Paragraphs 1 a and 1 b, AFHQ letter, file and subject as above, dated 27 February 1945, are amended as follows, effective as of 1 September 1945:

"a. Mediterranean Theater of Operations boundaries include the entire Mediterranean Sea (excluding the Island of Cyprus, and the Turkish Islands adjacent to the Turkish mainland, and the Dodecanese Islands), Italy, Hungary, Rumania, Yugoslavia, Albania, Bulgaria and Greece."

"b. Africa-Middle East Theater (formerly Middle East Theater) boundaries include the entire continent of Africa, Palestine, Trans-Jordan, the Island of Cyprus, the Dodecanese Islands, Turkey and the entire Saudi-Arabia peninsula, excluding Iraq and Trucial-Oman."

1. Effective 0001A, 1 March 1945, the boundaries of the following United States Army Theaters of Operations are:

a. MEDITERRANEAN THEATER OF OPERATIONS

From the point at which the 6th meridian West longitude meets the coast of Spain, thence East and Northeast following the Southern coast of Spain to the Franco-Spanish border, thence along the Southeastern coast of France, to the Franco-Italian border; from there by following the Northern border of Italy to the point at which the Italian, Swiss and Austrian boundaries meet; along the Northern boundary of Austria to the Hungarian border, East along the Northern boundary of Hungary to the border of Rumania, East along Rumania's Northern boundary to the Black Sea; thence South along the Rumanian and Bulgarian coasts to the Turkish border; thence in a Westerly and Southwesterly direction following the Western boundary of Turkey to the Mediterranean Sea; thence South following the Turkish coast, the Syrian coast, the Palestine coast and the Egyptian coast to the Suez Canal (the island of Cyprus and all Turkish islands adjacent to the Turkish mainland are excluded), thence West along the Northern coast of Africa to the juncture of the 6th meridian West longitude and coast of Tangier, thence North along the 6th meridian West longitude to point of origin.

b. AFRICA-MIDDLE EAST THEATER (formerly the Middle East Theater)

Originating at the South Pole, North along the 64th meridian East longitude to and including Rodriguez Island, thence Northwest to the 60th meridian East longitude (Albatross Island), thence North along that meridian to the 25th parallel North latitude, thence West along that parallel to the Arabian coast, thence Southwest to the Tropic of Cancer, along the Ocean-Trustial Ocean border, thence due West to 50° and 30 minutes East Longitude, thence due North to the Head of Bahr As Salwa, thence North along the Western coast of the Persian Gulf to the Southern border of Kuwait, thence Northwest along this border and the Southern and Western borders of Iraq to the Southern border of Turkey, thence East along the Southern Turkish border to the Persian border, thence North along the Turkish-Persian border to the Russian border to the Black Sea, thence along the coast of Turkey to include European Turkey and all the Turkish islands adjacent to the Turkish mainland in the Mediterranean Sea (including the island of Cyprus), thence South and Southwest along the Syrian coast, the Palestine coast and Egyptian coast to the Suez Canal, thence

along the North coast of Africa to where the 32d parallel North latitude meets the coast of French Morocco, West along that parallel to the intersection of the 32d parallel North latitude and 32d meridian West longitude, thence South along that meridian to the intersection with the parallel 13° 30 minutes North latitude, thence Southeast to Ascension Island (excluding the Island and territorial waters), thence Southwest to the intersection of the 40th parallel South latitude with the 26th meridian West longitude, thence South along that meridian to the South Pole, the point of origin.

c. EUROPEAN THEATER OF OPERATIONS (Readjusted in part)

Originating at the point 43° 45 minutes North latitude, 32° West longitude, South along the 32d meridian to the point 32° North latitude 32° West longitude, thence East along the 32d parallel North latitude to the intersection of that parallel with the North African coast, along the coast of North Africa Northeast to the intersection of the 6th meridian West longitude with the coast of Tangier, thence North along that meridian to the Southern coast of Spain, thence along the Southern coast of Spain and the Southern coast of France East and Northeast to the meeting of the Franco-Italian border and the Mediterranean Sea, thence East along the mutual boundaries of MTOUSA and MTOUSA.

Effective with the redesignation of the North African Theater of Operations, U.S. Army, as the Mediterranean Theater of Operations, U.S. Army, the boundaries of the Mediterranean Theater of Operations will be as follows: From 32° West longitude - 43° 45 minutes North latitude South along the 32d meridian West longitude to 13° 30 minutes North latitude, thence East along this parallel to the Western Coast of AFRICA, thence generally East and South along the French territorial boundaries in West AFRICA and along the Atlantic coast of AFRICA to the intersection of the western boundary of NIGERIA with the Gulf of Guinea, (excluding GAMBIA, Portuguese GUINEA, SIERRA LEONE, LIBERIA and GOLD COAST, thence North and East along the boundary of NIGERIA to the intersection of the Nigerian French Equatorial African and French West African boundaries, thence Northward along the Eastern boundaries of French West Africa, ALGERIA and TUNISIA to the Mediterranean Coast, thence Northeastward through the Mediterranean Sea to the intersection of the Southern border of TURKEY and Northern border of SYRIA with the Mediterranean Coast (i.e., including CRETE and all of the islands of the Aegean but excluding Cyprus); thence generally East and North along the Southern and Eastern political boundaries of TURKEY to the Black Sea, thence West and North through the Black Sea to the mouth of the Dniester River, thence generally North and West along the Northern political boundaries of ROMANIA, HUNGARY and AUSTRIA as they existed prior to 1939, to the boundary of SWITZERLAND, thence generally South and West along the Eastern and Southern boundaries of SWITZERLAND to the intersection with the Eastern boundary of FRANCE, thence South along the Eastern boundary of FRANCE to the intersection of the FRENCH-ITALIAN border and the Mediterranean Sea, thence generally West and Northwest along the waters adjacent to the Southern coast of FRANCE to the intersection of the SPANISH-FRENCH border and the Mediterranean Sea, thence West along the Southern boundary of FRANCE to the intersection of the SPANISH-FRENCH border at the Bay of Biscay, thence generally West along the Northern Spanish Coast to 43° 45 minutes North latitude, thence West to the point of beginning.
