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SUBJECT: U.S. Personnel Ceiling for Civil Affairs Functions.

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1. In conformity with War Department instructions the personnel ceiling for US Army officers and men for civil affairs agencies has been set at 250 effective 30 June 1946. A recommendation has been made to the War Department for an increase of 30 persons; approval has not yet been received.

2. Based on the 250 ceiling allocation of US Army personnel has been made as shown.

6601 Military Govt Det 71 Officers 35 EM

This includes any US personnel assigned to liaison duties at Tenda or Bolzano.

2675th Regt 48 Officers 96 EM

This is based on a suballocation.

The three Service Sub-commissions

12 Officers 11 EM

Residual Functions of the AC

36 Officers 82 EM

3. The allocation of 12 officers and 11 EM to the three Service sub-commissions does not permit the assignment of any US Army officers to the IPW Section. Otherwise it permits the present allocation.

Air Forces S/C 7 Officers 5 EM

Land Forces S/C 5 Officers 9 EM

4. The allocation for the residual functions of AC do not permit the allocation of US Army officers to liaison duties or to CEM or to any advisory functions to the Italian Government. The allocation is based on what is considered will be final organization of US Army personnel on civil affairs duties in Rome. While the assignments set forth in the allocation charts are not mandatory they do indicate the basic ideas underlying the allocation.

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5. If other functions not listed must be performed it will be necessary for personnel to take on additional duties. It appears necessary even before the formal abolishment of the Allied Commission for it in fact to withdraw from those duties which are not to be performed afterwards. It is recognized that additional U. S. personnel should be assigned to the Displaced Persons Branch. (If the 30 additional persons are authorized as the result of recommendations to the War Department, it is contemplated that 10 additional officers and 10 additional enlisted men shall be allocated for duty with the Displaced Persons Branch).

6. The Allied Finance Agency and the Allied Supply Accounting Agency are not included in these considerations.

7. In order that final organizational instructions may be issued and made effective by 30 June 46, it is requested that any comments be submitted without delay. You will forward the comments, if any, of the Chief Commissioner, Allied Commission, with such recommendations as you deem fit.

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
