SUBJECT : Authorities for travel.

TO : H.Q., G-1.
Destination Office.
Adjutant.Journeys by road over 100 miles and travel to AUSTRIA.

1. Reference A.S.H.Q. Memorandum No. 33 of 23 June 1945. "Inter-Theatre travel" and A.S.H.Q. letter reference A.G. 374.2/173 G-1-0 of 16 June 1945 "Travel to Austria".
2. The Disposition developed on the Chief Commissioner in A.S.H.Q. Memo No. 33/45 to authorize travel by road in excess of 100 miles has been delegated to G-1(3) this H.Q.
3. When Movement "Requests for Travel and/or Assignment Orders" are received from G-1(2) for movement by road to destinations in excess of 100 miles it can be accepted inter alia that the necessary authority is contained in the application.
4. Likewise when the destination is in Austria, it can be assumed that the conditions set out in the A.S.H.Q. letter under referenced have been complied with in so far as the conditions are concerned.
5. It is not contemplated that G-1(2) by road to Austria will be authorized to destinations further a field than HILDEBRUNN, from which point, it is considered, any further travel into the country should be undertaken by H.Q., E.A.A. It is requested the above mentioned drivers proceeding to Austria be instructed that they are not authorized to travel beyond the point specified in their Movement Orders.

1. Effective 16 July 1945 a limited amount of travel by civilians in the direct interests of the Allied administration of Austria will be authorized into the American and British Zones of Austria.

2. This will be in accordance with Phase 2 of the AFHQ G-1/Security Instruction (Austria) No. 3 dated 2 May, 1945.

3. The procedure to be followed will be that as outlined in AFHQ letter "Travel to Austria" dated 26 June, 1945.

1. Reference AFHQ CI/Security Instruction No 3, AG. 371.2/173 of 2 May, 1945 and AFHQ letter AG. 371.2/173. GSI-0 of 16 June 1945, which was sent out by this office as Airport and Frontier Control Memorandum No 353.

2. It has been decided that the Second-Phase of travel to and from the British and American Zones of AUSTRIA shall open on 16 July 1945. It is NOT proposed to announce this fact to the public, but the measures described in para 2 of CI/Security Instruction No 3 will come into effect from that date, with certain slight alterations as given in para 3 below.

3. These alterations will be:-

A. Reference para 2d (c) of the Instruction.

Local Military Exit Permits (yellow with green diagonal band) will be issued by this office until the quadripartite control of travel is functioning, when the Military Exit Permit (blue with red diagonal band) will be taken into use.

B. Reference para 2d (3)(c) of the Instruction.

The IEC card is not being used in AUSTRIA. This sub-para will therefore be deleted.

C. Reference para 2d 4. of the Instruction.

This only applies to British, British Commonwealth (incl Indian) and American ex-PW. Other ex-PW are allowed to leave AUSTRIA undocumented provided that they are moving in formed bodies and that Frontier Controls are reasonably

c. Reference para 2d 4 of the Instruction.

This only applies to British, British Commonwealth (incl Italian) and American ex-PW. Other ex-PW are allowed to leave AUSTRIA undocumented provided that they are moving in formed bodies and that Frontier Controls are reasonably satisfied that they are genuine.

4. Please note that those arrangements do NOT apply to travel to and from JUGOSLAVIA, the frontier to which is still closed.

5. Will all addressees therefore please take with effect from 16 July, 1945, the necessary measures as laid down in CI/Security Instruction No 3.

