Reference your radio 5795 August 8 no agreed time for transfer as fifth ARMY does not concur in position of DISTWO as explained in DISTWO radio SDI/1689 August 10 (not to all) turnover on 20 August will insure freeing FIFTH ARMY of commitments in corridor by 1 September at same time being available to DISTWO to adjust and assist in any unforeseen matters that may arise.

2. Require to relieve US troops in area are 3 officers 18 enlisted men for liaison detachments at DOBBIACCO and BRENNER passes; 2 officers and 93 enlisted men to guard GEM which fifth ARMY recommends DISTWO request for continued operation of GEM dumps. GEM dumps to be transferred to DISTWO. Total required for all reliefs are 5 officers 111 enlisted men.

3. Agreed diplomatic hotel at SALSOMAGGIORE will be taken over by DISTWO on 20 August.

4. Reference para 2 ourad 5795 desire turnover of remainder of TREVISO Province to 13 CORPS at same time as turnover to DISTWO.

5. Only US troops to be withdrawn about 20 August are 985 field Artillery battalion 84 GEM Mortar battalion 77 field Artillery group to CRTA both category 2 reserve in October. 536 field Artillery battalion under 178 field Artillery group

1. Tentatively agreed 5TH ARMY - DISTWO turn-over ICS corridor less remainder THEVISO Province effective 202359Z August. Final agreement will be reached by 5TH ARMY on 10th August.

2. Mutually agreed 5TH ARMY - 13 CORPS to turn over remainder THEVISO Province effective 202359Z August.

3. Letter listing Enclaves to be retained, distribution of CEM camps, and local resources required is being forwarded separately. Minutes of meeting will be forwarded as soon as available.

4. DISTWO will request AFHQ for GSUS now working in area which they wish to retain upon release by 5TH ARMY. Numbers approximately 1700 POWS are being recommended by 5TH ARMY.

5. DISTWO will accept responsibility for guarding and administering GSUS with MNS when equivalent 2 Battalions (approx 1000 troops) are made available to DISTWO. Until then essential POW Command retain responsibility. It must be released or closed out between 1st September and 1st October. DISTWO will also accept responsibility for Diplomatic Hotel SALSOMAGIONE effective 202359Z August.

6. 16 Evac Hospital will remain present location until relieved by 15 Field estimated 1st October.

Security Patrols

10. In view of the relatively small number of British tps in NW ITALY, it is desired to show these tps as much as possible. Security patrols will therefore be org as follows:-

These patrols may be drawn from the eqns in 2 Dist res, which are at 12 hrs notice, but will not be drawn from the eqn in op of Areas, unless the Area Comd concerned gives orders or permission to that effect.

Regts will ensure that these patrols are in touch by wireless and can be redirected or recalled at short notice if required.

11. Maint of Law and Order in AG Territory

The initial responsibility for maint of law and order is an AG com. For this purpose the Carabinieri are under control of AG. If the Carabinieri prove insufficient the local comd will provide mil assistance at the request of the local AG authority. Where possible Italian tps should be used initially in preference to Allied tps, but this must be left to the discretion of the local mil comd.

When time permits all requests by AG for assistance will be made through the Regional HQ to the appropriate Mil HQ (see para 8 above), who will, if in agreement, detail the tps required.

12. Maint of Law and Order in Italian Government Territory (IGT)

Within IGT the Italian civil authorities have under their control the Carabinieri for the purpose of maintaining law and order. If the Italian authorities are unable to quell a disturbance with their own resources, they should call upon the local Italian Military Headquarters for the assistance of Italian tps. If no Italian tps are available, or if there is still need for additional tps, they should call upon the local Army/SA Area Comd concerned for assistance.

Upon receiving such a request the Allied Comd will refuse assistance, and will point out to the Italian authorities that the quelling of civil disturbances is a matter for the Italian administration. If, however, he is of the opinion that Allied military interests are or may be involved, assistance will be provided. Before rendering assistance he will warn the local Italian official making the request, that the area is liable to be made forthwith into Allied military zone. If time permits, the Plan, Area/Sub Area Comd will also consult the local AG officer, and seek instructions from HQ 2 District before the employment of tps is authorized. The Plan, Area/Sub Area Comd will inform HQ 2 District as soon as possible of any request made to him or to any subordinate comd, and the action taken thereon.

