told them that as officers and soldiers they would appreciate the fact that as they are unable to produce any orders or travel authority it was difficult for him to provide facilities. To this they agreed and left the building.

Attached is a report made by Capt. Scalfa, PSO of Vercelli, which refers to a similar visit and request by a Russian Lieutenant.

On 25 June, Capt. Gorcewvassily returned to Turin and demanded that he be furnished with gasoline and cigarettes. Colonel Regent, AMG, and the French Commanding Officer agreed on the imposition of a curfew beginning at 2200 hours, ending at 0500 hours.

On the contrary, Provincial Commissioner was informed by French officers that they expected relief which would continue without interruption until completed 30 June. In general, the situation is in hand although there is some anti-French feeling on the part of the Italian populace.

From questioning it appears the Lieut. is part of a Russian military mission with HQ in Rome and a transient camp for Russian repatriates in Modena, from where he operates.

Attached hereto is copy of report of Provincial Commissioner Turin Province on SUS. explosion incident as at 1115 hours 25 June 45.

At 1600 hours 25 June report was received from the Commander CC.RR. in Piemonte, that CC.RR. in SUS. had been arrested by the French.

At 1700 hours the same day, the PPSO Turin Province, reported the facts as three CC.RR.'s, in defiance of orders that they do not appear on the streets in uniform, went out fully armed and were immediately disarmed and returned to their barracks. 3. The order of the French Divisional Commander that no CC RR will be allowed on the streets in uniform or armed is still being strictly enforced.

Capt. Scott agreed to this interrogation. The interrogation was conducted and, apparently, continued throughout the night.

8. Bailey bridge between Road Block No5 (French) and Road Block No15 (American), which was removed by the French on the twenty third, has not as yet been restored. On questioning French promised to restore it but claim there is considerable work to be done to restore it. CAO reports that they are, apparently, not making a real effort to get the bridge in.
9. Nothing further to report at this time.

Subject: Explosion in the French Troop Mess at Hotel Sole of Susa.

1. An explosion occurred in the French Cendurre Mess in the Hotel Sole, Susa (Turin Prov) killing three (3) Gendarmes and one (1) domestic. French soldiers attacked civilians and caused some harm to the civilians (scratched faces and bloody noses). Prompt armed intervention scattered the troops, avoiding serious consequences. One CCMR, to avoid being roughly handled fired a few shots in the air. The French command in agreement with the American command have consigned the Carabinieri to the Caserma and have them in a state of siege. In spite of restrictions the carabinieri have ascertained that the explosion was due to explosive materials which the Germans left behind in the stove or furnace in other places. Further details are impossible to give.

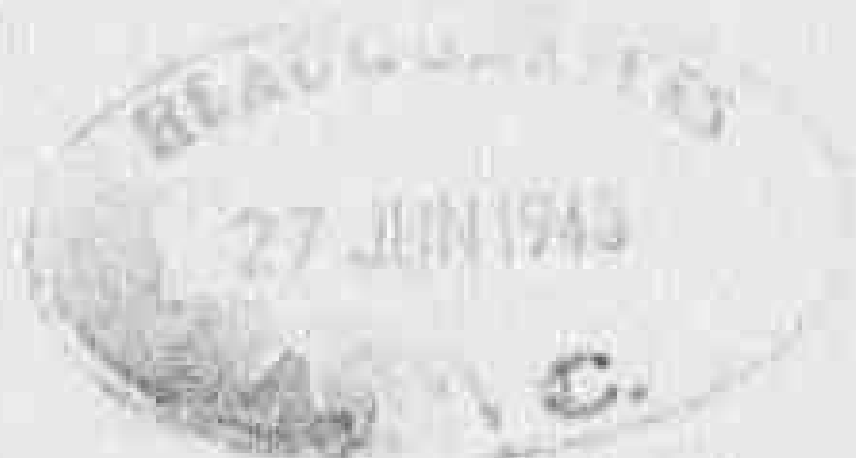

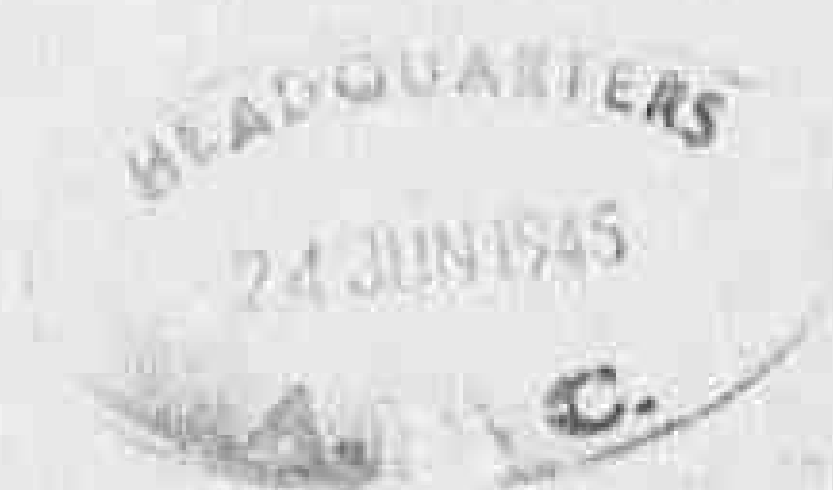

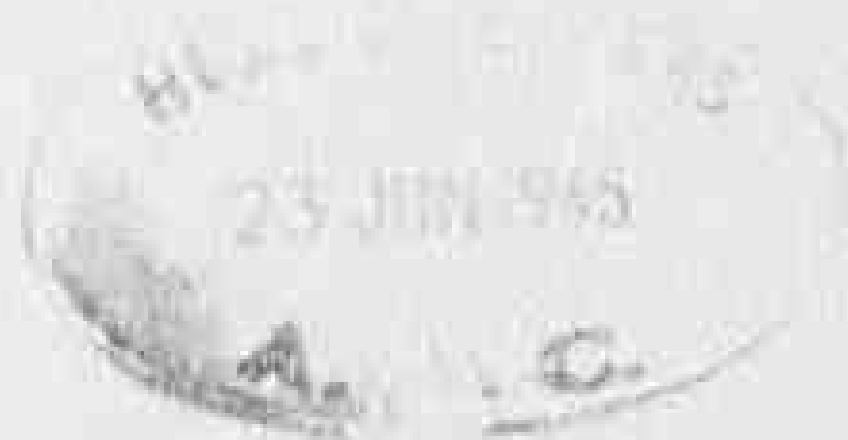
