Reference your AC/5095/Commerce dated 10 Mar 45 and this HQ T-12 dated 14 Mar 45.

1. This HQ receives demands for salvaged tyres sometimes from Transportation Sub-Commission, Tire Section, sometimes from Tire Section of Commerce Sub-Commission.
2. When the Director of Salvage AFHQ offers salvaged tyres to AC, it is obviously necessary that they shall be offered NOT direct to individual sections or sub-commissions but to whichever sub-commission or section is responsible for sub-allotting to other sub-commissions according to agreed priorities.

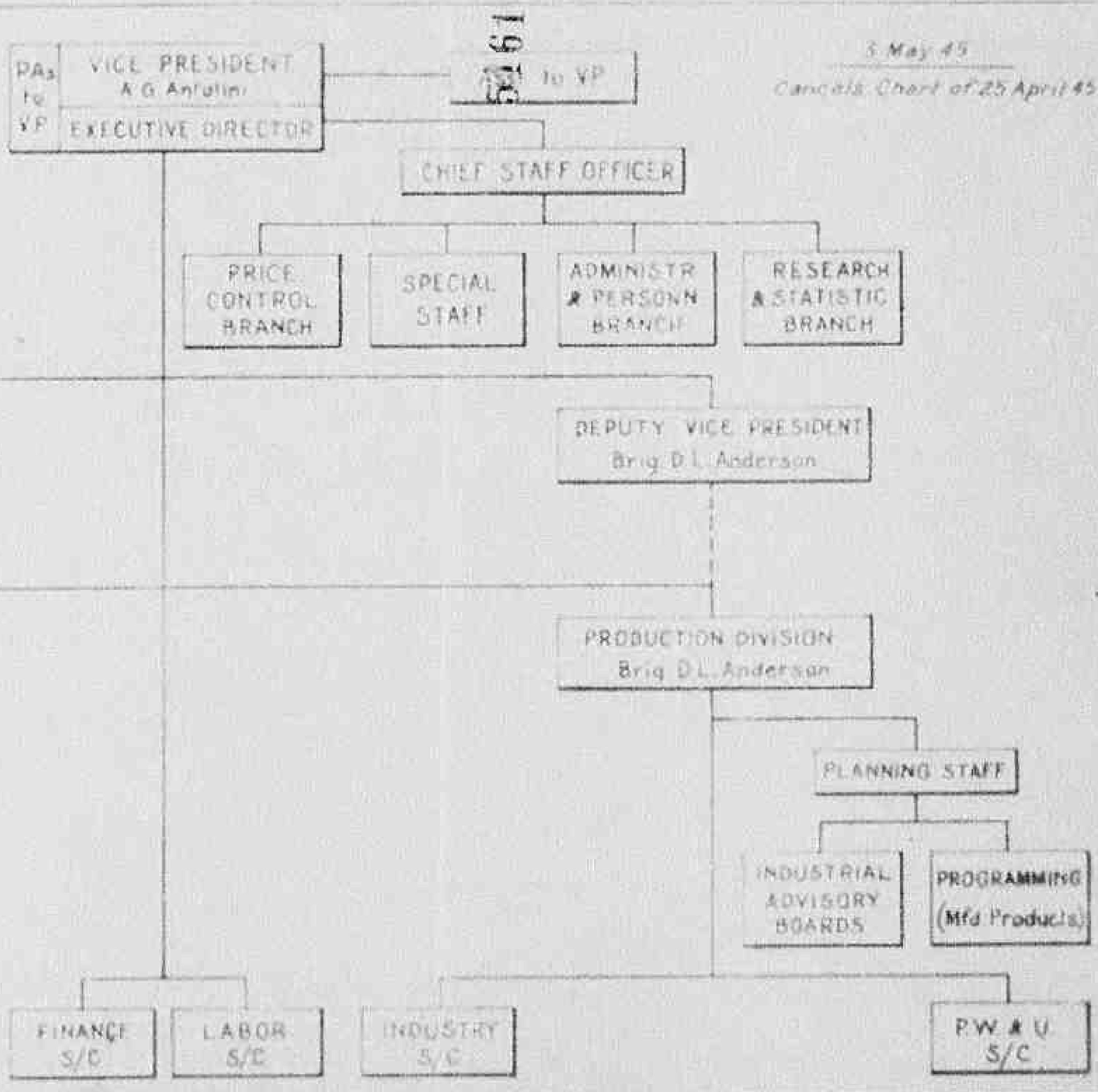

SUBJECT: Regionalization of Displaced Persons and Repatriation Sub-Commission.

TO: Distribution below.

