MEMORANDUM TO: G-1(B), Hq. ACC

SUBJECT: Nomenclature of Regions

1. Reference your G-1(B)/106/A.
2. This subject was discussed in detail with Major Ferrar and it was understood that apart from the named Regions which did not have a numerical designation -- i.e., Piemonte and Liguria -- British personal mail was being addressed to Regions using their former numerical designations.
3. Establishment Memorandum No. 24 (Change No. 1) states that in the marking of vehicles "Roman numerals will continue to be used in all Regions with the exception of Southern, Liguria, and Piemonte Regions who will use the capital letters SR, L and P respectively in place of Roman numerals." It is suggested that these lettered designations can be used as addresses for private correspondence if this is acceptable to the APO.

1. Reference change of titles of Regions to geographic names.
2. See folio 141 file 57/Ca. The British postal position is now quite straightforward and has been clarified by the issue of a circular sent out by G-1 (B) of 21 Sep 44. All British private correspondence comes direct to this HQ, except that for the two Armies in the field. It would save a small amount of time in local sorting if PIEMONTE and LIGURIA Regions were given numbers, but G-1 (B) do not press for this.
 - a. It is recommended however that numbers be selected - say X for PIEMONTE and XIV for LIGURIA.
3. See folio 141 file 57/Ca. LAZIO Region to be styled "LATIO-TURRIA Region". The suggestion is a logical one although it will require more typing.
 - a. It is recommended that this suggestion be adopted.
4. If you approve 2 a and 3 a above notification will be made.

1. This Headquarters suggests that rather than the name of "Lazio" for Region IV, the hyphenated name "Lazio-Umbria" be used. This would be more indicative to the Italians as to exactly what territory comprises the Region.

1. The changing of Regions numeral designations to names as set out in Executive Memorandum No. 62 has run afoul of :

(a) Technical point raised by Secy-General at 107 and

(b) Security aspects in addressing of officers private correspondence (at 121).

2. Pending arrival of Regions into the area to which they are assigned, I believe that there are valid security reasons against giving them compartmental or geographical names. It is therefore recommended that Exec. Memorandum No. 62 be withdrawn and advance Regions continue 'by the numbers' until they are on their own ground. As they become so located, geographical names may be substituted.

3. If you agree I will draft a rescinding order. I suggest Piemonte retain the designation "Region K" whilst Liguria pick up either of these numerals - II, III, VII or XIV. No

4. Static Regions retain geographical names.

In view of the adoption of geographical instead numerical titles for Regions, may this office please be informed if it is permissible for the old designations to be used for the purposes of private correspondence as it is thought the new designations will be considered a breach of security regulations if used in this respect.
3. Alternatively, the address of this H.Q. could be adopted for all personal mail (British), but this would entail redirection by the British P.O. and delay in receipt by Officers and O.Rs in the field.
