1. Distribution Lists previously published by this headquarters are rescinded and Distribution List Number 6, attached, is substituted therefor:

2. The following information concerning Distribution List Number 6, is furnished for the guidance of all concerned:

a. A and H will be employed to indicate staff distributions. They are identical with the exception that H will not include those purely British sections shown in paragraph 1b of Part I.

b. Distribution B, C and D will be the same as X, Y, and Z respectively, with the exception that X, Y, and Z will not include the units and sections shown in Part VII and paragraph 1b of Part I.

c. Distribution A, B, C, and D normally will be employed on Allied Force Headquarters publications, whereas H, X, Y, and Z will appear on Headquarters NIOUSA publications.

d. Distributions B and X are devised to reach specified major commands as well as certain units to which no other channels of communication exist. Further dissemination of the information thus published is the responsibility of the major command concerned.

e. Distribution C and Y will cover the headquarters of armies, corps, air forces, base sections, special commands, and one copy for each division, brigade, regiment, group, and separate units of an echelon of equivalent size.

f. Distributions D and Z are designed as complete distributions and should reach all companies, squadrons, and detachments as well as all staff sections.

g. Distribution E which is normally given to Supply Directives of Headquarters, NIOUSA, is shown in Part VIII of the List. 5290

3. During redeployment operations major commands will examine distribution requirements periodically and report desired changes to this headquarters as often as is necessary to maintain the flow of distribution at the minimum.

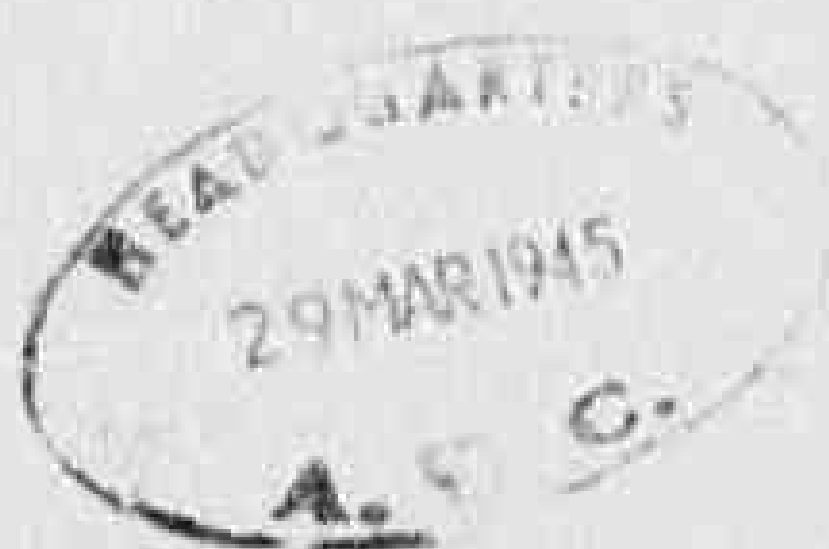

a. I and J will be employed in indefinite staff distributions. They are identified with the exception that J will not include those purely British sections shown in paragraph 1b of Part I.

b. Distribution B, C and D will be the same as X, Y, and Z respectively, with the exception that X, Y, and Z will not include the units and sections shown in Part VII and paragraph 1b of Part I.

c. Distribution A, E, G, and H normally will be employed on Allied Force Headquarters publications, whereas I, X, Y, and Z will appear on Headquarters USFSA publications.

d. Distributions B and X are devised to reach specified major commands as well as certain units to which no other channels of communication exist. Further dissemination of this information thus published is the responsibility of the major command concerned.

e. Distribution C and Y will cover the headquarters of army groups, armies, corps, air forces, task forces, special commands, and one copy for each division, brigade, regiment, group, and separate units of an echelon of equivalent size.

f. Distributions D and Z are designed as complete distributions and should reach all companies, squadrons, and detachments as well as all staff sections.

g. Appendix "A" shows Distribution E which is normally given to Supply Directorate of Headquarters, USFSA.

