Final Sitrep.

1BF PISTOIA political front calm. PISA political activity on increase. All parties exploiting announcement of hand-over of territory to Italian Govt. APUANIA communism growing among unemployed. Christian Democrat, Socialist, and Action parties very active. Organisation of Govt in Province and communes satisfactory. Memorial service for Partisans massacred by Germans held at FORNO by communists. No incidents.

2BF APUANIA supplies of vegetables appearing.

3BF PISTOIA Italian supply organisations can be trusted to continue good work. LUCCA supply difficulties diminishing with increased road repairs. LIVORNO supplies of most materials slowly becoming more plentiful. Stores displaying more varied assortment of merchandise. APUANIA supply position improving. 350 kilos olive oil distributed in FORDINOVO. 100 kilos in hand. 100 more head of horses needed in Province. 50 kilos sodium arsenate sent to FLORENCE for locust control.

Sitrep TOSCANA REGION area under Regional control June X.

1 BF LUCCA all attention focussed on Italian Government crisis. Local atmosphere calm. PISTOIA all attention on ROME. APUANIA Christian Democrats increasing in number and influence but Communism tends to increase amongst unemployed. PISA political activity still on increase. Meetings held in peaceful and orderly manner. Democratic Party appears to be getting stronger. 2 BF APUANIA pasta went into manufacture June 1. Increased supplies anticipated by mid June. Improved ration of 300 grammes weekly issued by FLORENCE sufficient grain in warehouse until mid September at present ration scale. 3 BF LUCCA general supply position shows progress. Consider all communes position fair for June. APUANIA 1000 tons flour allocated to Province. 25 mules arrived, 20 horses expected. LIVORNO resetting of tony nets now assures good supply of tony. Progress made towards having fishing boats unload catch at LIVORNO instead of FIORENTINO. FLORENCE normal operation of several industries held up owing to non availability of coal. Movement of raw materials, finished goods, and fuel (lignite) lessened by lower gasoline allocations. High cost of lignite, due to road haulage costs, is causing trend to higher prices of manufactured articles.

4 AF LUCCA arrest of 3 ring leaders of lawless elements in GARFAGNANA by Capt DE NASI may put final end to difficult situation there. APUANIA clash between CCNR and civilians at PONTREMOLI during night of June 3. No injuries. 1 American believed

1 BF general feeling of uneasiness regarding probable departure of Allied increased political activity continues in PISA but in peaceful and orderly manner. PIPO Partisan leader with IV CORPS returned LUCCA with 300 men and issued anti-order of the day (main antagonists Communists and fake Partisans) band is unarmed. 1 minor official suspended in APUANIA Province for former Fascist activities. 2 BF general distribution 125 grams FLORENCE Province during May 45, pasta rations also at 40 grams per person per day period 16 to 31 May 45. 3 BF local produce in LIVORNO continues fairly plentiful. Breakage of tony net in that Province has caused practically complete loss of seasons tony fish. Relaxation of fishing regulations should prove most helpful. 4 BF no serious crime and no disorder. 5 BF few cases of typhoid in PISA Province but well distributed, also small number of undulant fever cases. Committee of investigation into small number of typhoid cases on Island of ELBA placed blame on raw vegetables which were contaminated. Scabies prevalent in APUANIA Province but no other diseases although many cases of typhoid in nearby LA SPEZIA C. 6 BF Major REILLY Provincial Commission LIVORNO discharged from hospital and now recuperating. 7 BF control methods in LUCCA proving effective. Average of 800 Italian repatriated PW despatched daily from FLORENCE, departures keeping up with

Sitrep TOSCANA Region Area under Regional Control May 2. 1B,F LUGGA excitement over TRIESTE. PISA following meeting of there has been much activity. All parties holding meetings. All orderly. 2B,F FLORENCE salt ration increased to 250 grams per month. Sugar not distributed since March because of insufficient supply for general distribution. More unrationed foods (fruit and vegetables) could now be brought in if it were not for economic control line. FLORENCE has normally been supplied from the north. APUANIA 300 quintals olive oil allotted by region ex PISTOIA. 700 tons flour from LIVORNO. 90 tons handled through Italian vehicles. Transport ceased. Impossible to get flour to other communes by civilian transport. Urgently need allocation of 10 WD 6 x 6 trucks. 3B,F FLORENCE curtailment of electric power due to breakdown of transformer slowed down industrial production. Necessity of having to bring lignite into province by autotransport is heavy burden on road haulage equipment, costly and inadequate. 4A,F FLORENCE proposed demonstration against arrest of PIETRO NENNI failed to materialise owing to presence of British and American police. APUANIA few proclamation offences. Peaceful demonstrations by women directed at Prefect and Sindaco to obtain work for their menfolk. PISA wave of bicycle stealing has been broken. 5B,F LIVORNO still a few cases typhoid on ELBA. APUANIA 5 cases typhoid reported in APUANIA Commune. PISA still some undulant fever in province but steps taken to combat it. 6A, 7A, F FLORENCE situation well under control.

