POINTS ON WHICH INFORMATION IS REQUIRED ON HEADQUARTERS AC BY THE PLANNING STAFF OF ADVANCED HEADQUARTERS NO. 2 DISTRICT, CEF

1. It would assist greatly if HQ AC could make available a svy of the extent to which the enemy has either planned or embarked on the demolition of canals by rd, rail and inlandwater in (incl brs and locks), also of electric power installations and water sup systems. If such a svy could be made available it would also be appreciated if this HQ could receive say a weekly int bulletin recording info on this subject as it comes to hand.

2. It is noted that the HQ AC policy with regard to the requisition of available civ tpt in NW ITALY has been approved by HQ AAI in principle and this decision is naturally accepted by this HQ. Detailed info, however, is requested as to the method by which it is intended to operate available tpt and to the extent to which it is proposed such tpt should be pooled.

It is considered that the amount of WD tpt which will be available for NW ITALY, both for mil and AMG purposes, will be extremely limited and in view of this it is requested that a responsible rep of the AC Transportation Sub-Commission should call on this HQ at an early date, in order that detailed planning of the methods of tn to be adopted can be initiated. In this respect it is the opinion of this HQ that it will be essential for a responsible representative of the AC Transportation Sub-Commission to be set up in NW ITALY, preferably in close proximity to the future locn of this Headquarters.

3. For the purposes of planning the op of the port of GENOA and the detailed layout of the Dep Area in the vicinity of this port it has been necessary to make certain assumptions with regard to the estimated tonnages which will be discharged through the port of GENOA on AC account. This estimate has been based entirely on info available through mil channels and it is now requested that as accurate an estimate as possible should be made available by HQ AC. It is requested that this estimate should show the tonnages which it is expected to discharge in the initial stages and also the expected monthly increases in those tonnages for the period six months after capture of the port. It would help if this estimate could be broken down into the various commodities i.e. sups, coal, POL (packaged and bulk) etc.

4. It is requested that six copies of all proclamations which AC intend to issue in NW ITALY should be made available for HQ 2 District for distribution to the Areas etc concerned.

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for the guarding of vulnerable pts and essential installations will be sufficient for this purpose and that any Patriot policy envisaged which will make formed bodies of Patriots available for this duty will be welcomed by the Mil Authorities.

As the progress of ops in NORTHERN ITALY will preclude the possibility of the allocation to 2 District of all responsibility for the whole of LOMBARDIA Province it will be necessary to agree a bdy between 2 District and the mil fm responsible for ops in the central part of NORTHERN ITALY. It is considered that a bdy following the Provincial bdys and excluding the Province of SONDRIO, BERGAMO, BRESCIA, CREMONA and MANTOVA from 2 District would be a reasonable bdy. The whole of the compartment of FLORENCE and LIGURIA is, of course, to be included within the No 2 District bdy.

It is requested that HQ AC agreement to this proposal should be obtained. Infm would also be welcome on AC proposals for the Province of PIACENZA in the compartment of AMILIA.

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8. Infm is also requested on the frontier policy generally in respect of the FRENCH and SWISS frontiers. The mil aspect of this problem will naturally be considered by the General Staff at HQ MAJ and infm as to this policy will be obtained through mil channels. It is, however, considered that there are many AMG aspects such as trans-frontier movement of personnel stores, commercial relations, customs restrictions etc, which will require to be studied and any infm as to the policy to be adopted in the handling of such matters will be very useful to us.
