## Final sitrep UMBRIA-MARCHE REGION.

This Headquarters closes with effect 2359 hours 9 May 1945; all Provincial offices except ANCONA already closed; ANCONA COMMUNE to continue under military government. This Region's portion of German demobilization (?) consisted in surrender of 15 vessels, chiefly S-Boats but including 1 U-Boat, with total crews of 1300, at ANCONA on 6 April. DONIZIA PACELLI MUSOLINI and 2 younger children due momentarily to arrive at "R" Internes Camp at TERMI. TERNI Province had best olive collection record of region considered as percentage of target, though PERUGIA Province had larger total collection. PESCARO had best collection of grain in relation to target figure, with PERUGIA again having largest tonnage. Final harvest figures for UMBRIA-MARCHE REGION:

1. New court of appeals for MARCHE opened at PERUGIA on 28 April by Minister of Justice; ceremony attended by Regional Commissioner and other Allied officers. 2. Arrival of sugar shipments makes possible PERUGIA Province's first general issue of sugar in 4 months. 3. All Provinces instructed to make drastic reductions in circulation permits to allow use of available quantities of PUL for industries, mills and truck pool grain movement. Olive oil collection in Region now at approximately three-quarters of target figure; UMBRIAMARCO grain collections 117% of goal. Grain collections through 28 April: ANCONA 60,886 tons 121%, ASCOLI 47212 tons 109%, MACERATA 73842 tons 109%, PESARO 37741 tons 181%, PERUGIA 91,335 tons 114%, TERNI 25,549 tons 102%. Olive oil collections through 28 April: ANCONA 321 quintals 32%, ASCOLI 440 quintals 49%, MACERATA 534 quintals 52%, PESARO 407 quintals 50%, PERUGIA 14,800 quintals 74%, TERNI 8,254 quintals 62%. Total collections for Region: 336,565 tons wheat 117% of target; 24,362 quintals oil 73%. 4. N.S.E. Emergency allocation of 20 tons soap obtained in face of scabies problem in upper MARCHE, owing to continued failure of Italian Ministry to allocate soap to AMG territory. Demonstration staged by about 500 persons at PESARO regarding complaints on price of wheat; situation competently handled by Provincial Public Safety Officer in cooperation with gendarmerie and no trouble resulted. PERUGIA CITY curfew moved from 2200 to 2300 hours with full approval of military authorities. Approved paper RICOSTRUZIONE in ANCONA suspended publication for lack of paper while 162 papers, including some of purely pornographic nature are being published in ROME. 2 R. TERNI Province has 3-months supply of salt. 3 R. Efforts being made to arrive at consolidated figures for need of coal and fuel in Region, including harvest. Numerous drugs being uncovered daily in PERUGIA CITY, indicating that adequate supplies exist. Lack of rain causing reports of possibly serious damage to spring-sown crops throughout Region; autumn-sown wheat suffering only in thin soil, looking very good on better land, particularly in Umbrian plain where nightly heavy dews are as beneficial as rain. All UMBRIA-MARCHE Provinces now have exceeded target figure for collection of last year's grain harvest. Wheat collection totals through 21 April: ANCONA 60569 tons 121%, AScoli 47048 tons 109%, MACERATA 73573 tons 109%, PESARO 37055 tons 178%, PERUGIA 91142 tons 113%, TERNI 25305 tons 101%; Regional totals 334692 tons 116%. On 22 April Regional Commissioner, Minister of Public Instruction and local authorities opened exhibit of 4 centuries of Umbrian art, commemorating 5th centennial of birth of PERUGINO, and permanent fair of Umbrian arts, both at PERUGIA; Regional Commissioner pointed out that ITALY's great art had been produced in atmosphere of liberty and expressed hope that rebirth of liberty might make it possible for nation once more to come into its cultural heritage.

## Sitrep ABRUZZI-MARCHE Region.

1C. Second demonstration in 2 days occurred at ASCOIL-PICENO on 12 March as protest against price of bread. Warned that demonstration was planned, Public Safety Officials placed 25 Carabinieri inside Prefecture, but these proved useless. 8 members of crowd who talked loudly and refused to disperse arrested by Provincial Public Safety Officer. Troops were called to assist, were provided from Italian POLICE Division and performed duty satisfactorily in morning. In afternoon troops from same unit aided with crowd, which returned with intent of removing prisoners from jail. Italian Captain and Lieutenant said they were unable to control their men. Prisoners were admitted to jail and a 1900 hours curfew imposed. Italian troops have now been removed from town, Military Police loaned to assist and situation in city now is normal. Trail of persons arrested scheduled for Thursday. Error in last week's sitrep regarding permission having been granted for AQUILA demonstration was erroneous.

