The first plan was performed at the time of the issue of racial laws in Italy.

The second one at the outbreak of the war against Greece-land.

I was forced to apply to some other people to whom I committed my stocks without receiving any receipt or statement. Upon my return from the forced exile, I found that the same persons were renitent in turning over to me my own goods.

I beg your Command to inform me if you can do something to help me. I thank you wholeheartedly. Please accept my best regards,

Dear Maurice

I am sorry to worry you about trifles but I shall really be rather glad if you could cause somebody to let me know the composition, by numbers and names, of the Greek Representation on the Advisory Council and to the Allied Commission. The particular point at issue is that there have for many months past been two representatives living in the Grande Hotel; one is a Captain, R.H.N., and the other is a Colonel. They are, in point of fact, living in that portion of the Grande Hotel held by this Headquarters for transit purposes and I have been trying for a long time to get them moved elsewhere. I would be very grateful if you would let me know with whom on your Commission I should deal.

The Greek representatives also hold a certain amount of other property which seems to accommodate a very floating and transitory population and it is for that reason that I should be glad to know the position of the Commission.

With effect from 25 March 1946, the issue of Allied Force permits for entry into Italy, has ceased from all countries with the exceptions of Germany and Austria. The Italian Government has re-assumed responsibility for the control of entry into Italy, and has appointed agents at frontiers, sea ports and airports, to insure that Italian visa regulations are observed, quoted from the latest TRAVEL CONTROL D BACTIVE for your information.

As entry into Italy is no longer a military prerogative, it is regretted that this office can no longer pass on such applications as it has so done in the past.

The a/m letter* have been passed to the Italian Ministry of Foreign Affairs. However, this office will not accept any further applications and it is suggested that they be passed direct to the Italian Ministry of Foreign Affairs.

I have to inform you that on the night of the 26th to the 27th inst., a shot was fired from outside the room in which Mr. A. Sgourdeos, 1st Secretary of this Delegation was asleep. The bullet hit the wall a few inches to the right of his head and rebounded into the bed without hurting him.

The Italian Police have been informed and are investigating the case. Mr Sgourdeos' flat is situated via Manfredi N°19.

I am bringing the above to your knowledge for your information.