1. Not prepared to give final approval requested by you without hearing DISTWOC views. However consider plan sound in principle for discussion at meeting at Headquarters COMARMC on 8th August. Final plan when agreed will be submitted to this Headquarters for approval.

2. Our comment on your paras are as follows.

A. Your paras 2 and 3. No exceptions or reservations required by this HQ but approval is subject to DISTWOC being able to meet new commitments from present resources or from COMS to be transferred from 5TH ARMY.

B. Your para 4.

1. Understad 16th Evacuation Hospital should remain present location until transferred to 13 CORPS and not moved south of ALPENTINES.

2. Consider Diplomatic Hotel at SALSO MAGIONE is an Allied commitment and should therefore be transferred to DISTWOC and not 5TH ARMY.

3. Necessary enclosures including hospital at MONTAG and staging area around VERONA railroad station should be retained for POW Command until movement of US POW completed. Also any additional enclosures considered necessary.

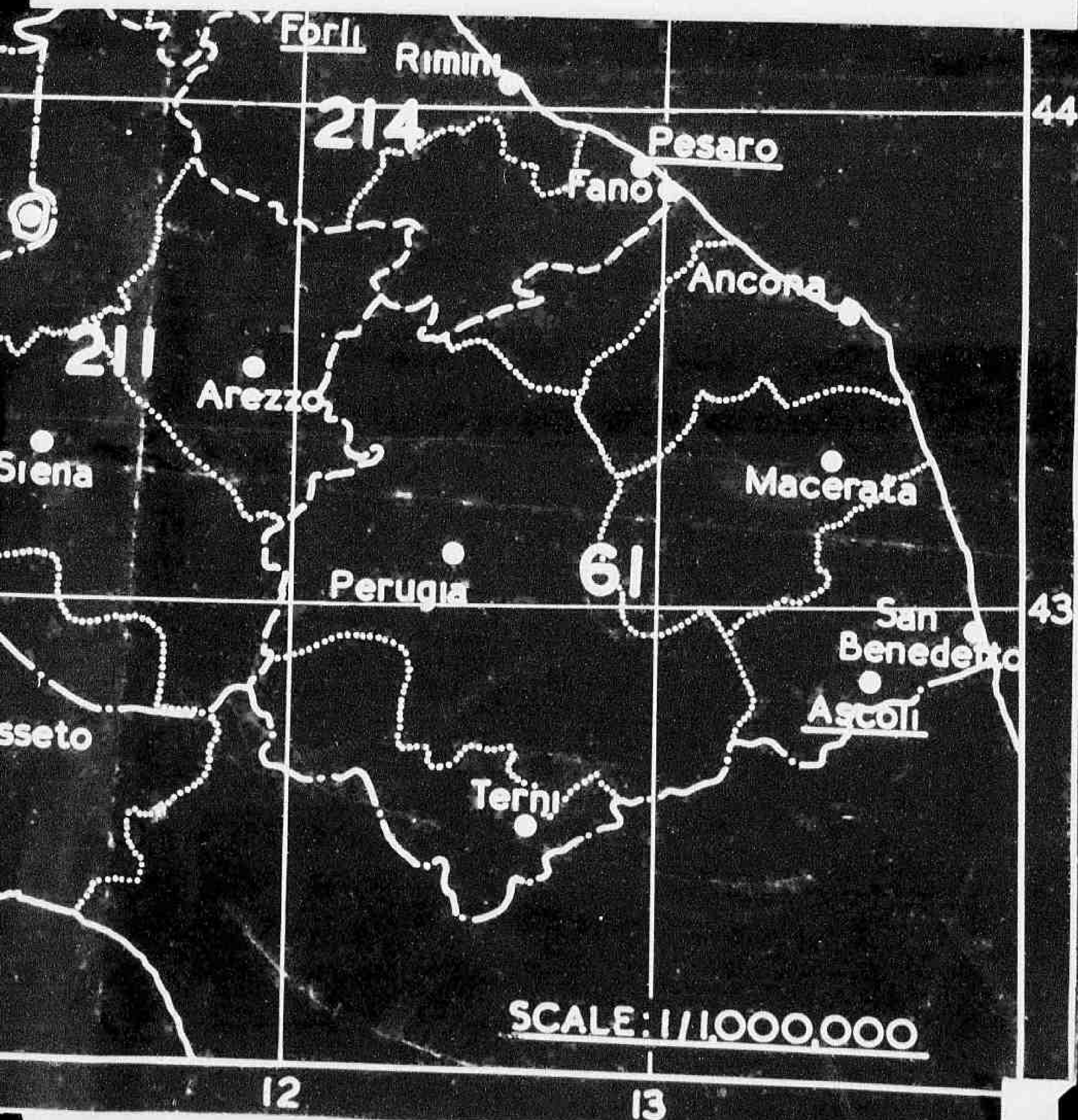




Reconnaissance Map of Central Italy, No. 1

COMMAND IN THE MEDITERRANEAN THEATRE

With reference to your memorandum of 1 June forwarding a report (COS(45)369(0)) by the British Chiefs of Staff on the future organization of command in the Mediterranean, I have been instructed by Field Marshal Alexander to submit the attached paper giving his views on this subject. In addition Field Marshal Alexander offers the following comments on certain points dealt with in the British Chiefs of Staff Report.

a. GRASSE and the DODECANESE (Paras 8, 17b, and 17(c)(iii) of the Report).

(1) GRASSE.

It is agreed that the commitment in GRASSE is no valid reason for the continuation of AFHQ but there would be considerable administrative disadvantages in transfer of responsibility to MIDDLE EAST for some time yet. Moreover it is preferable for political reasons that GRASSE should not pass to MIDDLE EAST at present.

(2) DODECANESE.

The general question of division of territorial responsibility between SACRED and MIDDLE EAST is dealt with in the attached paper, where it is argued that the DODECANESE (in common with all other Italian territory in EUROPE) should continue to be the responsibility of SACRED. Although this is the logical solution, the fact that MIDDLE EAST has in practice handled the DODECANESE situation, and is now responsible for administering Allied Military Government there, is good reason for recognising officially the de facto position.

