The Italian press has recently given wide publicity to reports that the Allied authorities have authorized the former prefect and Mayor of BOLOGNA to proceed to Paris, London and Washington, in their capacity as leaders of the movement for the freedom of the South Tyrol, to defend the cause of the constitution of the Alto Adige to Austria.

The Allied Commission announces that such reports are without foundation. No authority has been given.