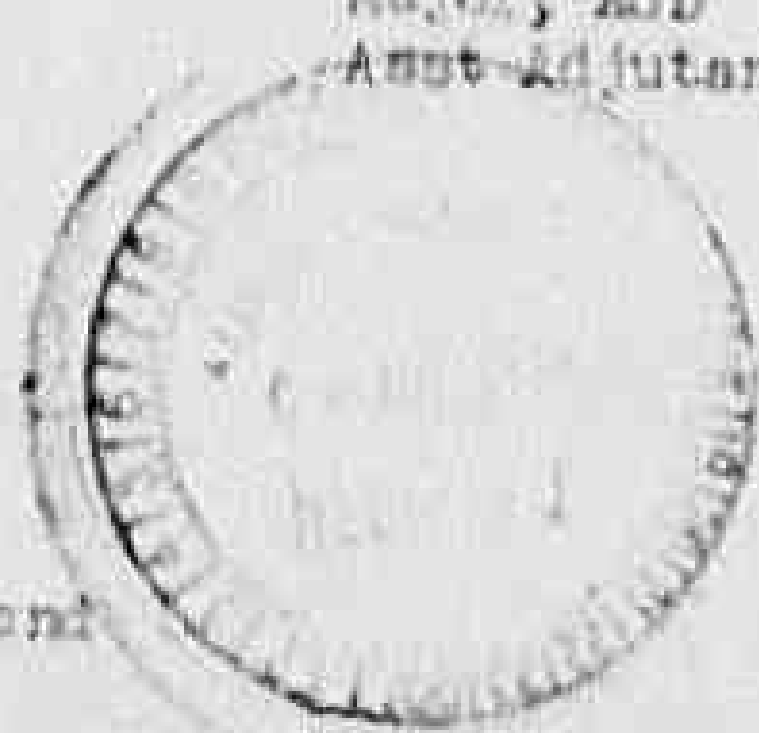

ALLIED FORCE ZONE (AFZ), enforced "valid for entry into Austria" will be required by all persons entering that part of Austria controlled by AFZ, with the exceptions noted in Part I of Appendix "A", on the date hereof. Travel will be restricted to the minimum essential to the Allied administration of Austria. Every application will be considered individually.

Applicants desiring to proceed from Italy to Austria will complete an application form. The procedure is laid down in Section 1 of the Regulation No. 61/45, dated 5 June, 1945, relating to the issue of military travel permits. It will be allowed in all such cases.

1. Effective this date Allied Force Permits endorsed 'Valid for entry into AUSTRIA' (specimen as Inclosure I) will be required by all persons entering that part of AUSTRIA controlled by SACRED, with the exceptions noted in paragraph 2 below. Travel will be restricted to the minimum essential to the Allied administration of AUSTRIA. Every application will be considered individually.

2. The exceptions are:

Applications for permits for all other categories of travellers shall be referred to this headquarters.

6. Duplicate copy of the application form will be forwarded to the Assistant Chief of Staff, G-2, this headquarters in the case of:

- a. All applications referred.
- b. All permits granted without reference.

7. Where special information of security or political interest arises in the case of an application, such information should be forwarded with the application.

8. Urgent cases may be dealt with by cable, but application forms should be forwarded in order to complete records of this headquarters.

9. Persons other than American and British military personnel who are exempted under paragraph 2 above from the requirements of a permit, will be cleared with this headquarters by cable before despatch. American and British military personnel however, may travel without telegraphic clearance.

10. Every civilian entering Austrian territory must hold a national passport and must comply with the exit permit regulations in force in the territory he is leaving.

11. Unless otherwise ordered permits will be valid for a return journey.

12. Persons, other than the exempted categories, who arrive in AUSTRIA by water, land or air without Allied Force permits are liable to detention and subsequent deportation to the country from which they start their journey.

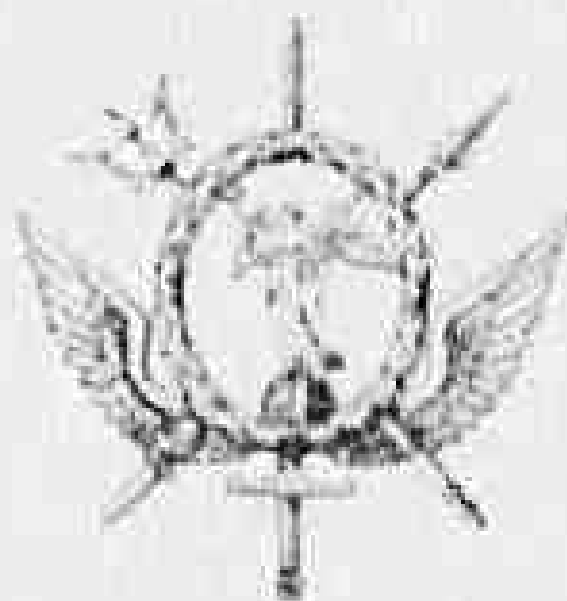

The Security Control of Displaced Persons in AUSTRIA

TO: All Concerned

1. Period Covered. The period covered is that of active operations and the following static period before the assumption of responsibility by the Control Commission/Council.

2. Considerations.

a. The principal displaced persons security problem for the Allied Forces, during the period of active operations, is the infiltration of enemy agents through the allied lines in the guise of displaced persons. During this period the screening of displaced persons will be the responsibility of Counter Intelligence staffs under present arrangements and Counter Intelligence staffs will be responsible for the necessary measures.

b. During the second period the main security problem will be the prevention of the escape of persons on the Counter Intelligence Wanted List and/or criminals posing as displaced persons. All other security problems relating to Allied Displaced Persons will be the responsibility of the respective Allied National Authorities. Counter Intelligence personnel will render assistance where necessary.

c. The paramount consideration is the speedy repatriation of Allied Nationals through assembly centres. It is, therefore, the policy of the Supreme Allied Commander that the detailed Security Control of Allied displaced persons should be carried out in the main at the reception centres in their own countries.

3. Procedure at the Assembly Centres for Allied National Displaced Persons

a. Registration

(1) Allied Force Registration Record (DF2) will be completed in duplicate in respect of each displaced person by a Registrar, where possible of his own nationality.