1. As decided upon at the President's conference on 9 March, 1965, the Displaced Persons and Repatriation Sub-Commission will, in future, be regionalized. The division of responsibility is as indicated in the subsequent paragraphs. Regionalization will involve effective in the northern regions on the Regional Commissioners of FIMBITE, LACORPIL, LOMERDIL, VIMZIL and EMIL. ensure control within their respective Regions.

2. Responsibilities of the Displaced Persons and Repatriation Sub-Commission will include the following:-

- (a) Establishment of general policy concerning refugees, displaced persons and repatriation.
- (b) The allocation or re-allocation of available personnel for the administration of Group Headquarters and Camp Staffs. The usual practice of issuing movement orders through Regional Commissioners will be observed, and their prior concurrence obtained whenever possible.
- (c) The opening and closing of camps as dictated by the overall policy and control of equipment, stores and basic transport.
- (d) Visits to Camps and Centres by Officers of HQ DP and R S/C from time to time to ensure that a standard policy is maintained. Officers making such visits will always advise Regional Commissioners and, whenever practicable, call on their HQ beforehand.
3. The Regional Commissioner is responsible for the activity of the Sub-Commission in his Region in exactly the same way as he is for the activities of all other Sub-Commissions. This will include:-

- (a) Supervision of camps.
- (b) Effective action on such directives as may be issued concerning refugees, displaced persons and repatriation.
- (c) Disposal of surplus stocks for conversion to "Repatriation" purposes of centres.

3. The Regional Commissioner is responsible for the activity of the Sub-Commission in his Region in exactly the same way as he is for the activities of all other Sub-Commissions. This will include:-

- (a) Supervision of camps.
- (b) Effective action on such directives as may be issued concerning refugees, displaced persons and repatriated.
- (c) Financial arrangements for covering "ordinary" expenses of centres.
- (d) The provision of food to refugees and registration to males laid down by HQ, etc.