1. Reference your letter, file G-5/3/2A dated 19 May 45.
2. Par 2 of the cited letter refers to the fact that no senior AMG officer was present at the disarming ceremony in FIVIZZANO although Lieut. OPULENTE was notified by phone that there was to be such a ceremony. I, personally, went to MASSA that day and took part in the ceremony with the partisans of MASSA; as the implication that this HQ was negligent is entirely misplaced.
3. I inquired of the Provincial Commissioner of APUANIA about the ceremony at FIVIZZANO, which I had been told thru Lieut. OPULENTE would take place at 5 o'clock. He had no definite information about it, in fact, he told me that he had told the officer at FIVIZZANO to delay the ceremony of giving certificates until the disarming had been completed. Major SHIRK, the Provincial Commissioner, was not aware that the ceremony was to be held; and gave me the impression that the time for holding it was indefinite. I therefore dismissed the matter.
4. So far as being able to place a full-time AMG officer at FIVIZZANO, that is not practicable, if the officer is to be furnished from this Region. At present there are no Provincial Officers available for APUANIA Province other than the P.C. I have been told informally that two officers, formerly working with the partisans, are doing GAO work on some informal arrangement made with the P.C. This assistance is very much appreciated for without them there would be none.
5. It is desired to point out to the DCCAG with 15 Army Group that this Region has been greatly depleted in officers and has not sufficient personnel to function effectively in all matters. The situation has been presented to AG HQ, and that HQ understands that many things formerly done by this Region can no longer be accomplished; certainly not accomplished up to the usual standard of the Region, due entirely to lack of personnel.

Sitrep TOSCANA Region area under Regional control May 2.

1 BF FLORENCE anxiety apparent amongst all parties at TRIESTE situation. LUCCA merchants form strong influence with mild socialist politics. Communists well organized and vociferous. FISA little political activity. Meeting of provincial CLN held on 18 and 19 May. APUANIA communists active amongst former Patriots in CARRARA. Not to an alarming degree. General politics not of primary interest to population. Provincial officials well organized with few exceptions.

2 BF FLORENCE herring supplied in lieu of April meat issue arrived mostly in bad condition. APUANIA bread ration still 200 due to lack of transport of some small communes not supplied due to same reason. Vegetables and other foods appearing with satisfactory quantities but prices too high.

3 AF LUCCA medical stores, first aid kits and Italian Red Cross DSS (mobile) reaching Gothic line communes. General ~~position~~ improving.

4 BF FLORENCE incident occurred in PONTASSIEVE commune on 13 May resulting in death of Carabinieri Maresciallo, his 18 year old ^{son} ~~son~~, and a communist. 43 extra Carabinieri sent from FLORENCE

same day. Three other murders during past week; all apparently political. Enquiries proceeding in all cases. Public morale fairly good. LUCCA anxiety continues regarding lawless acts in isolated communes. Active measures being taken to check these, and to investigate. PISA 2 auxiliary Questura agents arrested 7 May at SAN GUILLIANO, for throwing 2 hand-grenades at American soldiers. One soldier killed and 1 wounded.

5 BF LIVORNO typhoid on ELBA increasing. Otherwise health good P FISA some 20 cases undulant fever in province and few cases typhoid. APUANIA threat of typhoid, but only in adjoining province.

6 B. 7 BF LIVORNO continuous flow of refugees averaging 2000 per day. Situation in hand. LUCCA drift of refugees into crowded VIAREGGIO checked slightly. Will be under control by mid week. PISTOIA MONTECATINI presents only problem.

8 AF APUANIA too high but downward trend apparent. PISTOIA slight rise continues.

9 P LUCCA examination of CAGLIANUOVO discloses considerable rebuilding possibilities. General condition on COTRIG line communes deplorable.

1 B F FLORENCE signs of apprehension amongst non-communists particularly aristocracy at rumours of Province shortly being taken over by the Italian Government and departure of allies. PISA Communists still active. Other parties indulge in very little activity. All parties joined in VE Day celebrations. LIVORNO 8,000 people attended Victory celebration. Officials of AMG and civil government present. Very orderly. Allied nations congratulated and people very happy over Victory. Communist tendency seems strongest. LUCCA anticipate ructions when Province handed back to Italian Government control due to a number of causes principally left wing agitators who are hard at work. PISTOIA main party seems to be Christian Democrat. 2 A F LUCCA steps being taken to supply isolated Communes. 3 B F LIVORNO fishing decreased due to no gasoline for boats. 4 B F FLORENCE 21 of the 63 prisoners who escaped from FLORENCE jail have been recaptured. Search continues for remainder. Pass situation unsatisfactory (unsatisfactory 7). PISA girl murdered by negro soldier in area of SAN GIULIANO. Investigation proceeding. LIVORNO Italian courts now working well. Defascistization proceeding and comprehensive reports are due soon. LUCCA employees of GENIO CIVILE threatening strike for higher wages. 5 B F FLORENCE typhoid epidemic at PRATO almost finished. LIVORNO 12 cases typhoid reported on ELBA. Population in infected area instructed to sterilize water. Capt WHITEY investigated living conditions and