(2) A copy of the Assembly Centre Registration Card (DF3) - which is compiled from the DF2 - will be submitted by the Assembly Center Director to the CI Travel Control Section at Army/Allied Commission Headquarters in respect of each displaced person who has been registered.

- (1) It will be the responsibility of the appropriate Allied Liaison Officer for repatriation, using the D&Z and any additional information he can obtain to verify the nationality claimed by the displaced person. Any inconsistencies in a displaced person's statements will be reported to the Allied Liaison Officer for further investigation. The Allied Liaison Officer will immediately notify the Assembly Centre Director in any case where he has doubts about the bona fides of a displaced person.
- (2) In order to reduce the numbers of enemy or ex-enemy displaced persons who are subsequently discovered at reception centres in Allied countries and are thereby required to be returned to detention camps in AUSTRIA, Assembly Centre Directors will obtain local security clearance by the submission of a complete nominal roll to the local CI representative for endorsement before a given group leaves an assembly centre for a destination outside AUSTRIA. This check is to be made against wanted persons lists should be left as late as conveniently possible before departure, in order that full advantage may be taken of all verification of bona fides previously carried out by the Allied Liaison Officer concerned.

c. Disposition of Suspects (Detention). The following out-comes will be reported to HQ by the Centre Director to the appropriate military headquarters:

- (1) Those found to be enemy, or ex-enemy nationals. The military commander will make arrangements for their removal to detention camps and for the safeguarding of any documentary evidence.
- (2) Displaced persons suspected on strong prima facie evidence of active collaboration with the enemy or of anti-Allied activities or of the assumption of a false nationality or identity. The military commander will decide whether arrangements should be made for their removal from the centre or arrange for supervision and detention until such time as they can be handed over to the appropriate Allied authorities, who will be responsible for the method of repatriation and necessary security measures in each case under the supervision of counter intelligence personnel.

d. Disposition of Suspects (Repatriation). If there are grounds for suspicion against a displaced person and it is established that he does not come under either category (1) or (2) above, the letter "S" will be placed by the Allied Liaison Officer in the upper right hand corner of the D&Z card and after his name on all copies of the nominal roll which are in possession of the group leader. Brief particulars of the reason for suspicion will also be entered in

space 24 of the DSE card. He will then be evacuated in the normal manner for ultimate disposition at the reception centre in the Allied country concerned.

e. Doubtful Cases. Assembly Centre directors may request the assistance of counter intelligence personnel (including any personnel who may be made available from the Allied Security Services) to advise in difficult cases. They will, however, avoid burdening military commanders with cases of minor importance.

f. Special Cases. US, British and British Commonwealth (including British Indian) Nationals, and neutrals and stateless persons will be dealt with in accordance with instructions issued by this headquarters.

4. Procedure at Assembly Centres for Enemy and Ex-enemy Displaced Persons

a. Wherever possible this category of displaced persons will be billeted on the Austrian population. Where necessary, military commanders will require the Austrian authorities to organize Assembly centres for them, which may be established as detention camps.

b. Military commanders will supervise the Austrian authorities in the registration of these persons.

c. Security screening of these categories and the necessary security measures will be the responsibility of military commanders and will be carried out by counter intelligence personnel in conjunction with Public Safety Officers. Our originals and those on the counter intelligence wanted list will be removed to detention camps.

5. Procedure at Reception Centres in Allied Countries

a. The Allied security services will be responsible for all security measures undertaken at the reception centres in the Allied country concerned, including:

- (1) Interrogation of suspects and wanted persons
- (2) Comparison of lists of displaced persons arriving at reception centres with lists of wanted persons and suspects
- (3) The collecting for censorship of letters and other documents carried by displaced persons.

b. The Allied security service of the nation concerned will be responsible for the final disposition of suspects and wanted persons. Any enemy nationals who have been overlooked and are discovered at this stage will be returned to be dealt with as laid down in paragraph 3-c (1).

6. Frontier Control

a. In the case of displaced persons arriving at frontiers under controlled repatriation procedure, the Group Leader of each party will surrender one copy of the complete master roll in respect of his group to the US or Br 3080

8. Displaced persons arriving at frontiers without proper documentation will be sent to the nearest assembly centre for processing after examination by counter-intelligence personnel.

SUBJECT: GI/Security Instruction (Austria) No. 3 - Travel to and from Austria

TO: All Concerned

Travel to and from Austria (zones occupied by American or British Forces) will be severely restricted and regulated in four phases.

1. First Phase - from the date of surrender or occupation of the whole or part of the territory concerned to the date when a skeleton form of GI Travel Control has been established. During this period:

a. The frontier zone will be occupied by section units with the object of "sealing" the borders as they existed at 31 December 1937.

b. The frontier will be closed to all travellers (including Kleiner Grenzverkehr - Frontaliere) not forming part of the Allied Forces of occupation.

c. GIC/ZL Control personnel will take up posts on the frontier.