b. FRENCH NORTH AFRICA (Paras 7 and 17(c)(ii) of the Report).

The French are already responsible for FRENCH NORTH AFRICA, except that we have retained certain rights in respect of ports and airfields, and the stationing of the necessary garrisons to operate them.

The same remarks apply to CORSIKA.

c. NAVAL and AIR COMMAND. (Paras 17(c)(vi)(vii) and (viii)).

(1) These proposals are generally agreed, but it is suggested that the

Although this is the logical solution, the fact that MIDDLE EAST has in practice handled the DOBBIAIUSSE situation, and is now responsible for administering Allied Military Government there, is good reason for recognising officially the de facto position.

b. EUROPE NORTH AFRICA (Paras 7 and 17(c)(ii) of the Report).

The French are already responsible for EUROPE NORTH AFRICA, except that we have retained certain rights in respect of ports and airfields, and the stationing of the necessary garrisons to operate them.

The same remarks apply to GIBRALTAR.

c. NAVAL and AIR COMMAND. (Paras 17(c)(vi)(vii) and (viii)).

- (1) These proposals are generally agreed, but it is suggested that the possibility of giving the three C-in-C MIDDLE EAST the same territorial responsibility should be examined. The MEDITERRANEAN BALKANS and MIDDLE EAST in fact constitute and form one integral area on imperial communications to INDIA and the FAR EAST.
- (2) As regards the position of C-in-C MED, it has been considered hitherto how that he is already the Naval member of the C-in-C Committee MIDDLE EAST, and that in his absence from meetings he has been represented by Flac Officer LEVITT and EASTERN MEDITERRANEAN.

COMMAND IN THE MEDITERRANEAN THEATRE.

PRESENT SYSTEM OF COMMAND.

1. A note outlining the present system of command in this theatre is attached at Appendix 'A'. The main points which emerge from this note are:

- a. SACRED's Command Group, which is the machinery through which he exercises inter-allied inter-service command, is a very small organization. Its retention or abolition would have no effect on reduction in the size of AFHQ.
- b. Matters of exclusively US Army concern are handled by the US Theatre Headquarters USMACV. On the British side there is no separate theatre command designated as such. The difference between the US and the British arrangements is not as great as would appear, but it has some effect on practical working particularly in regard to the distribution of correspondence and channels of general staff control.