LUCCA no epidemic reports yet from northern Communes. 6 B F down to rock bottom. 7 B F FLORENCE has caused some anxiety but HQ /o representatives have visited and assumed responsibility. Situation re repatriated Italian prisoners of war has caused some problems biggest of which is transportation. Transit camp for 2,000 organized in FLORENCE. Also 350 bed hospital for emergency cases. Most ex prisoners of war arrive piece meal en route for the south. Transportation being sought from military units and also by rail. Situation otherwise under control. LIVORNO 2,000 handled 12 May. 13 May expected 6,000. Procedure to feed and transport them, south. Usually remain only 6 hours in LIVORNO. Can handle about 6,000 per day using present railway transportation. Capt BEATTY negotiating with Navy for use of ships. If successful capacity will be greatly increased. 8 B F FLORENCE slight downward trend probably due to exodus of troops. LUCCA rises call for increased pay. PISTOIA prices low and control good. 9 F LUCCA unemployed number 4,000. Mines lifted to 28 April 71,684. Only 1 casualty. Civilian situation poor. PISTOIA overall administration good.

- 1 BF GROSSETO heavy rain prevented May Day demonstrations. LIVORNO May Day very quiet. Only one case of violation of orders. Violators jailed and awaiting trial. PISA numerous small parades mainly due to success of Patriots in north. Increased activity of Communist Party on small scale. 2BF grain collected past week 12,924 quintals. Collected to date 1,710,164 quintals.
- 3 BF unless more gasoline allocated fishing will cease. Coal distributed to hospitals and bakeries only. None available for industry.
- 4 AF LIVORNO 50 cases handled past week.
- 5 BF AREZZO typhoid 14 cases. Chickenpox 9 cases.
- 6 BF 16 officers withdrawn for AUSTRIA.
- 7 DF AREZZO 10,000 refugees reported by CORR to be on their way to railhead. Holding about 800 in camps at the moment. Many without documents while some have German paybooks and articles of Wehrmacht clothing. It is hoped to evacuate as many as possible by rail and this requires AFHQ authority.
- 8 BF price draught cattle decreasing.
- 9 F considerable jubilation at successful end of Italian campaign.

Sitrep TOSCANA Region area under regional control MAYX.

1 BF GROSSETO public attention fixed on events in North ITALY. General impression is public hope for leadership from the North. PISA little political activity but a good deal of excitement over Patriot activity further north.

2 AF grain amassed to date 1697240 quintals Total past week 12990.

3 BF AREZZO supplies sufficient for coming week. GROSSETO availability of unrationed foods in markets improving. LIVORNO only serious shortage is that of tires.

4 AF LIVORNO 125 cases handled past week. Mainly for traveling without permit and illegal possession of firearms. No serious offences.

5 AF AREZZO general health good. Six 78 officers withdrawn from TOSCANA for northern Regions.

7 BF AREZZO vanguard of refugees returning to their homes after being liberated from the GERMANS arrived at AREZZO railhead 27 April 1945. Total 65. All placed temporarily in CORTONA refugee camp. Arrangements have been made to return 40 to their homes in PIEVE SANTO STEFANO as soon as transport is available. GROSSETO can take 100 at FOLLONICA Camp at 48 hrs notice.

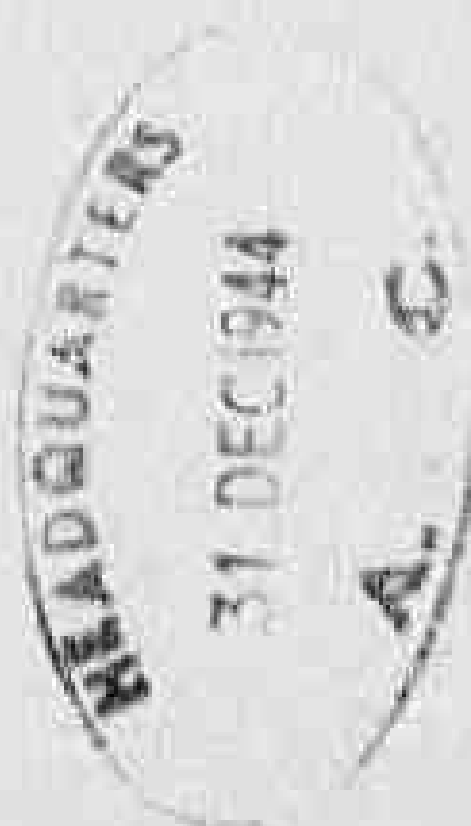
