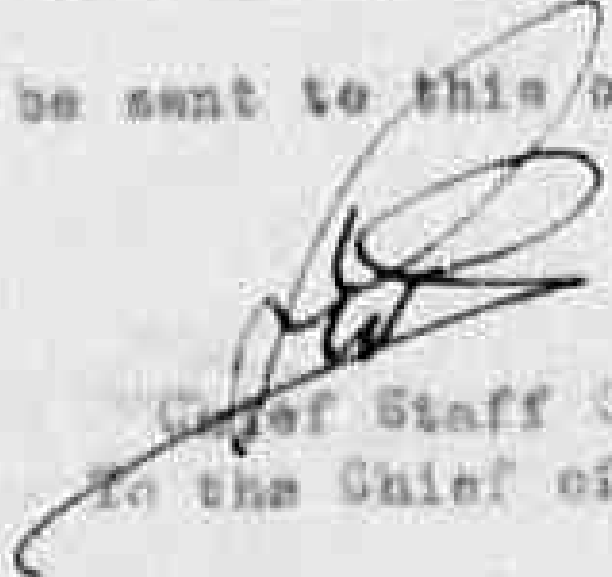

SUBJECT: Giving of Military Information to the Russians and French regarding the Italian Army.

TO : GCH, Land Forces Sub-Commission.

1. You were good enough to let me see Major-General Airey's letter to GCH of 7 November, Ref: GCH/DO/45/44, in which he asked you to refrain from passing to either the Russian or French members of the Allied Commission information about the Italian Army.
2. I have discussed this matter with the Chief Commissioner who asks me to say that by direction of the Combined Chiefs of Staff, the Chief of Staff, AFHQ, in a letter of 26 January, directed the Chief Commissioner to accord to the Russian member access to information on all aspects of the Commission's work. In the Chief Commissioner's opinion the re-organization of the Italian Army is properly part of the Allied Commission's work and information on this subject should be supplied both to the Russian and French members.
3. The Chief Commissioner would be very glad, therefore, if you would make arrangements to do so.
4. I am sending a copy of this letter to Major-General Airey.