FUTURE SYSTEM OF COMMAND.

2. The choice of future system of command lies between the following broad alternatives:
 - A. The retention of SACRED and Allied inter-service command generally on present lines.
 - B. Command through an inter-allied inter-service committee as shown diagrammatically at Appendix 'B'. The only material change from the present system is that the authority now vested in one man would be vested in a committee.
 - C. Command through an Allied Military Commander and Allied staff, coordinating with the two other services. This is shown diagrammatically at Appendix 'C'.
 - D. Command through national inter-service committees as shown diagrammatically at Appendix 'D'.

CONSIDERATIONS AFFECTING THE CHOICE OF FUTURE SYSTEM OF COMMAND.

4. The primary reason for which a Supreme Allied Commander was appointed in the Mediterranean Theatre was to exercise unified command over Allied sea, land and air forces in order to conduct a major campaign. Even though actual hostilities have now ceased, the whole of EUROPE is in a most unsettled state. This applies particularly to Southern EUROPE and the BALKANS where the ultimate ownership of territories on the frontiers of YUGOSLAVIA, ALBANIA, GREECE, ITALY and FRANCE is in dispute. The general situation will inevitably be uneasy until the final European peace settlement. The possibility of having to use force to impose the terms of that settlement, or to prevent unilateral military action by any of the interested nations in the meantime, cannot be ruled out.

Responsibility for controlling this situation is an Allied commitment. It involves the three fighting services and the coordination of Allied political action. The authority vested in and consequent prestige enjoyed by a Supreme Allied Commander together constitute a powerful means of "putting over" Anglo-American policy and of ensuring that it is accepted without delay and without resistance. The recent settlement of the disputes with the Yugoslavs and French in 1944 and 1945 Italy respectively are good examples. For these reasons alone there is evident advantage in retaining for the time being unified Allied command over the three fighting services as at present set up in this theatre.

5. The choice of the future system of command is also dictated by the following:

a. Command of the Allied Occupational Forces in Italy.

It has been proposed to the Combined Chiefs of Staff in May 1943 that an Allied corps of two divisions should be retained in Italy at least until the end of the year, and probably until the final peace settlement in Europe. Since Allied command in some form (alternatives A, B or C) must be retained, or the corps commander must report back direct to the Combined Chiefs of Staff.

b. Control of the Allied Commission and Administration of AMG.

Control of the Allied Commission can only be vested in an Allied representative or an Allied committee; executive responsibility for the operation of AMG can only be vested in an Allied commander. If, therefore, one of the alternatives B or D is adopted, it would be necessary to appoint an Allied Military Governor for Italy reporting direct to the Combined Chiefs of Staff.

c. Operation of the Anglo-French Naval Agreement.

Under COS 352 (revised) operational control of the French Fleet is vested in the Allied Naval Area Commander who is subordinate of SACMED. It would appear, therefore, that if either or both SACMED and an Allied Naval Area Commander are abolished, a fresh agreement would have to be made with the French Government. The French are unlikely to accept any change without protracted and difficult negotiations, which might have serious adverse naval repercussions.

d. Execution of Allied Administrative Responsibilities.

Any system of command which does not provide for retention of an Allied commander in some form would make the execution of Allied administrative responsibilities so difficult as to be unworkable in practice. These responsibilities, such as repair and docking of war and merchant ships, civil affairs, communications, labour, solid and liquid fuel, local resources and financial matters, form the greater part of the day-to-day work in this theatre. If there is no form of Allied command, action could only be taken after coordination and agreement between the British and US staffs concerned. This would probably become so cumbersome and slow a procedure as to make impossible the orderly execution of Allied administrative responsibilities. Alternative D is not therefore practicable.

PARTICULAR CONSIDERATIONS ATTENDING BRITISH NAVAL, ARMY AND AIR COMMAND.

6. British Naval and Air Command.

While for the reasons given in paragraph 4 there is advantage in the retention of the three fighting services for the present, it will

Continuation of the Anglo-French Naval Agreement.

Under GNS 358 (revised) operational control of the French fleet is vested in the Allied Naval Area Commander who is subordinate to SACMND. d. Execution of Allied Administrative Responsibilities.

