Reference 7 Para 3. The following is the position:-

Information Desk

Till 25 May 1946, nine girls were employed. At present date the number is six. These girls work during lunch hours, Wednesday, Saturday afternoon and Sundays. To allow time off it will be understood that only four are actually on duty. The work performed by these girls is issuing an average of 400 visitors passes per day, giving information to visitors, and information on the telephone. In the afternoon it is well known that between the hours mentioned namely 2 to 2.30, few Italians visit these Headquarters.

Escort Girls

On 25th of May there were 28 employed, this has been reduced to 20. Careful record is kept of all journeys, and these average out at approximately 30 each girl per day. These numbers will be cut as soon as possible, but for the present I consider the numbers shown necessary for efficient working.

With reference to civilian employees and ^{para} ~~cover~~ 12 of the Minutes of your meeting of the 9th July 1946, the following is the situation in the Civil Affairs Section:-

The number of civilian employees in this Section was given at your meeting as 64. Since the middle of June and by the end of July 8 civilian employees will have left this Section, but I cannot guarantee that they will not find work elsewhere in this building.

The number of civilian employees in Disper S/C has, however, gone up by 6 from 26 to 32. There will, therefore, only be a net reduction of 2, bringing the figure down to a total of 62.

Of this total of 62 - 32 are in Disper S/C and 14 in Public Safety S/C including the Security Division and Travel control - a sub-total of 46.

At the moment I do not consider these numbers excessive, but when the Liaison Groups have closed down and the Internees have been cleared from the civilian Internee Camp at Riccione and Disper S/C have settled down again, some slight reduction may be possible in these two Sub-Commissions. I fear, however, that Disper S/C may require reinforcements.

The matter is being carefully watched. I cannot, at this stage, make any proposal for comprehensive reduction.

X I suggest for urgent consideration that approval for engagement or re-engagement of civilian employees should be raised to Vice Presidents or equivalent level, ~~and~~ that the civilian personnel section should not engage or re-engage any civilian unless the application form is endorsed by the Vice President or similar authority concerned.

MEMORANDUM

The following is submitted as possible reply to Brig Carr's letter of 21 June 1946:

Reference your letter of 21 June 1946, subject: Civilian Staff, the following is furnished for your information:-

a. reference par 1. - Your remark that certificates were of no value is true only in part. This certificate was the first step in establishing responsibility for Italian civilian employees in the various sections and sub-commissions as well as opening the eyes of the responsible officer to flaws which may exist or might have existed in their organizational setup insofar as this personnel is concerned.

As refers to other sections or sub-commissions taking on personnel being released, there are at present only two (2) such units; Archives and Displaced Persons. Both of these units have submitted adequate proof that the increase of work warrants additional personnel.

b. reference par 3. - While it was originally planned by Hq. Comdt to cut considerably the messenger (escort girls) and cleaners strengths, the arrival of several new separate units in the building made it almost impossible. However, many are being released in both categories as of 30 June and some as of 15 July. Notwithstanding, I am in full accord with your comments.

The Hq Comdt was approached on the matter of cutting down the strength of the Reception Desks and is expected that such will be done on 30 June or soon thereafter.

g. reference par 4. - The only Liaison Group on the AC rolls as regards payment of civilian employees is the Public Safety Liaison RAAC with a strength of five (5). This is under your jurisdiction.

1. With reference to 2900-1 (Civ) of 6th June 1946, a statement of the numbers and grades of all civilian personnel remaining on the pay roll of this Section together with the necessary certificate was sent to G-1 (Civ.) on the 16th June.

As it is necessary to give civilian personnel a minimum of fourteen days notice and certain personnel were under notice, it was not possible to give a firm up-to-date certificate as of 16th June.

As the situation is constantly changing, I do not feel that certificates of this nature are of any value.

There is a prevalent tendency for civilian employees, surplus to requirements in one section or sub-commission to find employment elsewhere in this Headquarters. About five civilian employees will be leaving this Section at the end of the month, but I understand that most of them are being taken on elsewhere in this Headquarters. I presume that a careful check is kept on such re-employment.

2. G-1 (Civ.) records were not up to date. The Security Division of Public Safety Sub-Commission and the Displaced Persons Sub-Commission were not shown in the list of Civil Affairs Section. The Security Division were apparently included under the Headquarters Commandant, and Displaced Persons Sub-Commission under Land Forces Sub-Commission. I have spoken to G-1 (Civ.) about this and I understand the matter is being adjusted.

3. When one enters this building between 8.30 and 9 a.m. one is faced with six young ladies sitting at two tables at the foot of the main stairway, normally doing nothing. Casual observations during the morning reveal that comparatively few visitors are dealt with. When one returns to the office between 2 p.m. and 2.30 p.m. one is faced with the same reception-desk staff (they may not always all be in view), and they certainly have nothing to do during the afternoon and probably very little during the evening. It does not seem to me that such a luxurious reception-desk staff is in any way justified for the number of Italian who should now visit this Headquarters.

The above does not take into consideration the civilian reception staff at yet a third desk which normally appears to be a little more active.

I do not know whether a Lt. Colonel has certified that all this reception-desk staff are fully and essentially employed, but it does seem to me that a cut of 40% in their establishment could be made without any loss of efficiency.

If Liaison Groups are to continue for any length of time, I suggest this Headquarters call for and maintain a record of civilian staff by numbers and grades on Liaison Group pay rolls. Having regard to the steady reduction in the number of Liaison Officers, I feel there might be some revealing figures as regards the number of employees who have remained on the pay rolls.
