Following signal received from IV CORPS and is forwarded for your information:
*Frontier ISUM Number 6 from IV CORPS to 5 ARMY to include 311000B. It is confirmed that the 36 French Division is now relieving 1 DMI. Relief will not be completed before 8 June. French liaison officer with this headquarters reports personnel 36 Division are ex FFI from southwest FRANCE. On 28 May Colonel JORDON Deputy Regional Commissioner of LIQUIRIA accompanied the Regional Legal Officer and the Provincial Commissioner called on Colonel PIROT commanding the French troops in western IMPERIA regarding the establishment of Allied Military Government in that area. Colonel PIROT received them courteously but stated that he had not instructions to permit the establishment of Allied military and that he would have to communicate with General GREBAY who in turn would have to call DOYAN. It was however agreed by Colonel PIROT that in order to enable the Provincial Commissioner to comply with his orders that the proclamations would be posted but no further action could be taken pending the conference with General DOYAN. 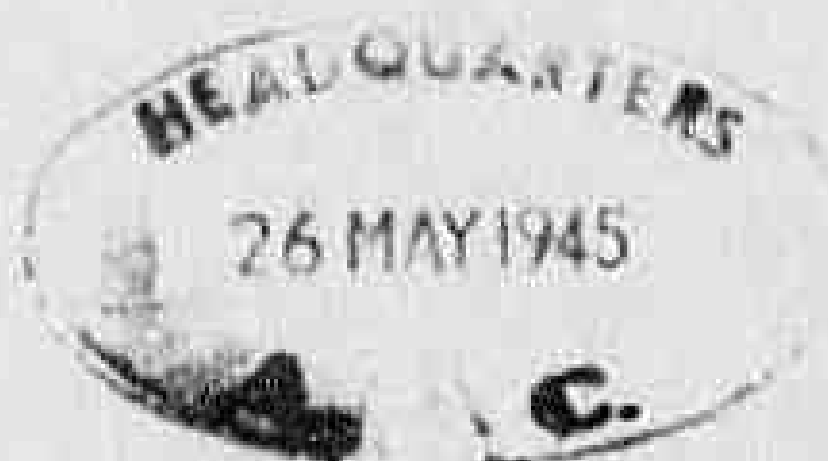

Sitrep No 19. Situation quiet and generally satisfactory. Evacuation refugees proceeding satisfactory in view of transport. 1100 evacuated last 7 days. First three political offenders tried in special nasine(?) courts SAVONA convicted and death penalty imposed in each case. Disarming Patriots continues but very great difficulty being experienced on opening Patriot centres. Patriots in IMPERIA very restless owing to expectation as to food and rest centres not being fulfilled.

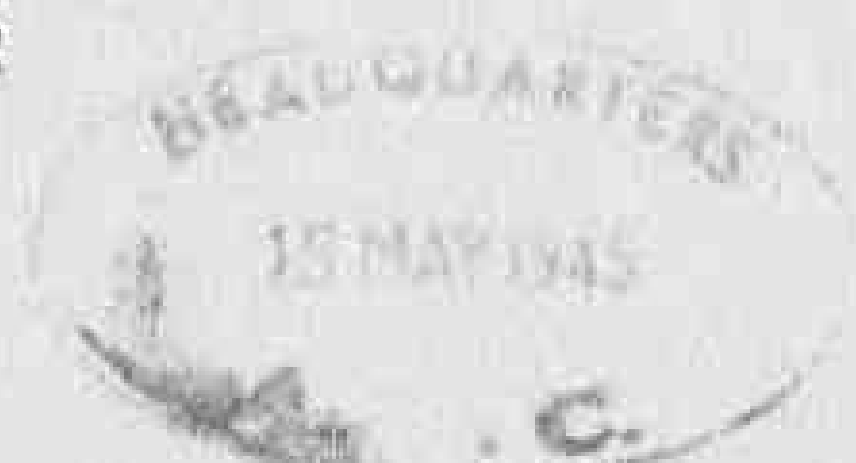

The following information of 11 and 12 May 45 has been received from LIBERIA Region:-

Situation satisfactory. The disarming of Patriots in LASSA, GNEBA and SAVANA is proceeding but in BASSA Province it is complicated by the previous French occupation, existing presence of French, and food shortage. A minimum bread ration of 100 grams has been maintained except in BASSA Province where transportation and communication difficulties necessitate the reduction of the ration to 50 grams.

Estimated casualties of 40 dead and 30 seriously wounded were caused by an explosion of an ammunition dump on the outskirts of SAVANA on 8 May. Local investigation indicates that the explosion was not due to hostile action.

It is reported that the French H.Q. Staff are holding informal ballots in villages on the subject of the return of territory to French rule in the part of BASSA Province still occupied by the French.

Being a trained soldier I always attach great importance to the sending of situation reports especially when communications are difficult. I was therefore surprised and disappointed when I received your cable 6817 of 3rd May stating that no news on Genoa had so far been received. Your telegram reached me on 5th May. ⁽¹⁾

I had already sent you situation reports as follows: MC/1 dated 25 April; and MC/2 Sitrep No.2 dated 30 April. These two reports were written in a field message book as I was separated from my field office and were despatched by military courier service. Then followed Sitreps No.3 of 2 May and No.4 of 4 May both of which were sent by the 57 Area Signals service. I had special enquiries made to ensure that all the above Sitreps had been accepted at the Signal Offices concerned and despatched. A further Sitrep is being sent today.

As we are dependent on military communications which are not under our control I feel I could not have done more than the above.

In addition we had a visit from a Staff Officer of G-5, 15 Army Group about 1st May and Hume paid me a visit on 2nd May and was given a full verbal report as, by that time, we had come under 5th Army. ⁽²⁾

As we are dependent on military communications which are not under our control I feel I could not have done more than the above.

In addition we had a visit from a Staff Officer of G-5, 15 Army Group about 1st May and Hume paid me a visit on 2nd May and was given a full verbal report as, by that time, 25 we had come under 5th Army.

Great confusion exists in my mind as to who is my next superior authority and through what channels communications should be sent. Hume, during his visit, indicated that for certain matters the Region would come under 5th Army A.M.G. and that G-5, IV Corps would also be in the chain of responsibility. (34)

The culminating point in the muddle occurred yesterday when I received from 15th Army Group telegram No. 9274 of 3rd May, a copy of which is enclosed. If there is one subject on which I should have thought it would have been necessary to deal direct with your H.Q. it is that of political activity dealt with in the telegram enclosed. (7)

I am sending a daily political situation report to 15th Army Group as directed and am of course repeating to your Headquarters.

As regards Sitreps, I am addressing these to IV Corps

It seems quite obvious to me that you will want normal reports etc direct from this H.Q. and that it is not the intention that 5th Army A.M.G. should collate all the information from this Region or that the channel of communication for all matters of importance should be through IV Corps and 5th Army A.M.G. I shall, of course, keep IV Corps and 5th Army A.M.G. informed of all matters which affect them as well as the local service authorities.