These responsibilities, such as repair and docking of war and merchant ships, civil affairs, communications, labour, solid and liquid fuel, local resources and financial matters, form the greater part of the day-to-day work in this theatre. If there is no form of Allied command, action could only be taken after coordination and agreement between the British and US staffs concerned. This would probably become so cumbersome and slow a procedure as to make impossible the orderly execution of Allied administrative responsibilities. Alternative D is not therefore practicable.

PARTICULAR OPERATIONS ATTRIBUTED BRITISH NAVAL, ARMY AND AIR COMMAND.

6. British Naval and Air Command.

While for the reasons given in paragraph 4 there is advantage in the retention of unified command over the three fighting services for the present, it will probably be desirable towards the end of the year for C-in-C Med and Air C-in-C MED to establish their headquarters in MALTA and the MIDEAST respectively. There is no difficulty in the release of either the naval or air C-in-C from the control of SACMND at any time that it is decided that this is the appropriate course. At the same time the physical move of their headquarters from ITALY does not necessitate such release, provided arrangements are made for the appropriation representation to remain at SACMND's Headquarters. The time of release should be decided later in accordance with the way in which the Mediterranean situation develops, and with regard to the considerations set out in para 4. Then release is effected the system of command in Alternative B or C should be adopted.

7. British Army Command.

Attention is drawn to paragraph 1b and Appendix A where it is explained that SACMND, in his purely British capacity, exercises his British command functions through an Allied headquarters. It is considered that the US system, whereby the US Theatre Commander exercises command through a US Theatre HQ within the General Framework of AFHQ is preferable. It is accordingly considered that a British headquarters should be organized on similar lines to USMCSA. This

involves no increase in personnel. The main advantage is that it would produce a direct British command and staff channel for dealing with British theatre problems. This is of increasing importance in the post-hostilities and redeployment phase on which we have now entered.

TERRITORIAL EXTENT OF THEATRE COMMAND.

8. The future territorial extent of the theatre command depends mainly on the system of command it is decided to adopt. If it is decided to terminate Supreme Allied inter-service command, there would be good reason to reduce the Allied command in ITALY to the smallest possible size, and to pass responsibility for the BALKANS to the US and the British Middle East commands. If it is decided to retain Supreme Allied inter-service command, it is evident that in the light of the considerations set out in paragraph 4, there is advantage in continuing SACMED's responsibilities for the whole of ITALY, all Mediterranean islands (excluding MALTA and CYPRUS), and all BALKAN countries. Both politically and from the intelligence aspect the BALKANS should be dealt with as a whole by one HQ. Yugoslav affairs and reactions will continue to affect ITALY and ALBANIA; and there is always the possibility of difficulties and incidents over JUGOSLAV-ALBANIAN-YUGOSLAV-GREEK relations. Over the whole of the BALKANS there is the predominating influence of RUSSIA. In these circumstances it is suggested that the appropriate division between SACMED on the one hand and the US and British commands in the MIDDLE EAST on the other, is that the former should be responsible for GREECE and European affairs, and the latter for territories in ASIA, AFRICA and the Arab and Moslem countries (including TURKEY). When Supreme Allied inter-service command is terminated, the above division of responsibilities should be reconsidered and adjustment made in the light of the situation obtaining at the time.

CONCLUSIONS.

9. The discharge of Allied responsibilities in general makes advantageous, and of administrative responsibilities in particular necessitates, the retention of some form of Allied command in ITALY for a considerable period yet, and probably until the peace settlement in ITALY.
10. For so long as it remains advantageous to concert naval, military and air action through a supreme inter-service commander, the appointment of SACMED should be retained and the system of command in the Mediterranean should continue as at present. When these considerations no longer apply, the Naval and Air Commanders-in-Chief should be released from subordination to SACMED. At this stage the system of command outlined in Appendix '3' or '4' should be set up.

APPENDIX 'A'.

NOTES ON PRESENT STRUCTURE OF COMMAND IN MEDITERRANEAN THEATRE.