Reports dispatched on 2 chief ports of ABRUZZI. At PESCARA 2 temporary wooden quays, each about 15 meters long, with draft of 2.5 meters are now available for use; no warehouses at present available. Port had a pre-war capacity of 50,000 tons; it was built in 1934-35 and reached highest development in 1938, when 300,000 tons of goods were moved. A dredge, 3 tugs, about 20 schooners and several fishing boats are now submerged in harbor. Most urgent need for putting harbor back into operation is salvage of dredge, which blocks mouth of canal, leaving only a 7-meter width for the channel. Full use of port would require salvage of other vessels, repairs to railways, quays and warehouses. Port Commandant believes, however, that it could be placed in operation fairly quickly. At ORTONA 100 meters of quay are now available for schooners, 60 more for lighters, but port has no cranes or gear of any type and is badly in need for dredging. Present capacity is about 200 tons, convenient to railroad. Maximum capacity likely to be achieved by repairs would be 1000 tons or less. Anchorage for about 12 schooners available. 15 meter-boats and schooners have been salvaged since ORTONA was taken by Allies, but an equal number remain sunk in port. Salvage firm short of timber and cement and needs cylinder-floats and lighter with crane.

All mines cleared from ORTONA-PESCARA railway with removal of total of 3627 mines on right-of-way; work now being continued on line north of PESCARA. Formal opening ceremony of new tribunale at VASTO held on 15 February with representatives of various branches of ALCOM present. Civilian phone service now permitted from MACRATA and ASCOLI provinces to all points south. PESCARA postal service to be opened on thrice-weekly basis for all parts of province accessible to military vehicles; remainder of province to be served by bicycle, donkey or foot as possible.

Olive oil control program now extended to four provinces - CHIETI, PESCARA, TERAMO and MACRATA. Official visit to ANCONA in connection with campaign reveals that Italian officials there ignored amassing and released whatever oil was brought in to civilians upon their own standards of propriety. Reports from CHIETI and PESCARA, first two provinces to get campaign in operation, show that road blocks are useful only in preventing large-scale removals; one road block on PESCARA-POPOLO road collected only 7 quintals in 8 months of operation. Allied vehicles often refused to stop and in ~~one case~~ fired machine gun at Carabinieri without injury. The 15-kilogram retentions are disapproved and "pork" reductions seem inequitable, but no popular opposition has been indicated to them. Olive oil

officers are having usual transport troubles. Each commune is being visited and the Sindaco and Parish priest asked to urge greater efforts in amassing. Company to AQUILA, PESCARA and CHIETI provinces -- 689 from ASCOLI, 700 from MACERATA and 994 from TERAMO. Two platoons of 1000 G.T. Company arrived during week and are located in MACERATA; one platoon of 1000 G.T. Company previously located in MACERATA has moved to ASCOLI-PICENO. Trucks hauling grain to south now distributed as follows: 60 at ASCOLI, 60 at TERAMO and 60 at MACERATA. Program of shipment of grain by rail from ORTONA commenced today with 100 tons of grain scheduled to go this week from TERAMO to LECCE and a 100 tons to follow the succeeding week. Afterwards it is hoped to increase the shipments to 200 tons weekly unless second 100 tons goes from northern railhead such as CHIARAVALLE.

Meeting of four prefects of the MARCHE held in ANCONA on 10 February and monthly meetings planned for future. Price of 40 lire per kilo determined for meat with eggs to sell at 12.50 each and wine at 16 lire a liter. Agreement made that MACERATA province will give the other MARCHE provinces preference in the purchase of eggs and pigs, at least until next prefect's meeting on 16 March. Soap, shoes and copper sulphate were pointed out as the most pressing needs of the compartment. ASCOLI and MACERATA

to slaughter 4 per cent of meat animals in provinces for ROME, with ANCONA making a similar but only half as large concession to PESARO province. Chief complaint reported by prefects is that farmers have to sell commodities at controlled prices and to buy clothing and shoes at black-market prices. Allotments of grain on bulk basis in the MARCHE now suspended.


