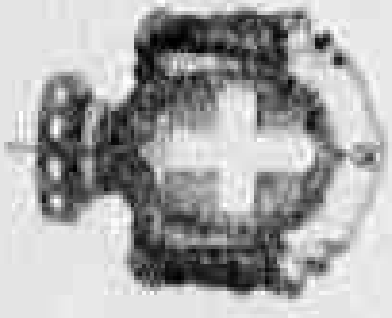

Some reports have mentioned that in the future there will be only one supreme Minister for the three Service Departments, and one Count Iachine has been mentioned for the post, with Undersecretaries in each Ministry responsible to him. Reliable sources state however that this solution is not likely to come about, and Gasparotto, who is now Minister for Post War Reconstruction in the present Cabinet, has privately said that the Ministries would carry on as before, and as for Count Iachine, he describes him as an "ass".

As regards the composition of the new Cabinet which will be formed after the 24th of this month, the Christian Democrats count on getting six seats, the Socialists at least three, the Communists at least three, Republicans one, and the National Freedom bloc at least one. Each political party will strive for the control of a Ministry, and thus instead of reducing the number it is more likely that more Ministries than before will emerge, so that the argument in favour of a Supreme War Minister loses weight.

Cavelotto has not been re-elected in his own Constituency, which is near Treviso but has been elected on the National list in Rome.

Information has been forthcoming to say that it would be a good thing to have the Italian-R.O.A.C. agreement ratified by the Government as soon as possible, as the present Cabinet will resign on June 24th, and difficulties and delays may result with the next Cabinet.