1. a. Allied Force HQ is an Allied army HQ, headed by a small Command Group exercising operational command and coordination over the three services. This Command Group consists only of Supreme Allied Commander, Deputy Supreme Allied Commander, Chief of Staff, CAO and Deputy CAO, Deputy Chief of Staff, Supreme Allied Commander's Secretariat, and the Joint Planning Staff. A great deal of the staff work of the Command Group is, however, done by AFHQ.
b. The naval and air theatre HQs are self contained organisations, completely separate from and independent of AFHQ.
c. Political guidance is given to the Supreme Allied Commander and the naval and air Commanders-in-Chief through the office of the US and British Political Advisers.
2. In its purely army aspect, AFHQ is the headquarters through which:
 - a. The Supreme Allied Commander exercises Allied command over the US and British land forces.
 - b. The Supreme Allied Commander, being the Commander of the British land forces in this theatre, exercises command over such forces.The US counterpart to b above is the Deputy Supreme Allied Commander (who is also CG MTOUSA) working through MTOUSA. It should be noted here that US portions of certain integrated staff sections of AFHQ constitute the corresponding staff sections of MTOUSA. G-2 is an example.
3. Actual integration in AFHQ is of necessity confined to those general and special staff sections and to certain divisions of staff sections which deal with matters that are of common concern to both Allies. Intelligence, operations, movements and civil affairs are examples. Other matters, such as personnel questions, are handled by separate and parallel US and British general staff sections (e.g. G-1 American and G-1 British). In some cases, there are separate and parallel US and British divisions within an integrated general staff section (e.g. G-3 Org American and G-3 Org British).
4. Apart from facilitating the coordinated discharge of Allied functions, integration results in a considerable economy in both British and US staffs which would otherwise be duplicated.