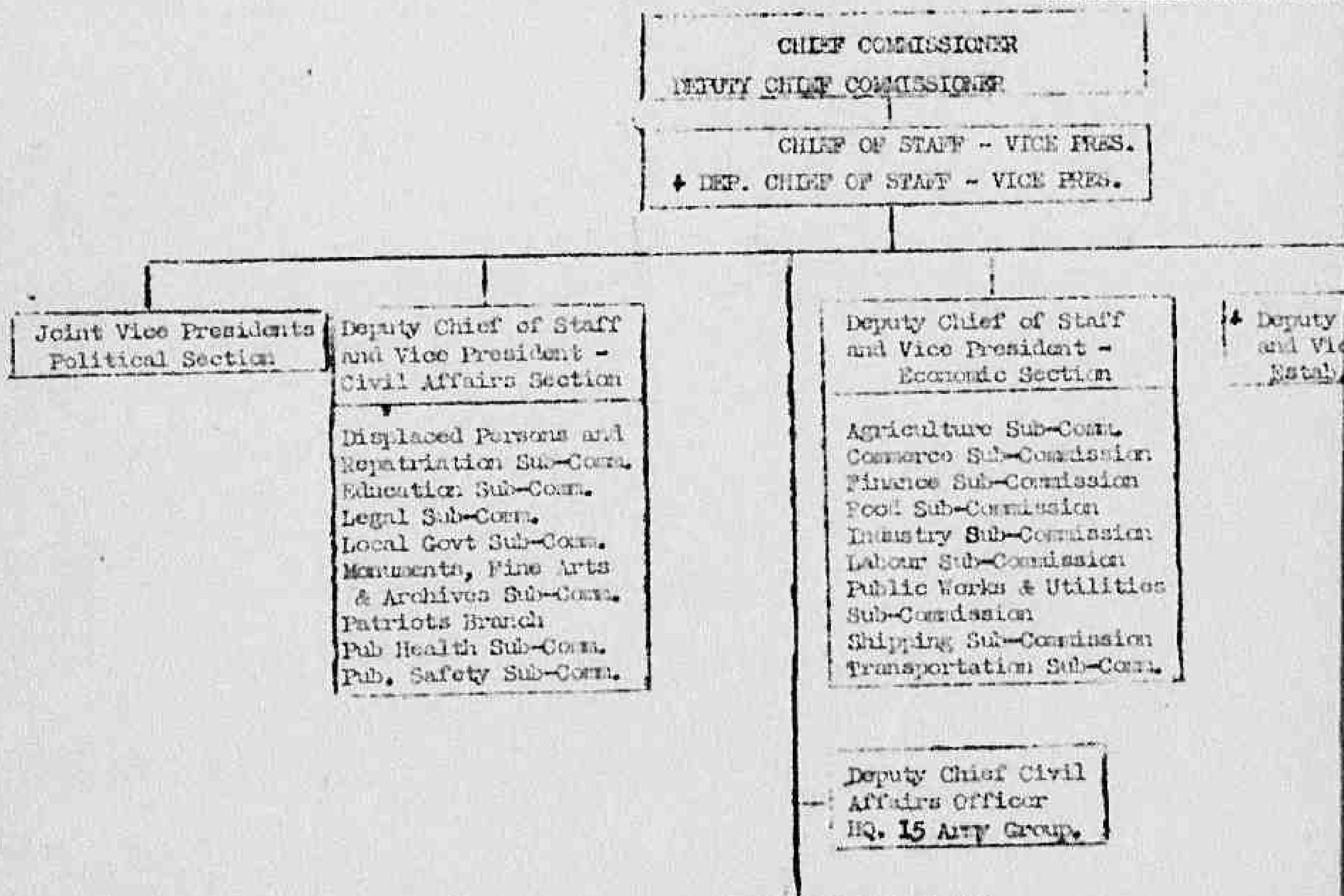

SUBJECT: Re-designation of Joint Directors,
Finance Sub Commission.

TO : Acting Chief Commissioner,
Allied Commission.

1. In order to give formal recognition to an existing condition and to regularize channels of communication, I would recommend that the Joint Directors of the Finance Sub Commission, be also designated Joint Financial Advisers to the Chief Commissioner, a status similar to that recently accorded to the Director of the Legal Sub Commission, who is also legal adviser to the Chief Commissioner.

2. The Finance Sub Commission occupies a position and fulfills a function analogous to those of your political and legal advisers, in that it is engaged in formulating the rules and conditions under which the work of the Allied Commission is carried on, both as regards the internal functioning of the Commission and its relations with the Italian Government. Within the Commission the Finance Sub Commission lays down the regulations for the expenditure of AM lire for AC/AMC purposes and performs the function of accounting for such funds. In this capacity it is desirable that the Joint Directors should have direct access to you to obtain your decisions on important points of principle.

3. As regards AC's relations with the Italian Government, the financial and accounting aspects will steadily become more important as our operating functions are shifted to the Italian Government. One outstanding example is the recent U. S. announcement that dollars corresponding to the lire paid out in Italy by American troops will be made available to Italy for the purchase of supplies. A host of financial problems must be dealt with to make this programme effective. You are in fact already consulting directly with Finance Sub Commission on these matters and my suggestion in para 1 above would give formal approval to this arrangement. Further, Finance Sub Commission has been in close contact with the Financial Adviser, G-5, AFHQ, since the

Allied Commission.

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2. The Finance Sub Commission occupies a position and fulfills a function analogous to those of your political and legal advisers, in that it is engaged in formulating the rules and conditions under which the work of the Allied Commission is carried on, both as regards the internal functioning of the Commission and its relations with the Italian Government. Within the Commission the Finance Sub Commission lays down the regulations for the expenditure of AM lire for AC/AMC purposes and performs the function of accounting for such funds. In this capacity it is desirable that the Joint Directors should have direct access to you to obtain your decisions on important points of principle.

SUBJECT: Organisation and Development of the Economic Section.

TO : Chief Staff Officer.

1. Some progress has been made in the inter office procedure of passing correspondence with the Economic Section. It has now been agreed that letters that are to be submitted through the Office of the COS to the A/CC for signature will all clear through one Economic Section officer; this to ensure that papers are properly prepared, files flagged and the conditions laid down in Office Memorandum No. 18 complied with.

2. It has been agreed that the Economic Section will prepare a list of staff duties for officers and while this may not be immediately forthcoming it will be followed from this end as a highly desirable organisational move.

3. There has been considerable correspondence between the Italian Prime Minister and the A/CC on the subject of derequisitioning of plants. The A/CC has ~~gone~~ on record to the effect that we must press for derequisitioning as vigorously as possible in the midst of this several reports have been received which would indicate that Economic Section is not fully geared up to get on with a rapid and comprehensive program of derequisitioning. There was a flour mill at BARI on which a report was furnished by P.S.B. This fairly new and up to date factory it was reported, could be put in use very quickly and action should have gone forward on to get it in operation some time ago. Several requests were received direct from the Italian Government with regard to specific plants and a comprehensive request was made for examination of the factories at present occupied by the military in TERNI Province.

4. It is suggested that the Economic Section can only deal with the whole problem of derequisitioning properly and forcefully if it creates through its Industry or Commerce Sub Commission a special agency. If a group of say, 3 qualified officers could be selected and given a directive to operate from the southern part of Italy on northwards it is felt that in co-ordination with the regular operation of the Sub Commissions involved the program could be quickly developed. The southern part is emphasised because as you know that area there has ample electric power.