2. Distribution lists will be revised or issued as often as is necessary to conform to changes in the situation. Information on these matters

are identical with the exception that II will not include those supply British sections shown in part VII of Part I.

b. Distribution I, II and III will be the same as I, II, and III respectively, with the exception that I, II, and III will not include the units and sections shown in Part VII and excepted 16 of Part I.

c. Distribution IV, V, VI, and VII normally will be employed on Allied Forces Headquarters publications, whereas IV, V, VI, and VII will appear on Headquarters AFHQ publications.

d. Distributions II and III are devised to reach specified major commands as well as certain units to which no other channels of communication exist. Further dissemination of the information thus published is the responsibility of the major command concerned.

e. Distribution II and III will cover the headquarters of army groups, armies, corps, air corps, base sections, special commands, and one copy for each division, brigade, regiment, group, and separate units of an echelon of equivalent size.

f. Distributions II and III are devised as complete distributions and should reach all commands, agencies, and detachments as well as all staff sections.

g. Appendix "A" shows Distribution II which is normally given to Supply Directives of Headquarters, AFHQ.

2. Distribution lists will be revised or issued as often as is necessary to conform to changes in strength or location. Information on these matters should accompany any request for increase or decrease in number of copies required.

1. Reference your 204/20/COS dated 11 Dec 44.
 2. The question of "overall" economy was studied before submission of this HQ letter RVIII/37/126 dated 7 Dec 44. The points made by you are fully appreciated, but some of the Directives, etc., published by your HQ are of considerable interest to PO's in the field, who are in fact on many occasions the individuals most vitally concerned. Therefore such instructions must of necessity be circulated to them to ensure that they act in accordance with such instructions. In such cases one copy per Province is not sufficient.
 3. It is obviously impracticable, on the receipt of new instructions on the various aspects of AMG work, for P.O.'s to recall PO's, often from widely dispersed locations, to deliver such instructions verbally, and it has in the past been necessary to have orders, etc., reproduced, for circulation to officers in the field.
 4. It is realised that Executive Memoranda are republished eventually for insertion in the booklet "Instructions for the Guidance of officers of the Commission" but the instructions contained in these memoranda must of necessity become operative immediately they are published, therefore they must be circulated immediately on receipt.
 5. It is considered therefore from the point of view of AMG/AC as a whole, that the additional copies requested by this HQ, while not essential (they can and must be reproduced) are very desirable, as the increased circulation whilst not using more paper will be the means of saving labour and delay in instructions reaching PO's in the field will be decreased accordingly.
 6. As the PO's in the field require only the Directives containing general C.A.C. information and none concerning technical matters, the number of extra copies requested will be relatively small.

2. The principle is that external correspondence should only be signed by an officer, the delegation of responsibility being entirely at the discretion of the Regional Commander, but if a suggestion is required the following is offered for your guidance :

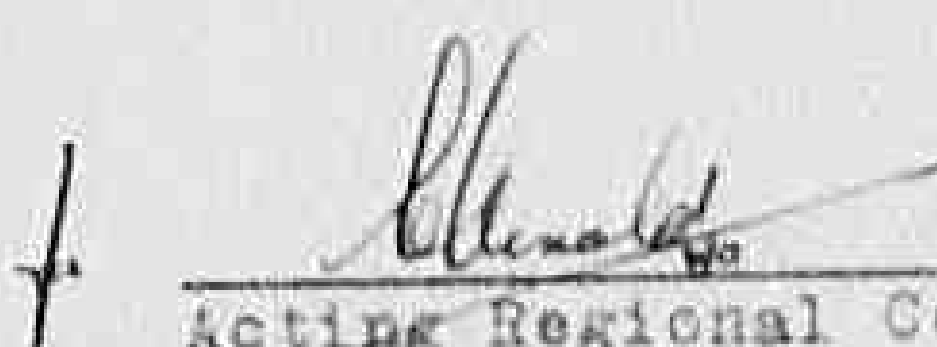