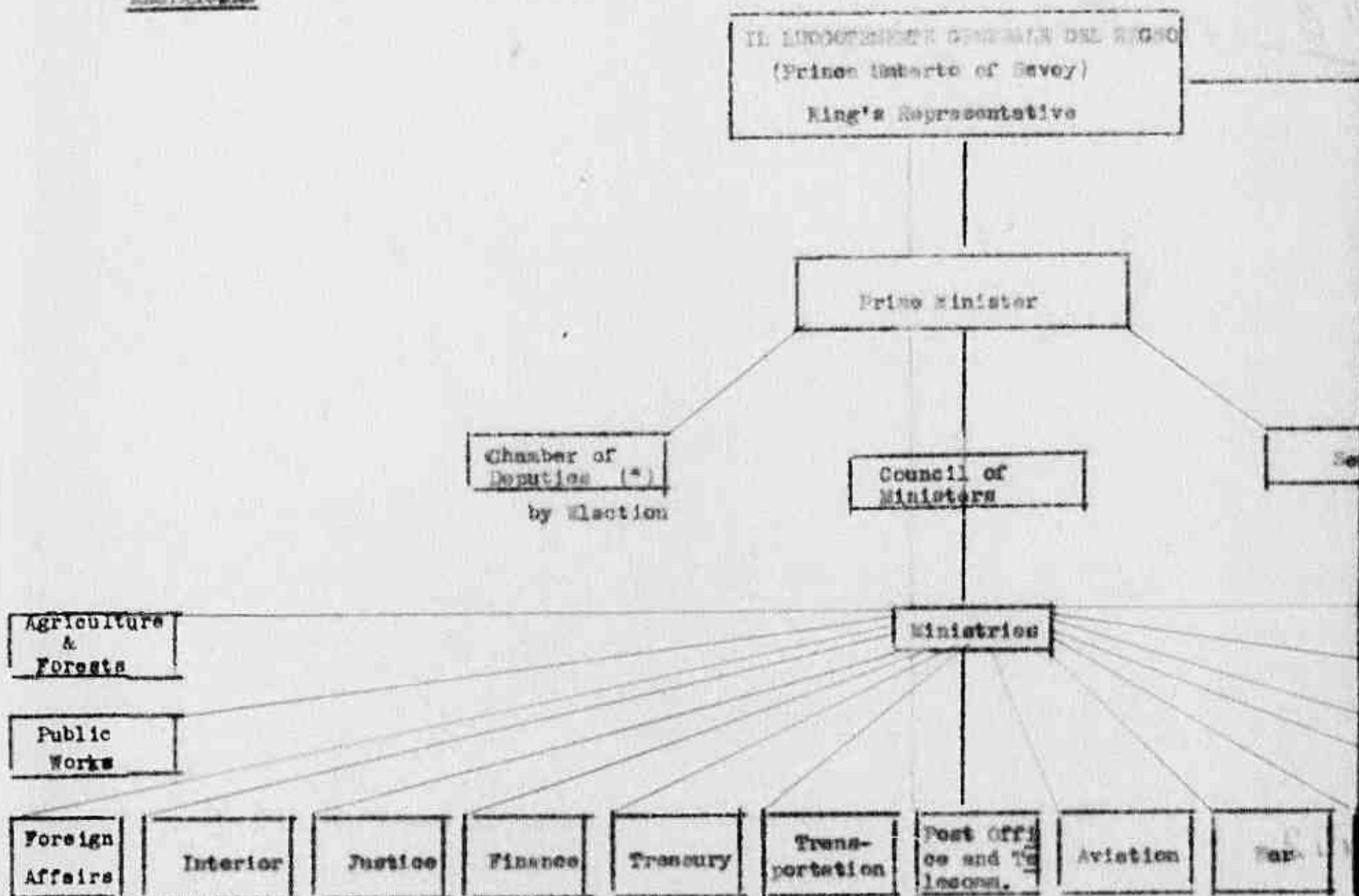

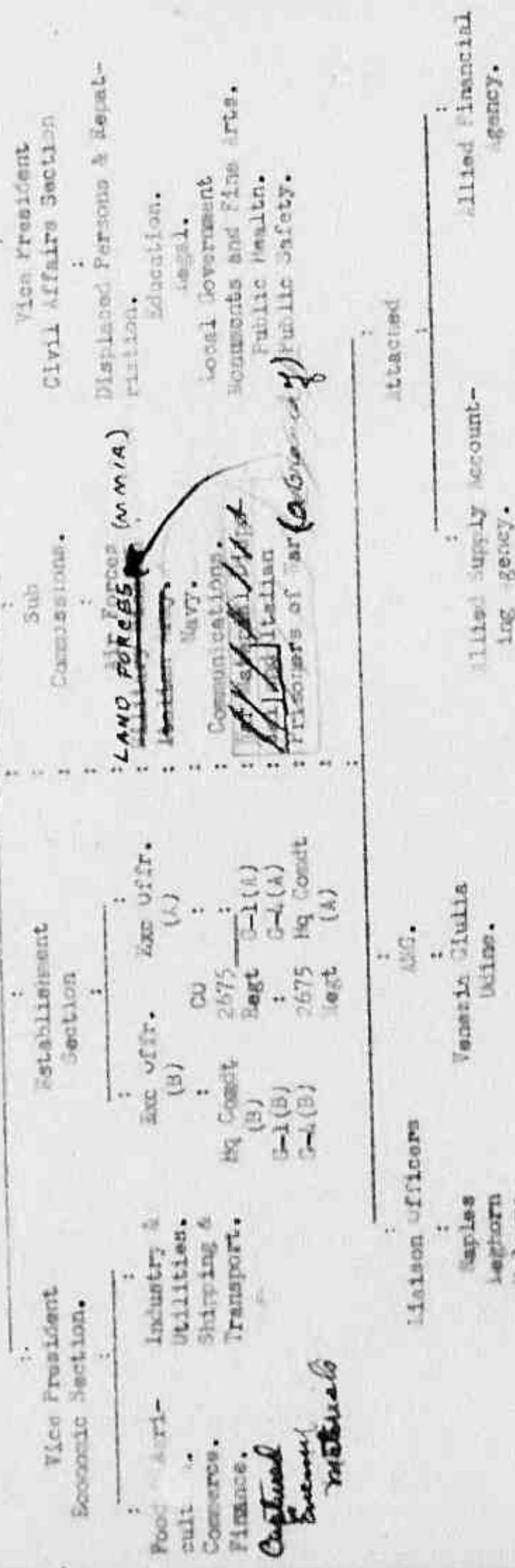