5. Would you please show this to Major Quayle who, I believe, is familiar with the many derequisitioning requests that have come forward in the past few days.

Announcement is made of the designation of Colonel C. A. FINELEY, as Director, Displaced Persons and Refugee Sub-Commission.

XIX - DESIGNATION OF CHIEF LEGAL ADVISOR

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The Medical Supply Branch of the Public Health Sub-Commission is hereby transferred to the Economic Section where it will become a part of the Warehousing Branch of the Food Sub-Commission.

XVI -- DESIGNATION AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE CIVIL AFFAIRS SECTION

The present Administrative Section is hereby designated as the Civil Affairs Section. 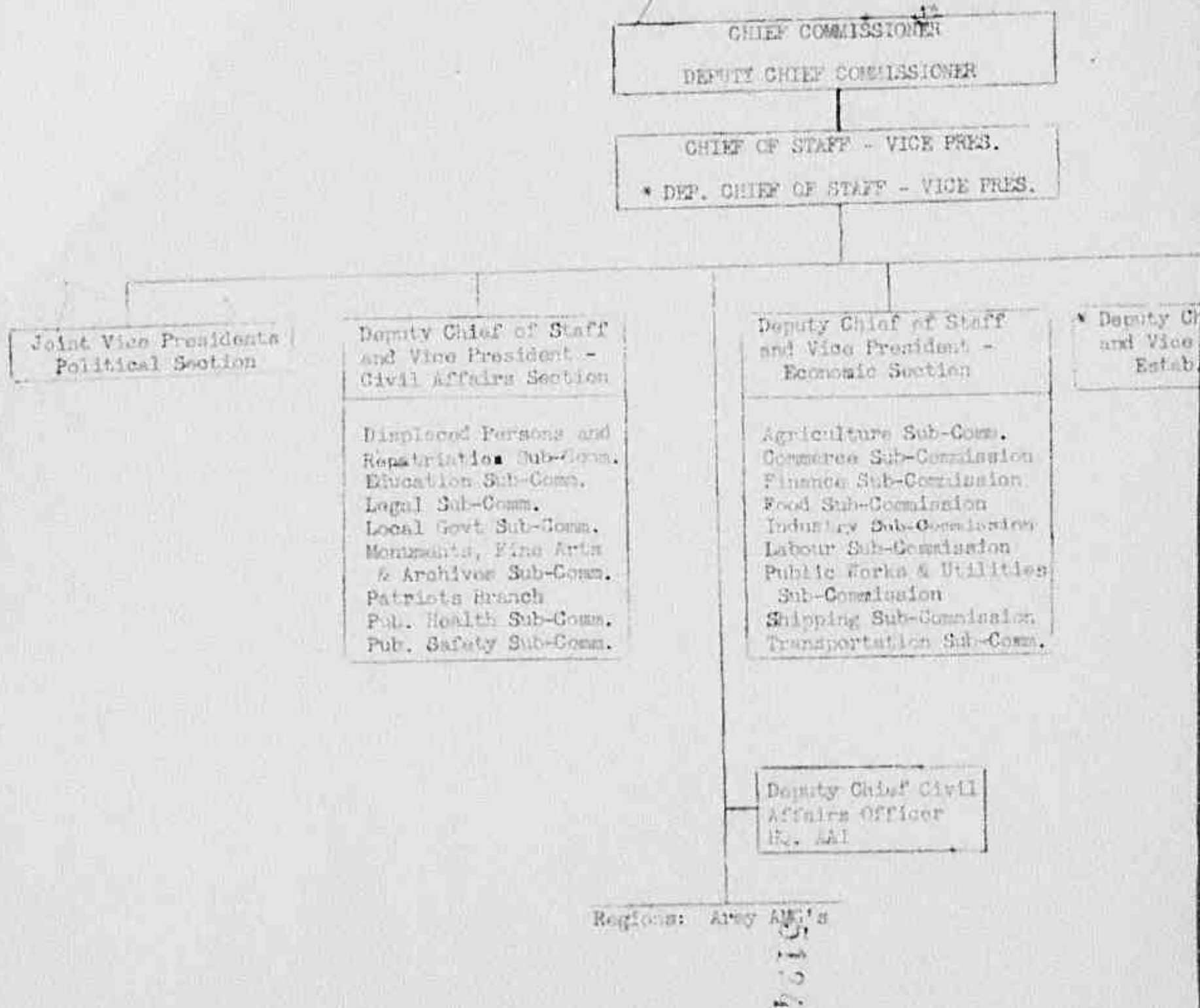
