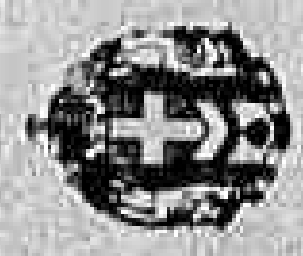

Reference telephone conversation HAMILTON-AMFLEBY 15 October. Further to our FX 48184 and F48417.

Since 147 Generals and 15 Colonels dispersed they and others similarly dispersed may be written off. 13 CORPS handling any new arrivals entering through northeast and these need not be evacuated MILAN.

2. Request number and ranks all officers PW from RUSSIA now MILAN or expected arrive near future. Pending receipt this information will take no action here. If upon receipt this information situation appears promising plan request Italian increment to CSDIC to contact Colonel ANFOSSO direct.

TO : Headquarters, Allied Commission, APO 394

1. Reference is made to your 612/EC of 15 September to this Headquarters copy to HQ XIII Corps forwarding a report by Signor ALFREDO PIZZONI in connection with an impending Yugoslav "coup de main" at TRIESTE.

2. Intelligence reports from any source are much appreciated by this Headquarters. In view however of the fact that it is the function of the G-2 Section of this Headquarters to evaluate such reports, it is requested that in future operational intelligence reports are not repeated by you to lower formations.

3. In this particular case for instance, G-2 Section was in possession of additional information which materially affected the value of the report.

1. Information received here large number of Italian Ex-Prisoners from RUSSIA including many high-ranking and general officers currently arriving AMD at UDINE.
2. Understand repatriation operates through ALLIED COMMISSION IPW SC and thence Italian authorities for disposition.
3. Urgently desired here that interrogation particularly officers on matters pertaining to Russian order of battle be effected with commensurate high security.
4. As information here is not available as to mechanics of administration of these personnel from UDINE into ITALY it is desired here that CSDIC be enabled to interrogate these personnel before such time as Italian authorities assume control.
5. Request you liaise with CSDIC and AMD UDINE to expedite and inform this Headquarters of progress made.

1. Information received here large numbers Italian Ex-War Prisoners including high ranking and general officers from RUSSIA now arriving UDINE at AMG.

2. Interrogation through 13 CORPS directed however facilities not available there for handling large numbers and possibility exists some personnel already cleared into ITALY.

3. Understand ALLIED COMMISSION IPW SC next screening agency before Italian Government assumes control.

4. Request you liaise with ALLIED COMMISSION to insure availability personnel named para one before Italian agencies assume control.

5. Directed that Russian Order of Battle be secured by interrogation and brief will be forwarded fastest.

2. It is to the effect that the Yugoslavs are preparing a surprise attack on Trieste and other places in Venezia Giulia west of the Morgan Line.

3. He has asked that this information be brought to the attention of Allied authorities.
