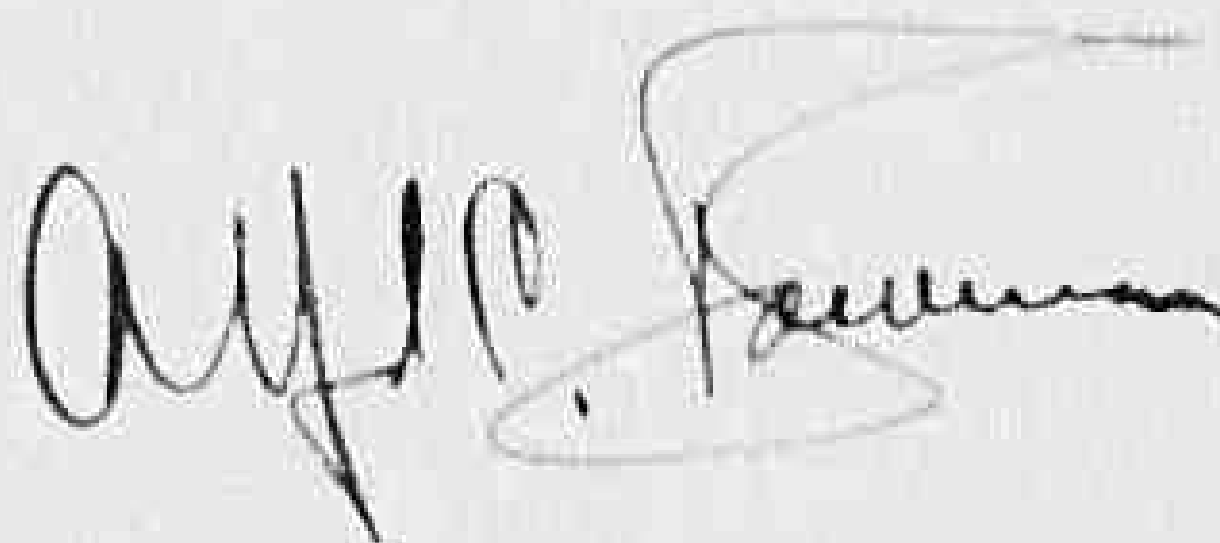

This is to confirm our telephone conversation of 2 February 1946 on the subject of Col. Bowman's Title which you raised in your letter (596/32/EC) of 28 January 1946.

I have again spoken to Airey, BGS XIII Corps who has spoken to General Harding who feels very strongly that no change should be made. The reason is that he regards the administration of Venezia Giulia as a direct responsibility of himself as Corps Commander and Bowman as his SCAO. He does not in any way regard AMG Udine as being a XIII Corps responsibility and is only interested in the administration of the province in so far as the purely military requirements of the Corps are affected.

I am quite satisfied from what I saw when I was there the other day that Bowman is in no sense exercising control over the Provincial Commissioner of Udine and that he does not regard himself as an adviser to the Corps Commander on matters affecting that Province. Airey has again given me an assurance on that point.

As you agreed that it would be inappropriate in the circumstances to make an issue of the question, I am not pressing it any further.

The Corps Commander has no objection to the title SCAD, VENEZIA GIULIA in order to distinguish him from the Provincial Commissioners of the three Provinces of VENEZIA proper who will shortly come under the military jurisdiction of 13 Corps. 13 Corps also recognise the arrangement by which technical direction is given by Sub-Commissions to specialist officers in the area on technical points. They feel, however, that on any matter of policy 13 Corps should seek direction from AFHQ: this includes certain matters of personnel such as the appointment of a new SCAD, or Chief of Police (see below). The SCAD himself is fully alive to the value of remaining under the technical control of the Allied Commission and so long as care is exercised both from this HQ and by the SCAD, I think a satisfactory method of working can be achieved. I have made it quite clear to the SCAD that neither he nor his staff are entitled to correspond with AFHQ and if they receive instructions direct from AFHQ, they should refer them to 13 Corps.