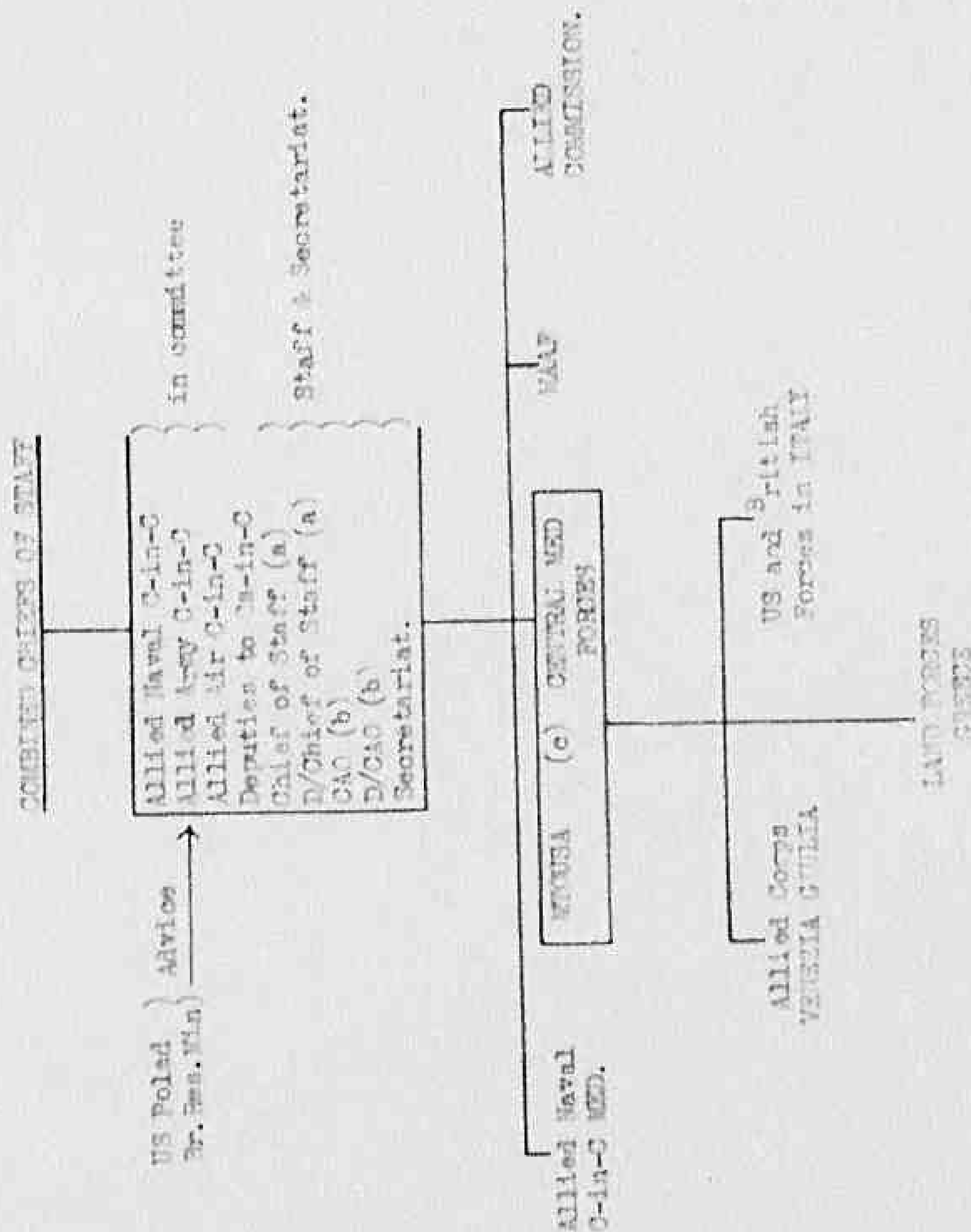

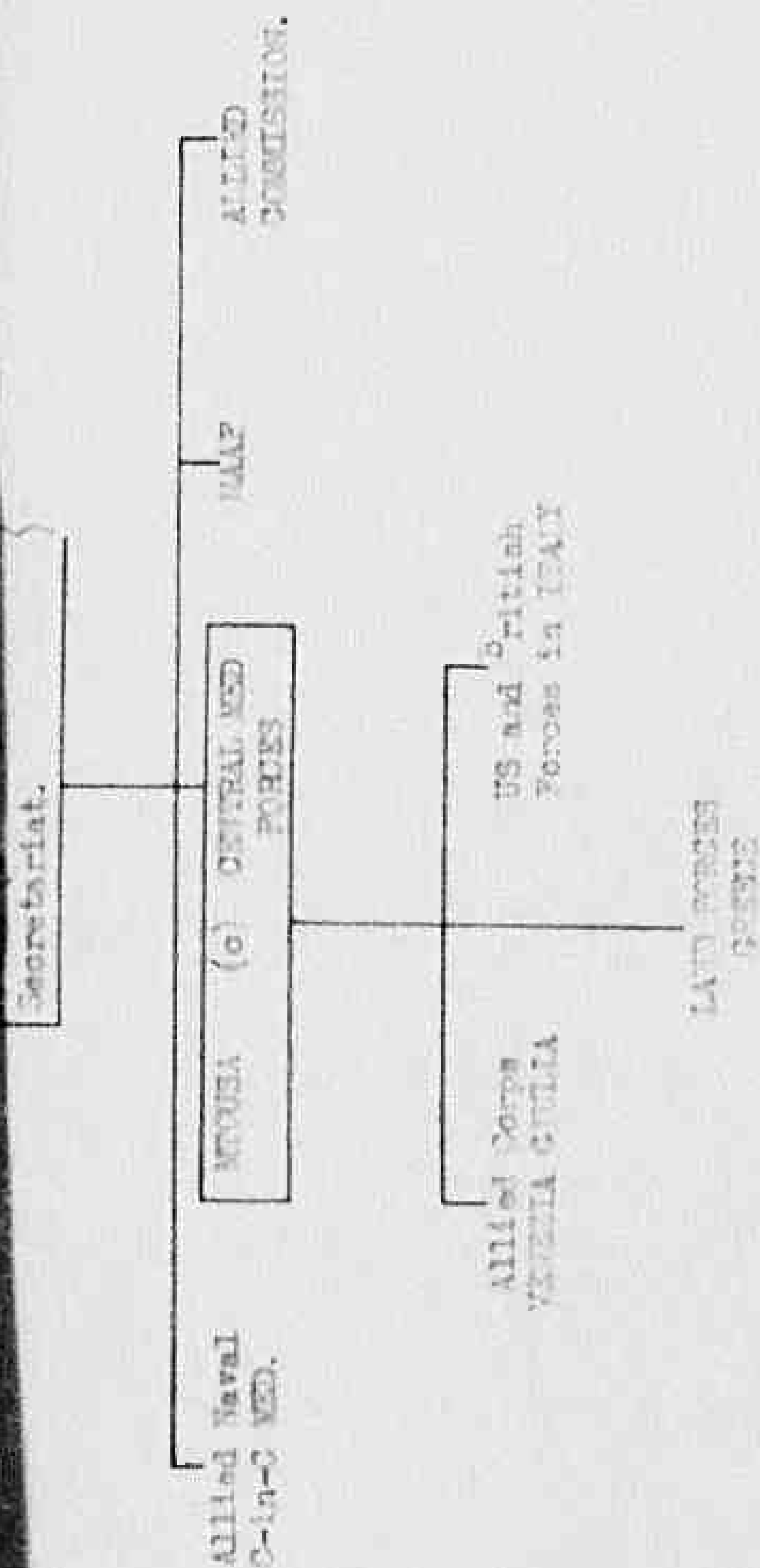

(c) British elements of Headquarters FIORENZE City Command and Headquarters BOLOGNA City Command will be co-operating Allied units in accordance with AFHQ Administrative Memorandum Number 11 dated 24 January 1943. (Revised to 21 October 1943).

(3) Peninsular Base Section will, in addition to its present responsibilities, be responsible for territory in NORTH ITALY as shown in map at Appendix "A".

d. MILIA

(1) Headquarters 2 District will be responsible for territory as given in map at Appendix "A".

(2) Headquarters 2 District will initially be responsible for the administration of British troops in Peninsular Base Section territory within the Compartimento of TOSCANA, except within the territory of Headquarters FIORENZE City Command.

e. CENTRAL and SOUTH ITALY

(1) The present responsibilities of AFHQ Area Allied Command will continue.

(2) British element, SOG area, will be responsible for the administration on behalf of Number 3 District of the territory at present controlled by Headquarters 1 Sub Area, and in

b. The delimitation of the boundary between Harbor 1 District and Peninsular Base Section in the Provincia of BOLOGNA and FIRENZE will be arranged mutually by the commanders concerned and notified to AFHQ.

c. Districts will inform AFHQ of the boundaries they propose for their subordinate headquarters.

4. DELEGATION OF PLAN

Method of execution:

a. VENEZIA GIULIA. Headquarters 55 Area will close in present location and pass to under command Headquarters Eighth Army for planning duties on 25 April 1945. When Eighth Army ceases to be responsible for VENEZIA GIULIA this area will revert to the command of AFHQ or such subordinate headquarters as AFHQ may designate