Dear Sir:

I have examined the situation set forth in your letter of the 1st December, and accompanying aide memoire No. 239 of the same date, with particular care.

Our position in this matter is a rather difficult one, which may best be summed up by stating that while the Commission recognizes that the situation with regard to transport for your Delegation is far from an ideal one, we must, at the same time, take into account the position of the various activities of the Commission in the same respect, which also is far from ideal.

Mr. Skindaris' car was requisitioned, I am informed, in an entirely regular manner, and, although I regret to inform you, the fact of his being a Greek subject does not in any way invalidate the requisition. The car is now in use by the Director of our Public Works and Utilities Sub-Commission, with the magnitude and difficulty of whose tasks I am certain you are familiar, and is, in consequence, in use on most essential military activities.

I am sure that you will recognize that our position in this matter is not one of our own choosing, but rather a decision imposed upon us by military necessity, and that should circumstances at any time change for the better, we should be more than glad to assist you to the best of our ability.

MEMORANDUM TO: Chief Staff Officer, Office of the COS

SUBJECT: Release of Civilian Requisitioned Car to Greek Delegation
to the Advisory Council for Italy

1. The attached correspondence was turned over to this office by Major Quayle for investigation and appropriate action. This matter has been thoroughly investigated, and while the Greek Delegation unquestionably has a legitimate need for additional transport, this need is secondary when compared to that of the Allied Commission.

2. Accordingly, it is recommended that an appropriate letter be drafted for the signature of either the Chief Commissioner or the Chief of Staff stating that the existing heavy demands for headquarters transport make it impractical, from the standpoint of military necessity, to release the vehicle at the present time. It is believed that if the Commission released this car it would only establish a precedent under which other delegations to the Advisory Council would immediately bear pressure on us for release of vehicles to meet similar needs within their organizations. Having once consented, this Headquarters would be obliged for diplomatic reasons to grant similar requests.

3. The vehicle in question is our No #291, Chrysler Sedan, assigned to the Director of the Public Works & Utilities Subcommission (Colonel Jenny). This car has been properly requisitioned and is on full-time employment in connection with regular AG activities. The fact that it was requisitioned from a Greek subject should not be given any weight in favor of the Greek Delegation's request. It will be observed that this matter was previously investigated by the Establishment Section and was rejected.

4. Should you desire, I shall draft an appropriate letter.

I also bring to your attention that we are housed at a considerable distance from AO Headquarters and are not in position to avail ourselves readily of the transportation service provided by the Dispatch Office.

In view of the above can some arrangement be made to alleviate our particular problem.