2. Forward GI Travel Control Office will be set up at HQ Occupying Force in the American and British zones respectively, and machinery for occupation and disposition of applications for authorization to cross the frontier will be prepared.

a. Travel to Austria will only be permitted to the following:

(1) US and British military personnel on duty. When travelling as individuals, military personnel must be in possession of regular travel orders.

(2) Holders of Allied Force Permits endorsed "Valid for entry to Austria only" and issued by G-2 (GI) Section, this headquarters, or other authority designated by that office. Allied Force Permits at this stage will be issued "for entry only" unless exceptional circumstances are present and to individuals whose proposed journey is of immediate operational importance.

f. Travel from Austria will only be permitted to the following:

(1) US and British military personnel on duty. When travelling as individuals they must be in possession of regular travel orders.

- (2) Persons travelling under escort and/or in possession of a Voyage Authority issued by GI/G.I.(s), Fifth or Eighth Armies.
- (3) Allied ex-prisoners of war evacuated to Italy by air and controlled under G-1 (A) and G-1 (B) arrangements.
- (4) Russian citizens moved under special arrangements.

2. Second Phase - after skeleton GI Travel Control is operating. Separate American and British GI Travel Control Offices with Fifth and Eighth Armies will move to Vienna as soon as operationally possible, having due regard to the status of the remainder of the GI organization. During this period:

a. Forward GI Travel Control Offices at Fifth and Eighth Armies' headquarters, respectively, will begin to operate and the frontier will be opened to limited traffic.

b. Frontier Guards drawn from occupational troops will:

- (1) Prevent all persons and goods not forming part of the Allied Forces from entering or leaving Austria except at authorized Frontier Control Posts.
- (2) Arrest and hand over to the nearest GI Frontier Post for examination and detention all unauthorized persons detected crossing or attempting to cross the Austrian Frontier.

c. Travel to Austria will be extended to:

- (1) Holders of Joint Chiefs of Staff Permits issued in Washington } endorsed

 } and by SHAEF. }

During this stage, permits may be issued for entry or for entry and exit.

d. Travel from Austria will be extended to:

- (1) Holders of JCS and AF Permits endorsed for a return journey.
- (2) Holders of Military Exit Permits issued by Forward GI Travel Control.
- (3) Displaced persons documented and moved under G-5 arrangements. Each group will carry:

- (a) 1 copy of DF 1 (Index Card) on each individual
- (b) 1 copy of the nominal roll with each Group leader for delivery to CI Frontier Control at crossing point of exit.
- (c) 1 copy of DF 2 (Registration Card) per individual accompanied with visa of country of destination. These will be held by the group leader in respect of each member of his party.
- (d) Allied ex-prisoners of war moved under G-1 (1) and G-1 (2) arrangements. Each PW (unless evacuated by air under special AAF orders) will hold a PW Identity Card issued by a PW Contact Officer or his representative.
- (5) Such other categories as may be notified by Forward CI Travel Control.

3. Third Phase - after CI Travel Control is fully established. This phase coincides broadly with the remainder of the period of control by this Headquarters. During this period:

a. Frontier Guards will continue to operate as before.

b. Personnel engaged on frontier and airport control will confine themselves to travel security duties and operate under the direct command of the Travel Control Sections at Allied Commission/Army Headquarters British and US elements, respectively. Their duties, undertaken in those two where possible, will include:

- (1) Manning of frontier and airport control posts.
- (2) Examination of all travellers and enforcement at the frontier or airports of travel regulations and instructions.
- (3) Making preliminary investigations into and interrogations of doubtful and unaccompanied travellers and persons detected attempting to cross the frontier or to leave or enter Austria illicitly by air.
- (4) Insuring suspects are sent to detention camps for further investigation.
- (5) Security Control of the movement over the Austrian border of displaced persons and Allied ex-prisoners of war.
- (6) At frontier posts making local arrangements to deal with Kleiner Grenzverkehr (borderers).
- (7) Organising security patrols on unauthorized routes 308 June-
tion with the local military commander.

(3) Advising the local military commander on the disposition of frontier guards.

c. Detailed instructions covering military entry and exit permit procedure will be issued. Civilian traffic will be kept to a minimum compatible with the interests of the Allied Administration of Austria.

4. Fourth Phase - From the time when this headquarters starts to hand over to the Control Commission. During this period, conditions will be as in the Third Phase, except that:

a. If deemed desirable, the categories of persons who may obtain entry and exit permits will be expanded.

b. Personnel of a purged and reorganized Austrian Frontier Control organization should be available to assist in dealing with the increase in traffic.

5. As a matter of travel control procedure, the beginning and ending of each phase will be decided and publicized by the Counter Intelligence Travel Control Organization for Austria.