in the later instruction referred to in paragraph 2b above. Should it be necessary to handle United States supplies through TRIESTE, the United States headquarters designated would be a co-operative Allied unit in accordance with AFHQ Memorandum Number 11 of 1943 above referred to.

b. NE ITALY

(1) As the rear Army boundary is advanced and responsibility for territory passes from Headquarters Eighth Army to Headquarters 1 District subordinate static headquarters will be allotted to Headquarters 1 District by AFHQ as shown at Appendix "B".

(2) Pedicular Base Section will assume responsibility for territory from Fifth Army as ordered by Commanding General AFHQSA.

c. NE ITALY

(1) Headquarters 2 District will be relieved of its present responsibilities, (see paragraphs 2a (3), 2f, and 2g) with the exception of CORSIKA and SARDEGNA, at a time to be notified by AFHQ and will initially come under command Commanding General 15th Army Group. Commanding General 15th Army Group will notify AFHQ of the date at which Headquarters 2 District will be required to concentrate forward in preparation for moving into NW ITALY.

(2) At a date to be decided by AFHQ following recommendation by Commanding General 15th Army Group, Headquarters 2 District will assume responsibility for territory as detailed in paragraphs 2d (1) and (2) above reverting to the command of AFHQ.

d. CENTRAL and SOUTH ITALY. Headquarters 3 District will assume responsibility from Headquarters 2 District as given in paragraph 2a(3) above from the date of the withdrawal of Headquarters 2 District. This date will be notified by AFHQ.

5. ALLOCATION AND PROVISION OF SUBORDINATE STATIC HEADQUARTERS. The allocation and provision of subordinate static headquarters will be as at Appendix "B" attached.
